The Lamar University women's basketball team, whose 2007 recruiting class was ranked No. 31 in the nation by The Collegiate Girls Basketball Report, has made great strides under the direction of head coach Larry Tidwell.

Led by three of the top players in the Southland Conference, the Lady Cardinals were picked to win the Southland Conference East division and received more first place votes in the conference pre season poll than any other SLC school.

The early results have been impressive, as the Lady Cardinals posted a 7-6 record in non-conference play this year, the first time since the 1991-92 season that Lamar has had a winning record through their non-conference schedule.

The four members of the Lady Cardinal coaching staff have over 75 years of combined coaching experience on the college and high school level, and know the fundamental skills needed to become a better basketball player. All four coaches will be involved in the daily individual instruction with the campers, passing their knowledge of the game along to your child.
