Lady Cardinals at a Glance

Lamar is led by Shalayne Blythe's 2.24 kills and 0.80 blocks per set, while Kaci Brewer is averaging a team-best 2.41 kills and 2.16 digs per set. Genevieve Gladle is averaging 2.16 kills and 2.86 digs per set, Lauren Holdorff is averaging 2.18 kills and a team-high 0.84 blocks per set while Ashley Todd has paced the LU attack with 8.52 assists per set. Andrea Hamilton leads the defense with 3.76 digs per set.

As a team the LU offense has posted a .201 hitting percentage this season, while allowing their opponents to hit .180. The defense averages 14.77 digs per set and 1.86 blocks per set for the Lady Cardinals.

Series History

This will be the 25th meeting between Lamar and the University of Texas, and just the second meeting in the last 18 years, with the series tied at 12 wins apiece. The last meeting between the Lady Cards and the Long-

horns was in 2005 when they met on September 10 at the Magnolia Invitational hosted by Ole Miss. Texas handed Lamar a 3-0 loss to even the all time series. The last time Lamar defeated UT was on November 6, 1980 when Lamar handed the Horns a 2-1 loss.

The Lady Cardinals dominated the early years of the series, winning the first 10 meetings between the two programs and 12 of the first 13. Since that time however, Texas has been the one in control, winning the last 11 including a pair of NCAA Tournament matches in 1983 and 84.

All Conference

The Lady Cardinals had three players earn All Southland Conference honors, and two more named honorable mention, as they helped LU to a 12-4 record and a second place finish in conference.

Middle blocker Lauren Holdorff, a junior from Friendswood, Texas, was named first team all-conference after finishing second in the conference in hitting percentage at .392 in conference play and was just one of seven players in the league to hit over .300.

Senior setter Ashley Todd was named second team all-conference after running the

Lady Cardinals offense for the majority of the season. The Corpus Christi, Texas native averaged 8.52 assists per set for the year which ranked eighth in the conference.

Kaci Brewer, a junior outside hitter from Castroville, Texas, joined Todd on the second team after leading the LU offense in kills during SLC play. She finished conference play with 170 kills for a 2.74 kills per set average, while ranking third on the team in digs with 148 during league play. For the year she knocked down 207 kills and collected 186 digs and tied for the team lead with five double-doubles.

Shalayne Blythe and Genevieve Gladle picked up honorable mention all-conference honors for their roles in the Lady Cardinals run to the No. 2 seed in the Southland Conference Tournament.

Hamilton digs towards the top

The Lady Cardinals libero Andrea Hamilton moved into third place on the schools all time digs list with 1,534. She entered the Southland Conference tournament just seven digs shy of third place, but an injury kept her off the court until the championship match. She is now just 57 digs shy of second place.

Keys to Success

As a team the LU offense has posted a .206 hitting percentage this season, while allowing their opponents to hit .182. The defense averages 15.42 digs per set and 1.90 blocks per set for the Lady Cardinals.

Dynamic Duo Leads LU Offense from the Setter Position

Senior Ashley Todd and junior Adrienne Meengs have led the Lady Cards offense from the setter position this season. After earning 2007 Southland Conference Setter of the Year Honors, Meengs missed the first two-thirds of the season to illness, but Todd stepped in and was one of the top setters in the league with an 11.92 assists per set average. Since Meengs return the two have split time setting and Meengs has begun to round into form, which led to an SLC All-Tournament selection. Todd's setting numbers have declined due to the fact that she is the Lady Cards top serving threat and continues to play an important role while not setting.

All Tournament Honors

Three Lady Cardinals earned SLC All Tournament honors after Lamar claimed the title, as Shalayne Blythe, Adrienne Meengs and Kaci Brewer were honored. Brewer was named the tournament MVP.

Hurricane Trouble

The Lady Cardinals had five matches cancelled this season due to hurricanes. Their August 30 match against Baylor was cancelled so the team could return to Beaumont before the mandatory evacuation of the city due to Hurricane Gustav. Two weeks later Hurricane Ike slammed into Southeast Texas, causing Lamar to cancel their home tournament which took matches against Louisiana Lafayette, UT-Pan American and Texas Tech off the schedule, as well as a road contest at the University of Houston.
