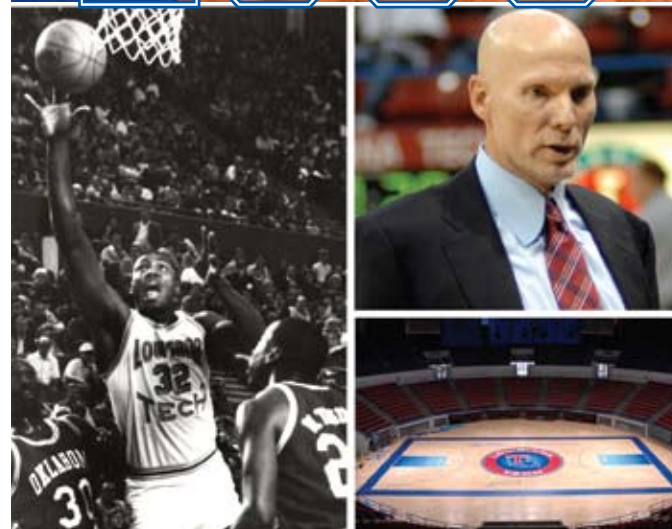

Coach Kerry Rupp

Louisiana Tech Men's Basketball is moving in a new direction with Coach Kerry Rupp. Coach Rupp has been involved in basketball at many different levels. He is known as one of the best teachers in the game, and one of the most successful high school coaches in the country. Coach Rupp was the first head coach at the University of Utah to win the Mountain West Conference Tournament Championship, and was selected as 1999 Utah Coach of the Year. The University of Utah went on to compete in the 2004 NCAA Tournament.

Coach Rupp helped develop Andrew Bogut into the National Player of the Year and the first pick in the 2005 NBA Draft. Coach Rupp assisted Indiana University to the NIT and NCAA Tournaments.

His coaching has taken him all over the world, including Europe and Australia. He coordinated the Utah Jazz Summer League, and in 1996 was part of the Seattle Supersonics summer league staff.

He has directed an assortment of camps at all levels, including the Karl Malone Basketball Camp.

Now Coach Rupp is ready to make his camp here at Louisiana Tech University the best in the country. He is ready to bring a spirit of fun and enthusiasm, while focusing on the



fundamentals necessary to a good game. The goal of the camp is to instill a sense of discipline in every camper, as well as an appreciation for the game. Every camper will come away knowing they have been taught by one of the best coaches in basketball.

Overnight Basketball Camp

Regarded as one of the best instructional overnight camps in the country.

All campers will receive breakfast, lunch and dinner at the Tech Student Center.

Grades 5–12

Camp runs from 9 am–9 pm daily and ends on Thursday, June 19 at 12 pm.

Registration will be held in the lobby of the dorm from 4–6 pm on Monday, June 16.

Team Camp

The camp will be divided into divisions according to classification and competition level, including Varsity and Junior Varsity divisions.

Teams will play at least 6 games and will be involved in the 2-Minute tournament.

Big Man/Guard Camp
