MATCH PREVIEW

KICKOFF

Louisiana Tech only has two more non-conference matches in preparation for league play, the first one coming on Wednesday at crosstown foe Grambling State with kickoff set for 5 p.m. at the GSU Soccer Complex.

The Lady Techsters have been stellar on defense thus far this season, allowing just four goals in eight matches. They have yet to allow multiple goals in a single match.

THE SERIES

Wednesday will be the tenth time that LA Tech and Grambling State face off on the pitch, making it the longest series in program history.

The Lady Techsters lead the Lady Tigers, 6-3, having won each of the last six meetings by a combined score of 41-1. This will be the fifth straight year the two teams play. Last season in Ruston, LA Tech won 9-0.

ABOUT

Under first-year head coach Justin Wagar, Grambling State has been very competitive this season with a 2-4 record. The two victories have come against Texas A&M-Texarkana and UC-Riverside while three of their four losses have been by only one goal.

Four different players -- Kiawna Mounts, Janee Harris, Sage Nelson and Kaylee Holt -- have scored for the Lady Tigers this season. Jordan Woodward has gotten all six starts in net, allowing seven goals.

LAST MATCH

LA TECH SCORES TWO GOALS OFF SET PIECES IN HOME WIN

Louisiana Tech has been productive this season on set pieces and Sunday was no different, scoring off two corner kicks to help register a 2-0 shutout win over Jacksonville State at the Lady Techster Soccer Complex.

Freshman Elizabeth Doll netted a header goal almost midway through the first half and junior Mylene Roy-Ouellet tallied a goal off a deflection in the 57th minute to give LA Tech its first home win of the year.

For Doll, it was her second goal of the season. Roy-Ouellet now leads the team in scoring with four goals. Of the 13 total goals scored this season, four have come off set pieces while five have come off headers.

TEAM NOTES

KGOALE NAMED C-USA DEFENSIVE POW

After helping the Louisiana Tech women's soccer team come away with a win and a draw in the opening weekend of the 2017 season, Nomvula Kgoale was chosen as the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Week in an announcement by the league office on Monday.

In the season opener at McNeese State, Kgoale played all but one minute in helping shutout the Cowgirls, 1-0. It marked the first win in program history over McNeese State in Lake Charles (previously 0-3).

The defender turned around two days later against Texas State and scored on her first shot attempt of the season. After a free kick into the box was punched out by the opposing keeper, the Polokwane, South Africa native took a first touch and then fired a bullet from 25 yards out to the upper-right corner.

KGOALE SELECTED AS C-USA PRESEASON DPOY

Louisiana Tech senior defender Nomvula Kgoale was one of 11 players selected to the Pre-season Women's Soccer All-Conference USA Team as well as being chosen as the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year in a vote by the league head coaches.

Kgoale made an immediate impact last season for the Lady Techsters after transferring from Tyler Junior College, earning second team All-Conference and second team NSCAA All-Central Region honors while helping the team post a 14-6-1 overall record (second most wins in program history).

Kgoale will be one of six returning starters for LA Tech looking to qualify for its fourth straight conference tournament. The Lady Techsters were picked to finish seventh (out of 14) in the preseason poll.

KGOALE PARTICIPATES IN SOUTH AFRICAN TRAINING CAMP

Nomvula Kgoale, a native of Polokwane, South Africa, was invited to participate with the South African Senior Women's National Team (nickname Banyana Banyana) training camp which was held in Johannesburg from July 23-28.

South Africa has qualified and played in the last two Olympic Games in the United Kingdom (2012) and Brazil (2016).

FORMER LADY TECHSTER JOINS SOCCER STAFF

After spending the last four years as a player on the back line for Louisiana Tech, Charity Simmons will now be on the sideline as an assistant coach.

Simmons saw action in 73 games from 2013-16, including 55 starts, as a defender in helping the program to a 48-30-6 record and qualifying for three conference tournaments.

SLOAN LEAVES LASTING MARK ON PROGRAM

Kathryn Sloan finished her four-year career as one of the most decorated student-athletes in LA Tech history, finishing as the program's all-time leader in points (89) and goals (36) as well as being the first Bulldog/Lady Techster to be selected Academic All-America of the Year.

The Kansas City, Missouri native graduated with a perfect 4.0 grade point average, earning her degree in Communication Arts and Design. She was also a four-time recipient of the Commissioner's Academic Medal, a three-time C-USA All-Academic First Team selection, a three-time All-Conference USA honoree, recipient of the C-USA Scholar Athlete Award, an Arthur Ashe Jr. Sports Scholar and a nominee for the 2017 NCAA Woman of the Year.

HOME SWEET HOME

Ever since the opening of the Lady Techster Soccer Complex in 2009, the team has pretty much dominated the opposition.

- Combined 23-6-2 record at home since 2014, outscoring opponents 83-21
- Record of 14-6 in Conference USA action (2013-16)
- Overall record of 54-19-5 since opening of facility
- Have gone undefeated in non-conference play in five of the seven seasons
- Whopping 35-5-3 home record during non-conference action

Since the program's inception in 2004, the team is an incredible 46-9-6 (.803) in all non-conference home matches, having suffered just three such losses since September of 2010.

Last season, the home win over I-20 foe ULM was a special one as it was the second largest attendance ever with 433 fans. It was also career win No. 50 at our home.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE

LA Tech has qualified for the conference tournament five time in the last seven years. For the first time in program history, the Lady Techsters advanced to the league tourney in back-to-back-to-back seasons. Last year was the earliest the team has ever clinched a spot in the tournament. The previous two times in C-USA, it took a dramatic home win in the regular season finale to seal the deal.

BREAKING DOWN THE SCHEDULE

The 2017 schedule for LA Tech will once again be split into 10 non-conference and 10 in conference with the Lady Techsters hosting nine matches at the Lady Techster Soccer Complex.

The team opens the fall slate with five of their first six matches on the road, starting with the season opener on Aug. 18 at McNeese State. The home opener takes place on Aug. 24 versus SEC foe Mississippi State. It will mark only the second time LA Tech has hosted an SEC opponent in program history (Arkansas in 2007).

C-USA action gets underway on Sept. 17 when UTSA comes to Ruston. LA Tech will face everyone in the league except for UTEP, Florida Atlantic and WKU.

EXCELLENCE IN THE CLASSROOM

The LA Tech soccer players currently have a combined cumulative grade point average of 3.595, the highest it has ever been since the program started up in 2004.

A remarkable 31 Lady Techsters earned recognition to the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll for the 2016-17 academic year. This honor is given to student-athletes who maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.

It was the most ever for LA Tech since joining the league in 2013, breaking last year's total of 28. It was also the most ever by any women's soccer team in the league during that span. It brought their four-year total to a league-best 106.

The impressive academic numbers don't stop there. Of the 31 who made the Commissioner's Honor Roll, 15 of them also earned the Commissioner's Academic Medal which is given to those who maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or better.

This amount was also a program high as well as the most achieved by any of the 14 women's soccer squads in the conference since 2013. It brought their four-year total to 42 Academic Medals earned by 23 players which is also the most of any women's soccer program in the league during that span.

SHERRY RELOADS WITH SIGNEES

Louisiana Tech graduated six key seniors who combined for 50 goals, 38 assists and 238 saves. Head coach Kevin Sherry ended up signing 12 high school players

The coaching staff searched far and wide to find this year's high school signees, from California and Colorado and Wisconsin to outside the country in Canada and Italy. They ended up signing 11 high school players as well as Mississippi State transfer Courtney Tompkins.

2016 RECAP

It was a common theme again in 2016 as LA Tech was picked close to last in the preseason poll, yet the squad finished with a 14-6-1 record, the second most wins in program history.

The team finished fifth in C-USA, the highest for LA Tech since joining C-USA in 2013, while also registering a program-best six league victories which qualified them for a third straight league tournament. They are one of only four teams (along with North Texas, Rice and WKU) to qualify for the conference tournament each of the last three seasons.

The Lady Techsters also set program records with the best road winning percentage (went 8-2) and with six consecutive road victories. After dropping three of the first five C-USA matches, the team proceeded to win four in a row, including a dramatic 2-1 victory at home in double overtime against UAB which clinched a top-8 spot.

LA Tech would ultimately fall, 3-0, as the No. 5 seed to No. 4 Florida Atlantic in the first round of the C-USA Tournament. Helping engineer the success on the pitch was Kathyryn Sloan who became the first player in program history to be named First Team All-Conference USA.

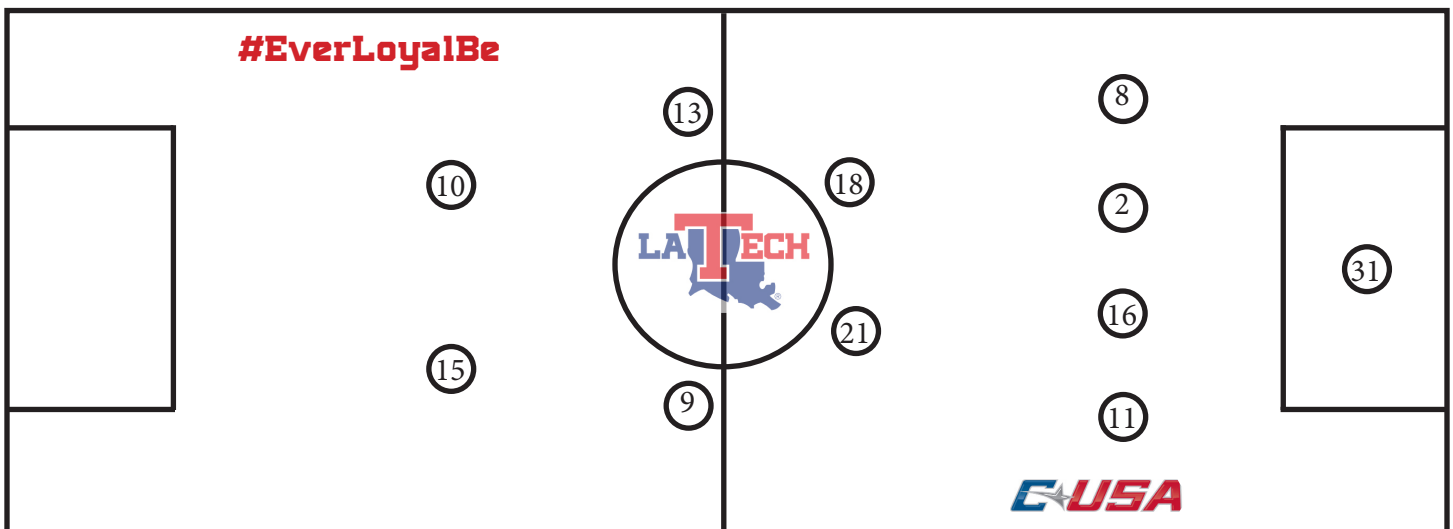
