First Time Freshmen and Upper Division Transfers

Online Application: When you fill out the application online at <http://www.csumentor.edu/> you will be asked to print the document and send in your payment. As a Prospective Student athlete however, we ask that you instead print and send the document and payment immediately to the Head Coach or Lisa Westerfield. The head coach will then submit the document and payment to the Athletic Compliance Assistant.

Lower Division Transfers (less than 60 transferable units by the end of Spring term)

Lower Division transfers need to submit the documentation listed below to the compliance coordinator along with their application:

1. Official transcripts from ALL Colleges attended along with high school transcripts and test scores.
2. Application completely and accurately filled out.
3. Fee (Check, money order or fee waiver application)

Add/Drop classes

Before adding or dropping a class, you should first consult with your academic advisor to be sure that you will not be affecting your academic standing for athletics. Once you have clearance from your counselor, you will need to sign in to your MyCSULB page. Select "Student Center". Go to Academics and under enrollment select "Add a Class" or "Drop a Class."

Placement Test Information

In order to attend any CSU campus and be placed into appropriate level English and Math courses, students should consult their official Notice of Admission to determine whether they are exempt from taking the CSU Placement Exams: the ELM (Entry Level Mathematics) and the EPT (English Placement Test). Financial Aid

All athletic scholarships are handled through coaches and the athletic department. The scholarship amount will

show on your mycsulb account along with any other aid your are receiving.

At Long Beach State, the financial aid office administers a variety of programs including grants, scholarships and loans. To apply for all programs available, the application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be completed. The scholarship and non scholarship athletes may apply for.

Each year, the FAFSA applications must be submitted between January 1 and March 2nd to be considered "first priority". This deadline must be met to be considered for all aid programs and also so that the financial aid is received in time to pay for registration and books.

If the March 2nd filing deadline is not met, you may not be considered for Cal Grants, EOP Grants, Federal Grant, Federal Perkins loan and Federal Work Study..

Housing

The residence halls at CSULB accommodate over 2400 students in five different complexes. Housing contracts are binding for one academic year. Each March each student athlete will sign a new contract if they wish to remain in the residence halls for the next academic year. Once a contract is signed you will be charged a \$100 penalty if you decide to cancel your contract. Cancellations after August 1st (approx date – check the housing website for exact date) along with the \$100 charge an additional per day charge will be assessed.

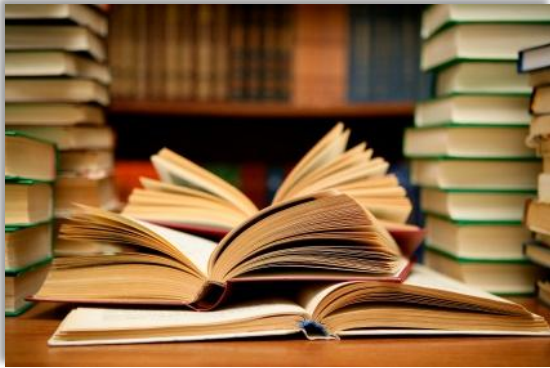

Library Services

Identification Cards: Your CSULB campus ID card serves as your library card. You must have a valid CSULB campus ID in order to use some library materials and equipment. Students should call (562) 985-7388 for additional information regarding photo ID cards.

Loan Periods: The basic loan period for books is 3 weeks. The loan period for media materials (audio cassettes, compact discs, videos, and DVDs) is 7 days. Periodicals and reference materials are not available for check-out.



Renewals: [Books may be renewed](#) (limit of 4 times) at the Circulation Desk or through COAST (unless the book is on hold). Media materials may be renewed 1 time.

Excessive Use Fees: A fee of 25¢ per item per day is assessed for general circulation materials returned past the due date. Overdue fines for Interlibrary Services, LINK+ , Reserve, and Media materials are assessed at a higher rate. Bills for all fees are sent by the University Business Office via mail or email. Payments can be made on [MyCSULB](#) or at the University Business Office. No overdue notices are sent.
