

TANTULUM POINTS

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

* TEAM POINTS: **100 points**-Community Service **NOT** subject to a limit of 3 scoring opportunities per semester

- Teams with less than 11 members must have 90% in attendance
- Teams with 12-25 members must have 75% in attendance in 1 event
- Teams with more than 25 members must have 60% attendance in 1 event

- 100 points will be awarded for the appropriate team percentage for the first hour. For every individual that stays longer Above and Beyond points are then awarded per hour after initial hour.

- 500 points will be awarded for one team community outreach project per year. This project must have 100% team attendance

* INDIVIDUAL POINTS: **5 Points**—must volunteer for 1 hour. For every hour there after above and beyond points will be awarded.

* No points will be awarded for community outreach on team road trips.

Ø COMMUNITY OUTREACH –

Service to the community (Long Beach or other); may be attended as a team or individual event. Must be Voluntary.

TEAM ENHANCEMENT

* TEAM POINTS: **100 points**-Dinners/Team Get-Togethers subject to a limit of 3 (100 pt) scoring opportunities per semester, other team enhancement opportunities are unlimited

- Teams with less than 11 members must have 90% in attendance
- Teams with 12-25 members must have 75% in attendance in 1 event
- Teams with more than 25 members must have 60% attendance in 1 event

*mandatory events will not be awarded points

* No points will be awarded for Team Enhancement on team road trips

* No points will be awarded for Team Enhancement that does not meet team percentages.

Ø TEAM ENHANCEMENT –

As a team, you attend or have presented to you a workshop, speaker, or program that deals with personal, career, or academic development, alcohol awareness, or other pertinent subjects. Topics may include:

- Hazing
 - Betting and gambling
 - Sports nutrition
 - Substance abuse education
 - Sexual harassment
 - Rape prevention
 - Careers and life after athletics
 - Violence prevention
 - Others approved by Candice Chick
 - * Can only do 3 team get-togethers a semester *
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PERSONAL ENHANCEMENT - 2 points per person

Ø PERSONAL ENHANCEMENT –

This is an individual category designed to give points to student-athletes who make extra efforts to better themselves. Points are awarded for attending workshop enhance you as a person, student, job seeker, etc. Topics may be similar to those above or include others such as time management, resume writing, interviewing skills, money management and more. Does not include tutoring.

*Consult with Candice Chick to ensure that points will be awarded for intended program.

ATHLETES SUPPORTING ATHLETES

* TEAM POINTS: **100 points**-Athletes Supporting Athletes **NOT** subject to a limit of 3 scoring opportunities per semester

- Teams with less than 11 members must have 90% in attendance
- Teams with 12-25 members must have 75% in attendance in 1 event
- Teams with more than 25 members must have 60% attendance in 1 event

* INDIVIDUAL POINTS: **2 Points** per person per game attended

* *Above and Beyond points will be awarded for teams/ individuals that demonstrate above and beyond support. Additional points will awarded based on shout outs with a range of 5,10,15,and 25 points based on the representatives discretion. The shout out must be seconded by another representative.*

Ø ATHLETES SUPPORTING ATHLETES –

This can be accomplished by attending the sporting event, hanging posters or signs of encouragement in the locker rooms, or any other creative way of supporting your fellow student-athletes(be creative in the category).

SAAC LEADERSHIP/ATTENDENCE

5 points for each Rep. for attending SAAC Meetings

50 points for Elected SAAC position awarded to that team once a year.

10 point Deduction for each Rep. missing a SAAC meeting unexcused.

10 points for relaying the monthly SAAC information to the representative's team.

100 points Deduction for Elected members that do not fulfill responsibilities for their entire term

Ø SAAC LEADERSHIP/ATTENDENCE –

Points are awarded every time the SAAC representative attends the SAAC meetings and participates in SAAC activities. Non-SAAC representatives may earn points for attending meetings and participating in activities. Elected SAAC Board Members earn points for holding a position for the year. Points may be awarded or deducted for returning or failing to return feedback forms for meetings.

HIGHEST TEAM GPA (*These points will be awarded after Fall semester only*)

First 100 points

Second place 50 points

Third place 25 points

25 points will be awarded for the team with the largest percentage of people on the Athletic ALL Star list (must have 12 units and a 3.0 GPA) by the end of the Fall semester.

Ø HIGHEST TEAM GPA –

Awarded after the fall semester to the first, second, and third place teams. The team with the largest percentage of people on the **Athletic Rising Star list** (must have 12 units and a 3.0 GPA) by the end of the Fall semester.

ABOVE AND BEYOND

5 points per person for an approved completed activity

5 points per hour/ per person for Community Outreach after the initial hour

Ø ABOVE AND BEYOND –

Individuals who go above and beyond normal expectations for participation earn points; these student-athletes go the extra mile or accomplish something that deserves recognition.

- 1) The Life Skills “CHAMPS CUP” Activity *Form must be completed by the monthly SAAC meeting following the activity and verification of involvement must accompany the form.* Verification includes:
 - I. Signature from outreach agency representative and phone number.
 - II. Signature from speaker or program representatives, the event program, or ticket stub for team or personal enhancement activities.
 - III. Ticket stub from athletic event or signature from a member of the athletic Administrative staff (Candice Chick, our Faculty Athletic Rep, etc.) present at the athletic event.
- 2) No “autograph sessions” can count as team outreach points as (only some teams get the chance to partake in autographing).
- 3) No points can be awarded if an individual is **working** at an **event** or getting **paid** to work in the community.
- 4) No points will be awarded for mandatory events.
- 5) Verification of individual or team activity must be completed by obtaining the signature of either an agency representative (Outreach), administrator, educator, Faculty Athletic Representative, or athletics staff along with ticket stubs, event programs, or other written documentation.
- 6) Points will be posted at the beginning of every new month on **BeachBoard** and on the “CHAMPS CUP” sheets handed out at monthly SAAC meetings
- 7) Props shout out by another team at the monthly SAAC meetings
 - I. 1 representative is allotted one shout out per monthly SAAC meeting.

Counting Points

- 1) The vice president oversees the counting committee; the vice president can not count TANTALUM points.
- 2) The counting committee is made of six representatives all from separate teams.
- 3) Committee members cannot count their own team’s points.
- 4) The top three teams cannot count the points of the other teams within the top three rankings.
- 5) Points will be counted 15 minutes before each monthly SAAC meeting.
