BLAIR FIELD RENOVATION PROJECT

~\$17 million project

Phase I – Batting Cages = ~\$2.2 million

Phase I will include the construction of new batting cages, construction of a new outfield fence, construction of home and visiting team bullpens, and demolition and preparation work.

Phase II – Practice Infield = TBD

Phase II will include the construction of a new practice infield facility, demolition and preparation work, and reconfiguration of a new facility parking lot.

Phase III – Clubhouse = TBD

The clubhouse will instantly become a state-of-the-art home that will include a team locker room, team meeting area, sports medicine area, Hall of Legends Lobby, equipment rooms, coach's offices, and more.

Phase IV – Grandstand Upgrades = TBD

Phase IV will include significant upgrades to the look and feel of the entrance way and surrounding views of the ball park, and the renovation of the public restrooms and concession/kitchen areas.
