49ERS BEGIN SECOND HALF OF BIG WEST PLAY ON THE ROAD; HEAD TO UC IRVINE, UC RIVERSIDE THIS WEEK

The Long Beach State women's basketball team begins the second half of its Big West slate on the road this week as it travels to UC Irvine and UC Riverside.

The 49ers, who are in search of their first conference road win, will face the Anteaters on Thursday, Feb. 2, at 5 p.m. at Bren Events Center. LBSU then makes its way to UCR's Student Recreation Center on Saturday, Feb. 4, for a 3 p.m. showdown with the Highlanders.

SCOUTING THE ANTEATERS

UC Irvine (9-12, 5-3 Big West) suffered a pair of home losses last week, falling to Seattle, 86-58, and UC Riverside, 70-67. Kassandra McCalister has paced the Anteaters with 11.7 points per game and a Big West leading 4.2 assists per contest. Jazmyne White and Methlyn Onogomuho have also averaged a team-best 6.0 rebounds per outing.

SERIES RECORD

Long Beach State leads in its all-time series with UC Irvine, 49-10. The 49ers have won the last two meetings, including a 63-51 victory at the Walter Pyramid on Dec. 31, 2011. LBSU has also prevailed in six of the last 10 outings and is 24-3 when playing in Irvine.

A GLANCE AT UC RIVERSIDE

After starting off conference play with six straight losses, UC Riverside (4-16, 2-6 Big West) has posted two consecutive victories with a 69-65 win over Cal State Fullerton and a 70-67 triumph at UC Irvine. Tre'Shonti Nottingham leads

**HEAD COACH
JODY WYNN
Third Season**

Jody Wynn enters her third year at the helm of the Long Beach State women's basketball program. Wynn became the sixth head coach in 49er history on April 7, 2009.

LBSU had failed to advance to the conference tournament the year before her arrival, but Wynn has now guided the 49ers to consecutive postseason appearances. In her first year at Long Beach State, Wynn led the team to a fourth-place finish in league play and a spot in the Big West Tournament quarterfinals.

The 49ers, who swept eventual Big West Tournament champion UC Riverside and defending Big West champion UC Santa Barbara during the regular season, closed out the campaign with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-7 mark in conference action. Three 49ers were named to the all-conference team with Karina Figueroa earning first-team honors. Figueroa was the first LBSU player to receive first-team recognition since Crystal McCutcheon in 2006.

In 2010-11, Long Beach State finished sixth in the Big West and had two players named to the all-conference team. The 49ers also claimed the Big West Freshman of the Year and the Big West Hustle Player of the Year awards.

Wynn came to LBSU with 13 years of collegiate coaching experience under her belt. In her five seasons as the senior assistant at USC, she was in charge of bringing in four nationally-ranked recruiting classes, including the No. 1-ranked group in 2006. On the court, Wynn coached seven All-Pac 10 performers, a conference freshman of the year and a WNBA draft pick.

Wynn entered the coaching ranks in 1996-97 as an assistant at Pepperdine under former USC head coach Mark Trakh. She helped the Waves to six postseason appearances, including three bids to the NCAA Tournament. In her eight seasons in Malibu, Pepperdine had six 20-win campaigns and captured four West Coast Conference championships.

The Brea, Calif., native was a four-year letterwinner and starting guard at USC from 1993-96. During her playing career, the Trojans compiled a record of 79-35 (.693), won the 1994 Pac-10 Conference championship and made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

Wynn was also a prep standout at Brea Olinda High School, where she guided the Ladycats to three California state championships. She earned CIF Southern Section and Orange County Player of the Year accolades in 1991 and 1992, while also being tabbed a *USA Today* and *Streets & Smith* honorable mention All-American.

Wynn earned her bachelor's degree in exercise science from USC in 1996 and attained a master's in education from Pepperdine in 2000. The former Jody Anton is married to Derek Wynn and the couple has two daughters, Jada and Kaeli.

the Highlanders and ranks third in the Big West with 15.2 points per game. She is also tops on the team with 65 assists (3.6/game). Natasha Hadley has chipped in 12.6 points per outing, while Jessica Ogunnorin is the team's leading rebounder with 6.9 boards per contest.

SERIES RECORD

Long Beach State trails in its all-time series with UC Riverside, 14-12, but claimed the most recent meeting with a 70-59 victory at the Walter Pyramid on Dec. 29, 2011. LBSU is 5-7 when playing in Riverside.

LAST TIME OUT

Long Beach State continued to struggle on the road with a 74-53 loss at Cal State Fullerton last Saturday. Freshmen Alex Sanchez and Bianca Balthazar led the 49ers with 11 points each, while Tipesa Moorer chipped in 10. Jhakia McDonald added five points and a team-high five rebounds.

MOORER DOUBLES UP

Senior Tipesa Moorer (Harbor City, Calif.) has reached double figures in scoring in 17 of Long Beach State's 21 games. She was named the Big West Player of the Week on Jan. 23, after leading the 49ers to a pair of key conference wins with 14 points against UC Santa Barbara and 16 points vs. Cal Poly.

Earlier in the season, Moorer poured in a career-high 24 points on a 10-for-14 shooting performance at UC Davis (Jan. 14). She has also registered two double-doubles with 18 points and 11 rebounds in an overtime win against Nevada, and 13 points and 11 boards in the opener vs. Utah Valley. Moorer was named to the Beach Classic All-Tournament Team after propelling LBSU into the championship game. On the year, she is tops on the squad and ranks fifth in the Big West with 12.7 points per outing.

TRIPLE THREAT

Redshirt freshman Alex Sanchez is tops on the team with 5.3 rebounds per game and also ranks second on the squad in scoring (9.0 ppg) and assists (3.2 apg). The Anaheim native has reached double figures 11 times with a career-high 20 points at Washington. She came close to matching that total with 18 points (8-for-10) vs. UC Irvine. Sanchez notched her first double-double of her 49er career with 17 points and 10 rebounds at Sacramento State. She also had a career-best eight assists in a win over Western Michigan.

BACK AND BETTER

After being sidelined for eight games with an injury, freshman Devin Hudson has returned to the lineup with a newfound confidence. She had a breakout performance at Pacific and UC Davis

three weekends ago. Against the Tigers, she went 3-for-4 from the field to finish with six points, while also pulling down five rebounds. The Ontario, Calif., native then earned her first start two days later at UC Davis and made the most of the opportunity, registering a double-double with a career-best 14 points and 12 rebounds. She also compiled 10 boards against UC Santa Barbara and had 11 points vs. Cal Poly. In the five games since her return to the lineup, Hudson is averaging 8.2 points and 7.6 rebounds.

MCDONALD HITS THE MARK

Junior Jhakia McDonald netted a career-high 14 points on a 4-for-6 shooting performance in a 74-67 win over Cal Poly. She sparked the 49ers late in the game, making a couple key defensive plays and sinking 4-of-6 free throws down the stretch. McDonald's previous best was 12 points vs. Cal State Northridge on Jan. 7. The Anaheim native also reached double figures at Columbia with 11 points. On the season, McDonald is averaging 5.5 points per game.

SOMETHING ABOUT MARY

Junior Mary Ochiltree has provided a steady presence for the 49ers all season as she is third on the team with 7.2 points per contest. The Lake Stevens, Wash., native produced a streak of five-straight games from Dec. 16-31, in which she reached double figures. Over that span, she averaged 13 points and made 64.1 percent of her shots. Ochiltree drained a season-high 17 points, making eight field goals on 12 attempts, in a 76-56 victory against Western Michigan. She also totaled 13 points vs. Wichita State in the Beach Classic championship game, earning her all-tournament honors. Ochiltree kept the hot hand in the Big West opener against UC Riverside as she totaled 14 points on a 5-for-6 performance from the field.

SPARGO PROVIDES THE SPARK

Freshman Lauren Spargo has provided a spark off the bench as she is averaging 7.1 points per game. She drained three 3-pointers en route to a game-high 15 points against Cal State Northridge on Jan. 7. Earlier in the season, Spargo matched her career best with 16 points in a 66-52 victory over Dartmouth (Dec. 16). With the 49ers trailing by seven, Spargo entered the game and scored eight unanswered points to give LBSU the lead for good. Two days later, the Santa Clarita native set a new career high with 18 points in a 76-56 win over Western Michigan. She went 7-for-15 from the field with four 3-pointers. Her efforts earned her Big West Player of the Week honors on Dec. 19. Spargo also reached double figures with 16 points at Iona.

"D" FOR DOOLEY

Redshirt freshman Chantel Dooley has been one of Long Beach State's top defenders this year. Dooley's pressure defense has led to her accumulating a team-best 31 steals. She is also tied for eighth in the Big West with 1.72 steals per game. The Northridge native has been solid on the offensive end as well, averaging 4.8 points per contest. Dooley has reached double figures twice with 11 points at Columbia and 10 points vs. Wichita State.

MENESES AT THE POINT

Hallie Meneses has been the 49ers' starting point guard in all but two games in her first year at Long Beach State. The sophomore transfer from the City College of San Francisco ranks sixth in the Big West with 3.4 assists per contest and is also averaging 4.5 points per outing. Three weeks ago, Meneses dished out a career-best eight helpers at Pacific and compiled five points, six assists and four steals at UC Davis. She also scored a season-high 14 points at Seattle (Dec. 2) and had her best all-around performance at Iona College (Nov. 26) where she finished with 12 points, seven assists and no turnovers.

BACK ON TRACK

After missing four games with an injury, Balthazar came back to average 5.5 points at Seattle (Dec. 2) and Washington (Dec. 4) in her first action since Nov. 13. Balthazar then erupted for a season-high 16 points in a win against Nevada on Dec. 8. Balthazar also reached double figures with 11 points at Cal State Fullerton and vs. Utah Valley. She is fifth on the squad with 6.2 points per game.

CLARK'S BLOCK PARTY - THE SEQUEL

Sophomore Ella Clark, who established a 49er freshman record with 55 blocks last year, swatted away 18 shots in LBSU's first seven games. She finished with a career-best seven blocks in the season opener against Utah Valley, which ranks her third in LBSU single-game history. Clark will sit out the remainder of the season due to a shoulder injury.

BETTER AT HOME

Long Beach State has posted an impressive 8-2 home record this season. LBSU has outscored its opponents 645-550 and is shooting 40 percent when playing at the Walter Pyramid. The 49ers opened the season with a 75-43 rout of Utah Valley (Nov. 11), before topping Nevada in overtime, 61-58, nearly a month later on Dec. 8. They remained perfect at home with wins over Dartmouth and Western Michigan, before suffering a 73-64 double overtime loss to Wichita State in the championship game of the Beach Classic. Long Beach State also began its Big West slate with home wins over UC Riverside and UC Irvine and picked up a pair of victories over UC Santa Barbara and Cal Poly two weeks ago.

ROAD WOES

On the flip side, the 49ers have struggled on the road with a 1-10 away record. Long Beach State has been outscored, 836-623, and is shooting just 35.4 percent in those games.

STARTING OFF RIGHT

The 49ers picked up a pair of wins during the opening week of Big West action for the first time since the 2005-06 season when they won their first seven games en route to a share of the Big West regular season title.

LBSU INKS TWO FOR 2012-13

Long Beach State women's basketball head coach Jody Wynn announced the signing of Yana Dellavedova and Gabby Kaiser to National Letters of Intent. The duo will join the 49ers in 2012-13.

Dellavedova is a 5-foot-11 guard who hails from Australia. She is the co-captain of her high school team and led the squad to the conference championship, averaging 12 points per game. Dellavedova has also represented Victoria Country at the U-18 and U-16 National Championships.

Kaiser is currently a senior at Mission Viejo High School. The 6-foot-2 forward averaged 20.8 points and 6.1 rebounds per game last year. She led the Diablos to the Division 2AA CIF-Southern Section playoffs and was named to the South Coast Holiday Classic All-Tournament Team.
