49ERS BEGIN QUEST FOR BIG WEST TOURNAMENT TITLE AGAINST CAL STATE FULLERTON ON TUESDAY

The fifth-seeded Long Beach State women's basketball team begins its quest for the Big Tournament title on Tuesday, March 12, when it takes on No. 8 Cal State Fullerton in a first-round game. Tip-off is set for 6 p.m. at the Bren Events Center in Irvine.

49ERS IN THE BIG WEST TOURNAMENT

LBSU, which has earned its fourth-straight Big West Tournament berth under head coach Jody Wynn, is 34-21 overall in Big West Tournament games. The 49ers' last tournament title came in 1991. Last year, Long Beach State advanced to the championship game, but fell to UC Santa Barbara.

The 49ers are 2-1 against Cal State Fullerton in postseason play. The last time the two teams met in the Big West Tournament was in a quarterfinal match-up on March 8, 2008. The Titans ended up winning, 69-51, at the Anaheim Convention Center.

HUDSON, SANCHEZ NAMED ALL-BIG WEST

Sophomores Devin Hudson and Alex Sanchez were named to the All-Big West Team the conference office announced Monday. The duo, which has guided the 49ers to their best season since 2005-06, earned honorable mention recognition. Hudson has become a force to be reckoned with in the Big West, where she is averaging a team-best 11.6 points and 9.8 rebounds per game. Hudson has eight double-doubles, six of which came in conference play. She also has 15 double-figure scoring games and 11 double-figure rebounding games. Sanchez, meanwhile, is LBSU's floor leader with a career-high 123 assists. She ranks second in the Big West with 4.1 helpers per outing. Sanchez also has 17 double-figure scoring games, including 10 in Big West action.

SCOUTING THE TITANS

After struggling through a nine-game losing streak, Cal State Fullerton (9-21, 5-13 Big West) made a late push as wins over UC Davis and UC Santa Barbara helped it claim the eighth and final spot in the Big West Tournament. The Titans, however, ended up dropping their final three regular season games. Chante Miles has paced CSF with 10.6 points, 2.9 assists and 2.0 steals per game, while Kathleen Iwuoha is tops on the team with 7.0 rebounds per outing.

**HEAD COACH
JODY WYNN
Fourth Season**

Jody Wynn is in her fourth year at the helm of the Long Beach State women's basketball program.

Since her arrival at LBSU, the 49ers have seen rapid improvements with two double-

figure win campaigns and an appearance in the Big West Tournament championship game.

Last year, Long Beach State qualified for its third-straight Big West Tournament under the guidance of Wynn, and found itself one victory away from earning an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The 49ers became the first team in Big West history to defeat the top two seeds en route to their first championship appearance in 11 years. Three 49ers were named to the all-tournament team, while Wynn also saw two of her athletes, Tipesa Moorer and Alex Sanchez, garner All-Big West honors. LBSU finished the season with an overall record of 14-18, marking the most wins by a 49er squad since the 2005-06 season.

In her first year at Long Beach State (2009-10), Wynn led a senior-laden squad to a fourth-place finish in conference play and an appearance in the quarterfinals of the Big West Tournament. LBSU closed out the campaign with a 13-17 overall record and a 9-7 mark in conference action.

In 2010-11, LBSU finished sixth in the Big West and had two players named to the all-conference team. The 49ers also claimed the Big West Freshman of the Year and the Big West Hustle Player of the Year awards.

Wynn came to Long Beach State with 13 years of collegiate coaching experience. She spent five seasons as the senior assistant, recruiting coordinator and head of scouting at USC, where she was in charge of bringing in four nationally-ranked recruiting classes, including the No. 1-ranked group in 2006. On the court, Wynn coached seven All-Pac 10 performers, a conference freshman of the year and a WNBA draft pick.

Wynn entered the coaching ranks in 1996-97 as an assistant at Pepperdine. She helped the Waves to six postseason appearances, including three bids to the NCAA Tournament. In her eight seasons in Malibu, Pepperdine had six 20-win campaigns and captured four West Coast Conference championships.

The Brea, Calif., native was a four-year letterwinner and starting guard at USC from 1993-96. During her playing career, the Trojans won the 1994 Pac-10 Conference championship and made three consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances.

Wynn earned her bachelor's degree in exercise science from USC in 1996 and attained a master's in education from Pepperdine in 2000.

The former Jody Anton is married to Derek Wynn and the couple has two daughters, Jada and Kaeli.

SERIES RECORD

Long Beach State leads in its all-time series with Cal State Fullerton, 65-38. The 49ers swept the regular-season series, defeating the Titans, 45-39, in Long Beach and 58-56 in Fullerton. Devin Hudson averaged 11.5 points and 10.5 rebounds, while Alex Sanchez averaged 9.0 points and 4.0 steals in the two outings.

LAST TIME OUT

Behind a monster performance from Devin Hudson, Long Beach State closed out the regular season on a high note, taking down Cal Poly, 71-58, last Saturday at Mott Gym. Hudson finished with a career-high 22 points and 20 rebounds. It was her first career 20-point performance and she also became the first 49er to have a 20-rebound game since 2005. Alex Sanchez added 16 points and four assists, while Lauren Spargo totaled 12 points. LBSU used a strong second half, in which it shot 60 percent from the floor, to overcome a five-point halftime deficit. They ended up outscoring the Mustangs, 44-26, over the final 20 minutes.

TWENTY-TWENTY

Sophomore Devin Hudson was dominant in a 71-58 win in the regular-season finale at Cal Poly as she finished with career-highs in points (22) and rebounds (20). She is the first 49er to have a 20-point and 20-rebound game since Melissa Gower posted 22 and 20 vs. Nevada on Jan. 13, 1995. Hudson is the seventh player in program history to accomplish the 20-20 feat.

10 AND COUNTING

The 49ers secured their third double-figure win campaign in the last four years with a 45-39 triumph against Cal State Fullerton on Jan. 19. LBSU had not reached the 10-win plateau in three-straight seasons before Coach Wynn's arrival in 2009-10. Long Beach State has also posted the most victories (16) in a season during the Wynn era and the most since going 18-10 in 2005-06.

BALANCED EFFORT

Long Beach State has shown its depth with nine of its 10 players reaching double digits in the points column at least once this season. Eight 49ers have also had multiple double-figure scoring games.

LIVE AND DIE BY THE THREE

LBSU has depended heavily on its performance from behind the arc this season. In their 16 wins, the 49ers shot a combined 38.1 percent (109-286) from long distance. They were at or over 40 percent in nine of those games and made at least 10 3-pointers on three occasions, including a season-high 12 vs. Canisius. On the flip side, Long Beach State is just 54-for-250 (21.6 percent) in its 14 losses. The 49ers rank fourth in the Big West in 3-point field goals made (163) and attempted (536), and are also fifth in 3-point field goal percentage (30.4).

FOR THE RECORD

Senior Mary Ochiltree is currently seventh in program history in career 3-point field goal percentage (36.1). Sophomore Ella Clark is also eighth among the 49er all-time leaders with 117 career blocks, while classmate Lauren Spargo ranks 10th with 265 3-point field goals attempted.

TRIPLE THREAT

Sophomore Alex Sanchez has continued to produce in every aspect on the court. She leads the team with 10.8 points, 4.1 assists and 1.6 steals per game, while ranking second with 4.4 rebounds per outing. Sanchez, who notched a season-high 19 points at Utah Valley, has reached double figures in scoring in 17 games. She has led LBSU in the points column 11 times and has finished tops on the squad in assists on 23 occasions.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIME

Devin Hudson registered her eighth double-double of the season in a big way as she totaled a career-high 22 points and 20 rebounds at Cal Poly (March 9). Two days earlier, she had 13 points and 10 rebounds at UC Santa Barbara. In other notable performances, Hudson totaled 15 points and a then career-high 16 rebounds vs. Big West regular season champion Pacific, 10 points and 15 boards vs. UC Riverside and a then career-best 17 points and 14 rebounds vs. Cal State Fullerton. Hudson has led LBSU on the glass 20 times, corralling at least 10 rebounds on 11 occasions. She has also reached double figures in scoring 15 times. Hudson is averaging 11.6 points and 9.8 rebounds against Big West opponents.

BALTHAZAR TAKES CHARGE

Sophomore Bianka Balthazar has reached double figures in scoring 12 times this season. She recently had a game-high 14 points at UC Santa Barbara. Earlier in the year, Balthazar poured in a career-high 17 points on a 6-for-9 shooting performance in a 79-50 win over Columbia, and later matched that point total at Hawai'i on Jan. 13. On the season, she is third on the team with 9.2 points per contest.

DOOLEY DOES MORE THAN DEFEND

Sophomore Chantel Dooley is known as a lock-down defender, but she has also displayed her scoring potential on several occasions. Against Sacramento State, Dooley was 7-of-13 from the floor for a career-high 19 points. In addition, she had 12 points at Utah Valley, 11 points against Iona and 10 points vs. Canisius. She registered her first double-double with 10 points and a career-best 11 rebounds vs. UC Davis (March 2). Dooley continues to be one of the 49ers' top defenders as she is second on the team with 45 steals. She had a career-high seven steals in the season opener against Sac State.

CLARK'S RETURN

Ella Clark, who sat out last season with an injury, has nine double-figure scoring games on the year, including four in the last seven outings. She had a season-best 17 points vs. Hawai'i (Feb. 7) and pulled down a career-high 11 boards at Pacific (Feb. 2). Prior to Big West play, Clark was named the MVP of the Beach Classic after leading the 49ers to the tournament title with 16 points against Canisius, and 14 points and a career-best six assists vs. Sam Houston State. She matched that assist total at Cal Poly on March 9. Clark has also made her presence felt on the defensive end with a team-high 44 blocks.

SPARGO FOR THREE

Sophomore Lauren Spargo is tops on the team with 38 3-pointers made. She has more than one trey in 11 games, including a career-high four against Washington (13 points) and Canisius (14 points). She also totaled a season-high 16 points vs. UC Irvine on Jan. 26, and had 15 points vs. UC Davis on March 2. The Santa Clarita, Calif., native has made 77 shots from long distance in her one-plus year career at LBSU, which puts her six away from breaking into the 49er all-time records.

SANCHEZ NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Alex Sanchez earned her first career Big West Player of the Week honor on Jan. 7. The Anaheim, Calif., native was recognized after leading the 49ers to a 2-0 start in conference play. Sanchez averaged 13.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 2.0 steals in a pair of wins over Cal Poly (Jan. 3) and UC Santa Barbara (Jan. 5).

FINDING THE OFFENSE

They were also over 50 percent from the floor when they registered a season-best 80 points at UC Riverside (Feb. 16). It was the most points scored by LBSU since an 80-79 victory over UC Irvine on Jan. 22, 2011.

In January, Long Beach State also broke out of a shooting slump with one of its best offensive performances of the season in a win over UC Irvine (Jan. 26). Against the Anteaters, the 49ers made a then season-high 48.1 percent of their shots and also went 9-for-18 from behind the arc. Prior to that, LBSU had registered a 29.3 field goal percentage and was 14.7 percent from long distance over a three-game losing streak from Jan. 9-17.

GETTING TO THE LINE

In Long Beach State's first 10 Big West games, it got to the foul line about 19 times per contest. The 49ers significantly increased that number over their three-game win streak from Feb. 9-16, averaging 30 free throw attempts per outing during that stretch. They went to the line a season-high 38 times against Cal State Northridge (Feb. 9) and 29 times at Cal State Fullerton (Feb. 14).

DOWN TO THE WIRE

Nineteen of Long Beach State's 30 games have been decided by less than 10 points. Four of those contests went down to the final seconds as the 49ers dropped a pair of buzzer beaters to Iona (60-58) and Santa Clara (68-67), while making the game-winning free throw with 0.6 seconds left in a 50-49 win over Sam Houston State. LBSU was then returned the favor on Jan. 17 as it came out on the short end of a 50-49 score against UC Riverside after the Highlanders made a free throw with 2.0 seconds on the clock.

ON THE REBOUND

Long Beach State, which has won the battle on the boards 16 times this season, outrebounded UC Riverside, 53-33, on Jan. 17. The 49ers' 53 rebounds were a season best, and the plus-20 margin was their largest since holding a 57-35 edge over Seattle on Feb. 4, 2011. LBSU also posted a double-figure advantage on the boards vs. UC Davis (44-32), at Pacific (50-39), vs. Columbia (50-34) and vs. Arizona (43-27) this year.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Dating back to 2011-12, LBSU has won 22 of its last 30 games at the Walter Pyramid. The 49ers are 12-5 this season, with three of their home losses being decided in the final seconds.

AGAINST THE PAC-12

LBSU made a statement during the non-conference season, going 2-1 against Pac-12 teams. Long Beach State, which defeated both Washington and Arizona, finished with two wins vs. the Pac-12 (formerly Pac-10) for the first time in 13 years. The 49ers' only loss came to perennial national power and then No. 1-ranked Stanford.

REMEMBERING MONICA QUAN

The 49er coaching staff will be wearing orange ribbons for the remainder of the season in remembrance of Monica Quan, the Cal State Fullerton assistant coach who tragically lost her life. Monica was in her second year at CSF and was a former 49er student-athlete as a member of the women's basketball team from 2002-05. She went on to conclude her playing career at Concordia (Irvine) where she graduated in 2007.

INJURY REPORT

Sophomore Sigrid Skorpen will be out for the remainder of the season with an ACL injury. Junior Hallie Meneses has also been out the entire year after suffering an ACL injury in October. In addition, freshman Yana Dellavedova had a career-ending back injury and has returned to her hometown in Australia.

49ERS INK THREE FOR 2013-14

Long Beach State signed three high school seniors to National Letters of Intent head coach Jody Wynn announced on Nov. 14. Anna Kim, Madison Montgomery and Brianna Throop will join the 49ers for the 2013-14 season.
