Kim Sowder, Head Coach - 15th year overall. Kim took the helm on August 18, 2006 after long time Head Coach Pete Manarino's retirement. During her tenure the 49ers have compiled a .626 overall winning percentage, six conference championships, and have made 11 NCAA appearances. Kim was a 1998 inductee into the Long Beach State Athletics Hall of Fame, and a former All-American shortstop.



Stephanie Swenson, Assistant Coach - 7th year. Swenson was a standout pitcher at UCLA under former Bruin coach Sue Enquist. Swenson was an honorable mention All-Pac-10 selection in 2000. She posted a 10-1 record with five shutouts and three one-hitters. Swenson finished the 2000 campaign with a 0.81 ERA in 77.2 innings pitched. After her playing days, Swenson helped out the Bruin coaching staff with recruiting.



Tairia Flowers, Assistant Coach - 4th year. A four-year letterwinner at UCLA, four-time Women's College World Series participant and two time All-American. Flowers has been a member of the USA National Team since 2001, winning gold medals at the 2003 & 2007 Pan Am games, the 2002 and 2006 World Championships, 2001 U.S. Cup, and 2004 Olympics along with a Silver medal at the 2008 games in Beijing.



Ralph Levy, Volunteer Assistant - 21st year. Ralph brings a wealth of knowledge to Long Beach State as he starts his 21st year as volunteer assistant. Levy's duties include assisting Head Coach Kim Sowder with game preparation and management. Levy's association with the Long Beach State softball program began in 1984 under longtime former Head Coach Pete Manarino. Levy was Manarino's good friend and classmate at Pius X High School in Downey (Class of 1971).

- ❖ **Fees:** \$140.00 if signed up before August 1st

- ❖ **Required Equipment:** Each camper must bring her own bat, glove, helmet, and cleats.
- ❖ **Registrations:** Complete the attached registration form and mail in with payment. Final registration will be the first day of each camp, provided space is available. All cancellations are subject to a \$25.00 processing fee prior to camp date. Once camp application is received, a confirmation letter, parking permit, and directions will be mailed to you.
