### General Information

Camp will be located on the beautiful Loyola College campus, home site of one of the nation's top lacrosse programs. In this collegiate setting, campers enjoy a unique living and learning experience. They are housed in modern, *air conditioned* residence halls and eat hearty, nutritious meals in the dining hall. All sessions are conducted on campus at Loyola's modern sports tech turf. During free time the campers will have access to Loyola's Fitness & Aquatics Center. To insure a proper coach / goalie ratio, enrollment will be limited.

### Equipment

The Greyhound Goalie Camp does not supply helmets, sticks, pads or gloves. All participants are expected to provide their own equipment and mouth pieces.

## Eligibility and Fees

This camp is only for boys ages 12-17. Graduating seniors ARE eligible. The total cost of \$550 includes lodging, meals, full instruction and a camp reversible. A \$200 deposit is required with the returned application. The balance is due 2 weeks prior to registration. Day camper fee is \$400 (includes lunch and dinner).

**A letter confirming receipt of your application** and deposit will be mailed immediately. You will also receive our medical form to be completed by your physician. Please contact our office if you did not receive this correspondence.

## REGISTRATION

**July 8, 2009 • 2:00 - 4:00 PM**

- Check-in will be held at the dormitory complex where the campers will be housed. Loyola College is located on 4501 North Charles Street, in Baltimore, MD.
- Balance of camp fee is due two weeks prior to registration.
- Room key deposit of \$90.00. This is a fully refundable, provided the card key and room keys are returned and there is no damage to the room or hall.
- Medical forms not previously mailed must be turned in at registration. An Athletic Trainer will be at registration should you have specific needs or medical questions.
- An opening session will be held immediately following registration. Following the evening meal, the first full instructional session will begin at 6:15 PM.
