Equipment

- Check-in will be held at the dormitory complex where the campers will be housed. Loyola University is located at 4501 N. Charles Street; Baltimore, Md., 21210.
- Balance of camp fee is due two weeks prior to registration.
- Room key deposit of \$90. This is fully refundable provided the key card and room keys are returned and there is no damage to the room or hall.
- Medical forms not previously mailed must be turned in at registration. An athletic trainer will be at registration should you have any specific needs or questions.
- An opening session will be held immediate following registration. Following the evening meal, the first instructional session will begin at 6:15 p.m.

- No lunch is served on check-out day. Rooms will be inspected and key deposits mailed back after housing releases them.
