- Tour the Loyola College facilities
- Attend a position specific clinic run by college players and coaches
- Have fun!

Camps are located on the beautiful Loyola College campus, home site of one of the nation's top lacrosse programs. In this collegiate setting, campers enjoy a unique living and learning experience. They are housed in modern, *air conditioned* residence halls and eat hearty, nutritious meals in the dining hall.

All programs are conducted on the nearby playing fields with modern sports tech turf. During free time, campers have full use of the recreational facilities and game rooms.

### **Eligibility & Fees**

Boys grades 9 to 11 (grade as of September 2008) are eligible. The total cost of \$350 includes lodging, meals, insurance, full instruction and counseling, films and an STX reversible jersey. A \$150 deposit for overnight campers (nonrefundable after June 25th) and a \$50 deposit for day campers (nonrefundable after June 25th) is required with returned applications. The balance is due two weeks prior to the start of camp. After receiving the application, a confirmation letter will be sent to you.

### **Equipment**

The Greyhound Lacrosse Camp does not supply helmets, sticks, pads or gloves. All participants are expected to provide their own equipment and mouth pieces.
