## 2011-12 PREVIEW

The Loyola University Maryland women's basketball team is coming off one of its most successful seasons in program history in 2010-11, finishing 21-13 overall and advancing to the second round of the Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Greyhounds set the school record for most conference wins in a season (15), tied the mark for most wins (21) and won their first ever postseason game by knocking off Old Dominion on the road in the first



round of the WNIT. Loyola placed second in the MAAC regular-season standings and reached the finals of the 2011 MAAC Championship before falling to Marist.

The Greyhounds look primed for another historical run in 2011-12, returning nine players from last year's squad including three starters. Miriam McKenzie, Katie Sheahin and Alyssa Sutherland will lead a solid core that is loaded with talent and experience from a great run a year ago. Head coach Joe Logan also has brought in four players for this year's freshmen class who will figure into the Greyhound rotation as the season progresses.

The Greyhounds will have to replace two very important pieces from the 2010-11 team in Erica DiClemente and Meredith Tolley, who were lost to graduation. DiClemente graduated as the ninth-leading scorer in Loyola history with 1,123 career points, while Tolley set the Greyhound all-time mark in made three-point field goals with 150.

Here is a preview of the 2011-12 Greyhounds:

### The Returners

#### Guards

With several returning veterans and two promising newcomers, the Greyhounds have depth at the guard positions entering this season. Loyola returns arguably two of the top guards in the MAAC in **Miriam McKenzie** and **Katie Sheahin**. McKenzie, a senior from Columbia, Md., led Loyola in scoring (14.0 per game) and rebounding (7.4 per game) while being named to the All-MAAC First Team and the 2011 Spark Energy MAAC All-Tournament team. She started 33 games for the Greyhounds, averaging 30.7 minutes and shooting 40.3-percent from the field.

McKenzie also ranks among the best to ever put on a Green and Grey uniform. The senior sits 19th on the all-time career scoring list with 1,008 points and ninth in three-point field goals made with 71.

Sheahin had her coming out party as a sophomore and became the first Greyhound to be named MAAC Defensive Player of the Year. Sheahin also was named to the Spark Energy MAAC All-Tournament team and was an All-MAAC Second Team honoree. The junior ranked second on the team in scoring (13.1 per game) and rebounding (6.0 per game). Sheahin led the team in minutes played, averaging 35.4 minutes per game. She finished the year ranked second in the nation and first in the MAAC in steals with 118.

Senior **Candice Walker** will likely start as part of Logan's three-guard set and brings experience to the lineup. Walker, an All-MAAC Rookie Team selection her freshman year, was a solid contributor off the bench for Loyola last season, and has fully recovered from knee surgery that she

underwent prior to the 2010-11 season. She appeared in 33 games, making one start and averaging 11.6 minutes per game.

Sophomore **Nicole Krusen** showed herself to be a three-point shooting threat for the Greyhounds last year. She finished second on the team with 28 made 3-point field goals while shooting 38.9-percent from behind the arc. Krusen had a total of 87 field goal attempts last season, with 72 of them coming from 3-point range. Sophomore walk-on **Julie Smith** rounds out the returning guards.

#### Forwards

Junior **Alyssa Sutherland** comes back as the top returning forward for the Greyhounds after starting 33 games last season. Sutherland led the team in field goal percentage at 46.5-percent and was second in steals with 53. The junior averaged 30.1 minutes per game and tallied 6.1 points and 4.1 rebounds per game.

Sophomore **Nneka Offodile** will be in the mix for a spot in the starting lineup after a strong freshman campaign where she averaged 1.6 points and 3.0 rebounds per game while appearing in 33 games and averaging 14.0 minutes.

Veterans **Kathleen Excellent** and **Kiara Henderson** will bring senior leadership off the bench for the Greyhounds.

#### Newcomers

Logan welcomes four freshmen to the Evergreen campus, who will all look to contribute immediately.

Guards **Nai Brown** and **Kara Marshall** will look to plug the hole left by DiClemente. Brown comes to Loyola from Newark, Del., where she helped the Sanford School to back-to-back state titles her junior and senior seasons. The Warriors won conference titles in each of Brown's four seasons on the team. She was a First Team All-State selection in 2011 and was Second Team All-State in 2010.

Marshall joins Brown in the backcourt after playing four years at Gaithersburgh High School in Gaithersburgh, Md. She guided the Trojans to their first-ever Maryland Class 4A State Championship in 2011. A 1,000-plus point scorer, Marshall led the Trojans in scoring and assists in each of her four seasons.

**Cierra Darden** will bring size to the Greyhound lineup, standing at 6-2. The Hughesville, Md., native led Grace Christian Academy in rebounds as senior and was honored as the team's best defensive player.

Forward **Steph Smith** helped Mount St. Joseph Academy to a 108-13 overall record in her four seasons at the school. She played for former La Salle head coach John Miller, which has helped her quickly learn the terminology and concepts in the Greyhound system. Smith finished her career with 1,129 career points and more than 700 rebounds while helping the Magic to District I titles in 2008 and 2011. Smith was an All-State Second Team selection in 2011 while being named league MVP.





## HEAD COACH JOE LOGAN

SEVENTH SEASON (96-88)

Head Coach Joe Logan enters his seventh season with the Greyhounds with a 96-88 (.522) record, ranking second in career wins at Loyola. He was hired as the 11th head women's basketball coach on May 12, 2005.

Logan led the Greyhounds to arguably the most successful year in program history in 2010-11, tying the record for most wins in a single season with 21, and setting the mark for most conference wins in a single season with 15. Loyola finished 21-13 overall and 15-3 in the MAAC to place in the regular season. It was the second season Logan had led the team to at least 13 conference wins.

During the season, the Greyhounds put together a nine-game winning streak, which tied for the longest in program history.

With wins over Canisius and Manhattan in the first two rounds of the MAAC Championships, Loyola advanced to the MAAC title game for the seventh time in program history in 2010-11, dropping a 63-45 decision to Marist.

Loyola received a berth to the Women's National Invitational Tournament for the first time ever, and picked up its first postseason win in program history by knocking off Old Dominion 67-65 on the road.

With the great team success also came individual honors. Three Greyhounds were named to All-MAAC teams, with Miriam McKenzie earning a first team nod while Erica DiClemente and Katie Sheahin were named to the second team. Sheahin also earned the MAAC Defensive Player of the Year Award.

Under Coach Logan seven student-athletes have been named to All-MAAC teams - Lauren Troupe (1st team, 2006), Krystle Harrington (3rd team, 2006), Jill Glessner (1st team, 2007), Vika Sholokhova (3rd team, 2007), Miriam McKenzie (1st team, 2010 and 2011), Erica DiClemente (2nd team, 2011) and Katie Sheahin (2nd team, 2011).

Two players have also earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors - Jackie Valderas (2006) and Sholokhova (2007). Three players also have earned MAAC All-Rookie team honors, including Erica DiClemente (2007), Candice Walker (2008) and Katie Sheahin (2010).

The Greyhounds were 14-16 overall and 9-9 in the conference under Logan in 2009-10. Loyola lost in the quarterfinals of the 2010 Citizens Bank Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Championships at the Times Union Center, in Albany, N.Y., to Fairfield, 70-66.

In Logan's first three seasons, the team registered a 32-22 mark in MAAC play (.593). He was recognized by his peers as the MAAC Coach of the Year after going 18-12 in 2006-2007.

Logan's ties to Loyola are more than just as a head coach. The Evergreen campus is also Logan's alma mater and where he met his wife, also an alumna of the University.

Logan graduated from Loyola in 1996 and worked as an undergraduate as a manager for the men's basketball team. The coach at the time, the late Skip Prosser, had high praise for Logan when he was hired in May of 2005.

After the graduation of nine players in Logan's first two seasons, the 2007-2008 Greyhounds were left with a roster of youthful talent. Undeterred, the team jumped out to a 7-3 record in the season's first 10 games with big non-conference wins over Drexel, Villanova, Mount St. Mary's, UMBC and Columbia, as well as a MAAC-opening sweep of Niagara and Canisius.

Injuries, however, dealt the team setbacks after the turning of the calendar, but Logan's club responded, reeling off four straight wins in February against conference foes. The Greyhounds then won their first game in the MAAC Tournament for the third straight season.

Logan and his coaching staff guided the Greyhounds to an 18-12 record and third-place finish in the MAAC in 2006-2007. The Greyhounds advanced to the MAAC semifinals for the second straight season, as well.

Loyola's 18-12 record came on the heels of a 20-10 record in 2005-2006, Logan's first year as head coach. The 38 wins posted during Logan's tenure are the most in a two-year span at Evergreen since the 1997-1998 and 1998-1999 teams won 41.

The 20 wins in 2005-2006 were the most in school history by a first-year women's basketball coach, and the 38 in two years are the most in that span, as well. Anne McCloskey won 33 games during the first two seasons of her tenure that began in 1976.

In his first season, Logan's team achieved the best record for a women's basketball team at Loyola since the 1998-1999 season. The Greyhounds finished third in the MAAC with a record of 13-5, also the best since the 1998-1999 campaign. Loyola's 20 wins are tied for the second-most victories in school history.

Logan and the Greyhounds topped Manhattan in the second round of the MAAC Championships after earning a first-round bye, and advanced to face second-seeded Canisius in the semifinals. The Greyhounds upset the Golden Griffins to move on to their first MAAC Championship game since 1998. Despite a loss to Marist in the final game, Logan and the 2005-2006 team fashioned one of the best seasons in school history.

Prior to his arrival as head coach in May of 2005, Logan was not a stranger to the Loyola women's basketball program. He was an assistant with the Greyhounds from 1997-2001 under head coaches Patty Coyle and Cindy Anderson-Griffin. During that time, Loyola posted a 72-43 record, advancing to the MAAC semifinals three times.

Logan left Loyola in 2001 to be a part of the coaching staff at St. Joseph's University in Philadelphia. There, he helped the Hawks to an overall record of 72-53. While Logan was at St. Joe's, the Hawks won two Atlantic 10 Eastern Conference titles and advanced to the Atlantic 10 Finals twice.

Logan also has worked with the NBA and WNBA as an advance scout for the New York Liberty in 1999 and an administrative assistant for the Philadelphia 76ers from 1996-97. He began his coaching career at Centenary College in New Jersey. There, he was as an assistant coach for the Cyclones men's basketball team during the 1996-1997 season.

Logan earned his bachelors of arts in history with a minor in business from Loyola in 1996. He is married to the former Susan Bryce (Loyola '98), who was a Greyhounds women's basketball player from 1994-1998. In March of 2009, the couple welcomed their first child, Margaret Grace (Maggie). The family resides in Hampstead, Md.
