



The Loyola College Athletics Communications Department welcomes members of the media to Diane Geppi-Aikens Field and all of the Greyhounds athletic facilities. Here are some guidelines to make your experience at Loyola College and the city of Baltimore an enjoyable one:

### Media Credentials

All members of the media attending games at Diane Geppi-Aikens Field must be credentialed. Those credentials must be displayed at all times so as not to hinder movement throughout the Arena.

Requests for credentials for 2008 Loyola College women's lacrosse games should be made in writing on official company letterhead and received at least five days prior to the game in question. These requests should include print and electronic photography as well. Requests should be sent to:

Single-game credentials can be picked up at the Loyola College Ticket Office located on the first floor of the Andrew White Student Center adjacent to Reitz Arena. The media will-call window opens 90 minutes prior to the scheduled game time.

### Radio Policy

Space is reserved in the press box area for visiting radio stations. Visiting stations planning on broadcasting should make known their requests in writing on official company letterhead a minimum of two weeks prior to the game in question. One telephone and one ISDN line are available to each requesting station. Technical questions will be handled by Joe Bradley the director of the Loyola College Event Services Department (410-617-2865).

### Game Day Media Parking

Members of the media wishing to receive parking should make that request known at the time of the credential request. Media receiving season credentials are reminded to let the Athletic Communications Department know when they are covering a game so as to secure parking for that game. Parking on Diane Geppi-Aikens Field is limited so a request must be made for each individual game.

### Media Services

Complete statistics and running play-by-play will be provided to accredited members of the media approximately 20 minutes following the contest. A limited number of wireless statistical monitors also will be available during the game. Diane Geppi-Aikens Field is a wireless facility. Please contact the Athletic Communications Staff for information on gaining access. If you have specific post-game needs (e-mailing or faxing of stats, etc.), please contact the Athletic Communications Staff by halftime.

### Post-Game Interview Policy

Arrangements for post-game interviews with members of the home and visiting teams will be made on an as needed basis. Contact a member of the Loyola Athletic Communications staff to request an interview. Unless specified differently, following a mandatory 10-minute cooling off period, the visiting team's coach and student-athletes will hold their media conference first, followed by Coach O'Day and Loyola student-athletes.

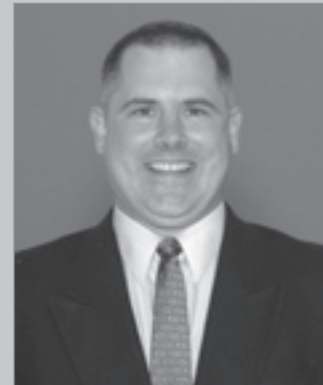
### Non-Game Day Interviews
