LOYOLA VS. UMBC: After a heartbreaking five-game loss to St. Francis on Friday night, the Greyhounds return to action on Tuesday night by hosting the UMBC Retrievers at Reitz Arena, Now 4-14 on the season, Loyola will play three of its next four matches at home ... This will be the final non-conference match for the Greyhounds prior to the start of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play on Saturday ... Loyola still has several non-conference matches scheduled near the end of the season.

SCOUTING THE RETRIEVERS: The Retrievers are 8-11 after winning a pair of AMERICA EAST Conference matches over the weekend ... After a four-game win on Friday at the University of Hartford, the Retrievers defeated Stony Brook on Sunday in a four-game match at the RAC Arena ... Freshman outside hitter **Sarah Ball** recorded 18 kills to go with nine digs in Sunday's win over the Seawolves ... She leads the team with 248 kills this season and has been named AMERICA EAST Rookie of the Week five times ... Coach **Ian Blanchard** is in his first year with UMBC after two years as an assistant at Towson University.

LAST TIME WE MET - LOYOLA VS. UMBC: Freshman **Sarah Ball** recorded her third straight double-double with 19 kills and 17 digs to lead the Retrievers to a four-game victory over Loyola in the opening match of the George Mason University Patriot Invitational on September 2 ... It was the first victory of the head coaching career for **Ian Blanchard** ... UMBC hit .299 in the match ... Loyola senior **Becky Corb** had 11 kills and 12 digs while freshman setter **Marcellee Williams** tallied her first career double-double with 35 assists and 10 digs.

HEAD COACH KRISTINA HERNANDEZ: Loyola Coach **Kristina Hernandez** is in her second season as the Greyhounds' leader ... Last year, the North Carolina A&T graduate guided Loyola to a 10-18 record ... Hernandez helped the Greyhounds double their win total from the 2003 season with the 10 victories ... She is the youngest Division I head coach in the country.

WHAT A STREAK!: Senior outside hitter **Becky Corb** recorded 10 or more kills in eight matches before being held to just nine against Morgan State on September 29 ... Against LaSalle on September 20, she tallied a season-high 27 kills in the Greyhounds' five-game win ... During the streak, she recorded 20 or more kills three times ... Corb currently ranks second in the MAAC in kills per game and leads the team with 234 kills this season after the nine-kill effort against the Lady Bears on Thursday.

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE: Three of the Greyhounds' four wins this season have come at home ... Loyola snapped a 12-match road losing streak on September 20 in the win over LaSalle ... The Greyhounds recorded a three-game sweep over Coppin State on September 6 to snap a season-opening, four-match losing streak ... Their win over Howard the following Tuesday snapped a three-match losing skid they suffered over the previous weekend at the Cal Poly/Best Western Royal Oak Invitational while the win over Morgan State was their second victory in a three-match span.

SHOULD WE MAKE THE SWITCH?: Three of the Greyhounds' four wins this season have come against MEAC opponents while the other win came against an Atlantic 10 opponent ... Loyola has defeated Morgan State, Coppin State and Howard and will host UMES on October 26.

DON'T I KNOW YOU FROM SOMEWHERE?: Loyola sophomore outside hitter **Katie Sindelar** and UMBC redshirt freshman **Angela Anderson** were high school teammates at Bishop Montgomery High School ... The duo helped Bishop Montgomery win the 2002 state title and back-to-back conference titles as juniors and seniors ... Anderson missed last year with the Retrievers after an ACL injury ended her season.

GETTING CLOSER TO THE RECORD: Senior **Becky Corb** continues her quest of becoming Loyola's career leader in kills during her senior season ... Entering Friday's match against Saint Francis, Corb has 1,423 kills in three-plus seasons ... She recorded a season-high 27 kills in the win over LaSalle on September 20 ... She is just 13 kills away from reaching the record of 1,436, which was set by **Sarah Becker, '94** during her four-year career ... Corb reached the 1,000-kill plateau last season against Rider at Reitz Arena.

SETTING ANOTHER MARK: Senior **Becky Corb** has a good chance of becoming just the second player in Loyola College volleyball history to record 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs ... She needs 61 digs to reach the milestone ... **Shauna Lagatol, '99** was the first player to reach the milestone ... She amassed 1,320 kills and 1,091 digs in her four-year career ... Lagatol stands third on the school's career kills list.

DIGGING TO A MILESTONE: Seniors **Jamie Arndt** and **Becky Corb** are getting closer to reaching 1,000 career digs ... Arndt enters tonight's match with 977 digs, while Corb is not far behind with 939 digs ... The school record for career digs is 1,383, which was set by **Megan McGuire, '03**.

LOOK OUT FOR FALLING MILESTONES: In addition to the milestones that seniors **Jamie Arndt** and **Becky Corb** can reach this season, several other players are nearing career milestones ... Senior **Christine Lopez** needs just nine kills to reach 500 for her career ... Meanwhile, sophomore **Christina Greenup** needs 35 kills to reach the same mark ... Freshman setter **Marcellee Williams** reached 500 assists in her career with 45 against St. Francis on Friday night.

3,000 AND COUNTING: Senior setter **Krystal Biegaj** recorded her 3,000th career assist earlier this season at the SpringHill Suites Classic ... She recorded the milestone assist in the opening game of the Greyhounds' four-game loss to North Texas when she set up a kill by sophomore **Christina Greenup** ... Biegaj has 59 assists in 18 matches this season, including a pair of 11-assist efforts early in the season ... Last year, she led the MAAC with 11.2 assists per game ... The school record for career assists is 3,763, which was set by **Kim Colavito, '93**.

DIG AWAY: Five different players tallied 10 or more digs in the Greyhounds' five-game loss to Davidson at the SpringHill Suites Classic ... Senior libero **Jamie Arndt** led all players with a season-high 28 digs, while senior outside hitter **Becky Corb** added 15 digs ... Freshman **Danielle Moran** recorded the second double-digit dig effort of her career with 14 digs while senior setter **Krystal Biegaj** had 13 ... Setter **Marcellee Williams** chipped in with 11 digs.

MORE DIGGING: Freshman **Danielle Moran** recorded a career-high 15 digs against North Texas ... In the four matches at the SpringHill Suites Classic, Moran had 36 digs ... She made her first career start against Davidson and had 14 digs to help the Greyhounds.

DOUBLE YOUR PLEASURE: Senior outside hitter **Becky Corb** recorded her first double-double of the season in the loss to UMBC on September 2 ... She registered 11 kills to go with 12 digs in the Greyhounds' four-game loss to the Retrievers ... Corb was named to the Patriot Invitational All-Tournament Team after registering 47 kills in three matches.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Freshman setter **Marcellee Williams** earned her first career double-double effort with a season-high 35 assists along with 10 digs in the Greyhounds' four-game setback to UMBC at the George Mason Tournament in early September ... Williams registered 93 assists in the three matches during the Patriot Invitational.

Loyola Head Coach Kristina Hernandez

The youngest head coach in NCAA Division I, **Kristina Hernandez** is in her second season as the Greyhounds' leader. A Texas native, Hernandez is a 2003 graduate of North Carolina A&T.



In her first season as head coach, Hernandez led the Loyola volleyball squad to a 10-18 overall record, which included a 3-6 mark in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. She doubled the number of wins from the previous season (5-24), including a 5-2 record in the final seven matches of the season.

Since her arrival at Loyola, Hernandez has become actively involved in the sport locally. Just this summer, she spent time with the USA Volleyball Summer national program and was the assistant coach to the first-ever Chesapeake region Youth National Team.

Hernandez earned her bachelor's degree in physical education from North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, where she competed as setter on the women's volleyball team. In her first season, she was named Rookie of the Year. Upon graduation, Hernandez served as co-head volleyball coach of the Golden Bear Junior Olympic Club in Berkeley, California. Hernandez also worked as a physical education instructor at Herbert Hoover Middle School in San Francisco and was a volunteer assistant volleyball coach under **Jon Stevenson** at St. Mary's College of California, one of five teams from the eight-team West Coast Conference to make the NCAA Tournament.

A member of the Northern California Volleyball Association and American Volleyball Coaches Association, Hernandez received an increased mastery and professional application of coaching theory certificate through USA Volleyball for coaching the Golden Bear Junior Olympic Club team. In the summer of 2003, Hernandez interned with USA Volleyball in the Beach, Education and Grassroots program under **John Kessel**, the Director of Beach and Grassroots Programs.

"Kristina Hernandez is driven," says Loyola Athletic Director **Joe Boylan**. "She has followed her dreams from playing collegiate volleyball at North Carolina A& T to coaching the Junior Olympic Club team. Kristina has tremendous potential as a head coach and we're glad that she is at Loyola."

MORE TROUBLE: Freshman setter **Marcellee Williams** recorded her second double-double with 32 assists and 15 digs in the win over Coppin State ... In the first game, Williams had seven digs and eight assists ... Williams also added a double-double in the Greyhounds' three-game loss to San Jose State on September 9.

SCHILLINGER EARNS FIRST HONOR: Freshman middle blocker **Rachel Schillinger** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Cal Poly/Best Western Royal Oak Invitational ... It was the first honor of her career ... Schillinger recorded 15 kills in three matches, including 10 in a loss to San Jose State in the tournament opener.

ANOTHER ACCOLADE FOR CORB: Senior outside hitter **Becky Corb** was named to the SpringHill Suites Classic All-Tournament Team after amassing 69 kills with 39 digs in four matches ... She recorded 20 or more kills in two matches while having at least 10 kills in every match ... She recorded a season-high 24 kills in a four-game loss to North Texas ... It was the second All-Tournament Team honor of the season for Corb.

MADDIE TIME: Freshman outside hitter **Maddie Fuller** has seen limited action so far this season, but she has made the most of her time against Howard and Morgan State... In her one game against the Lady Bison, the Dallas, Texas native recorded a pair of kills to go with a pair of assists ... Both were career highs ... She played in two games against Morgan State and matched her career high with two kills while setting a new personal mark with three assists.

THE STREAK IS OVER! With the five-game win over LaSalle two weeks ago, the Greyhounds snapped a 12-match road losing streak, dating back to last season ... Prior to the win over LaSalle, Loyola's last road win came against Marist in a five-game thriller during the final weekend of the regular season ... Loyola won just five games during the streak and was swept by an opponent seven times.

IT'S NICE TO MEET YOU: The Greyhounds have faced five opponents for the first time in their volleyball history so far this season ... It was the first-ever meeting against any of the teams Loyola faced in the Cal Poly Invitational while two of the four other teams in the SpringHill Suites Classic were first-time opponents.

LONG TIME, NO SEE: When the Greyhounds faced Winthrop at Charlotte's SpringHill Suites Classic, it was the first meeting against the Eagles since the 1988 season ... Winthrop has won all three meetings against the Greyhounds after the three-game loss.

REACHING THE CENTURY MARK: Senior outside hitter **Becky Corb** played in her 100th career match against Howard ... Senior setter **Krystal Biegaj** also reached the milestone in the Greyhounds' five-game loss to Davidson at the SpringHill Suites Classic ... In addition, senior **Christine Lopez** appeared in her 100th career match against Robert Morris last Tuesday.

GOING THE DISTANCE: Over the last two-plus seasons, the Greyhounds have been involved in five-game matches six times after last week's marathon thriller at LaSalle ... They have a 3-3 record in those matches, including a 1-1 mark this year ... Last season, Loyola was undefeated in both matches that went the full five games ... On October 9, the Greyhounds defeated St. Francis (PA) in a five-game thriller after the two teams traded games twice ... Loyola defeated Marist in five games on November 13 after losing the first two games.

NOT WASTING TIME: Three freshmen made their college debuts during the Greyhounds' three-game, season-opening loss to American on August 30 ... Setter **Marcellee Williams** recorded 18 assists and also had one kill for Loyola ... Meanwhile, **Rachel Schillinger** had four kills while **Danielle Moran** added four digs ... There are five freshmen on this year's roster.

DON'T HAVE TO WAIT LONG: Freshman setter/defensive specialist **Samantha Greenbaum** made her college debut against Seton Hall in the Greyhounds' three-game loss during the opening weekend of the season ... She started and had two digs in the opening game.

GETTING IN ON THE ACT: Freshman **Maddie Fuller** made her college debut against George Mason in the opening weekend of the season ... She had one attack attempt and recorded a dig in the Greyhounds' four-game loss to the Patriots ... She became the final freshman on this year's roster to make her college debut.

BATTLE OF BALTIMORE: The Greyhounds will host all four other Division I teams in Baltimore this season ... The Greyhounds earned their first Baltimore win against Coppin State in a three-game sweep and won in three straight games against Morgan State before a three-game setback to Towson last week ... UMBC will make the short trip to Evergreen Tuesday night ... Last season, the Greyhounds went 1-4 against the other Baltimore schools, including a pair of losses to the Retrievers.

LOOKING BACK AT LAST YEAR: The Greyhounds went 10-18 last season and doubled their wins total from the 2003 campaign ... Senior **Becky Corb** finished second in the conference in kills with 434, while fellow senior **Jamie Arndt** ranked first in the MAAC in digs per game.

WHAT A WAY TO FINISH: Five of the Greyhounds' 10 wins a season ago came during the final seven matches of the year ... The only losses during that stretch came against Niagara and Siena in the regular season finale ... The Greyhounds were 3-2 in MAAC play during the seven-game stretch.

UP NEXT: The Greyhounds begin Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference play on Saturday afternoon when they travel to Rider University to face the Broncs ... It will be the start of a two-match road trip for the Greyhounds, who also travel to Lafayette next Wednesday in a non-conference match ...
