### Belt, Black Win National Titles; Cardinal Men Finish 10th Overall

The University of Louisville track and field program closed the 2007 indoor season in strong fashion as sophomores Tone Belt and Andre Black won individual national titles to lead the Cardinal men's team to a 10th-place finish overall at the 2007 NCAA Indoor Championships on March 9-10 at the University of Arkansas' Randal Tyson Track Center.

On Friday night, Belt became the Cards' first ever national champion with his victory in the men's long jump with a school record jump of 26 feet, 1.75 inches on his second attempt of the day. Belt is now a three-time NCAA All-American after earning fifth-place finishes in the long jump and high jump at the 2006 NCAA Outdoor Championships.

On Saturday night, Black closed out the weekend for the Cards with his exciting win in the men's triple jump with a school record mark of 53 feet, 5.5 inches on his fifth attempt of the night. After entering the finals in fourth place, Black moved to second on his fourth attempt and then into the lead on his fifth jump.

Overall, the Cards tied for 10th with traditional national level programs Baylor, LSU and Tennessee with 21 points overall. Also scoring for UofL was senior Arthur Turland, who finished eight in the men's weight throw on Friday afternoon to become the Cards' first ever indoor All-American. On Saturday, Emily Turland became the Cards' first women's athlete to ever compete at the NCAA Indoor Championships with her 10th-place finish in the weight throw.

### UofL Has Six All-Americans in the Last Two NCAA Track Championships

Prior to the 2006 NCAA Outdoor Championships in Calif., last June, the UofL track and field program had four NCAA All-Americans in its history, but since then, the Cards have added six All-America performances and two NCAA champions in the last two NCAA track and field championships. Tone Belt leads the way as a three-time All-American, including the 2007 indoor long jump title and fifth-place finishes in the outdoor long jump and high jump. Andre Black earned All-America honors with his win in the indoor triple jump and Arthur Turland was the UofL's first indoor All-American with his eighth-place finish in the weight throw at the NCAA indoors. UofL's sixth All-American in the last two NCAA track championships was Kelley Bowman, who finished third in the women's high jump at the 2006 NCAA outdoors.

### Cards Win Eight BIG EAST Titles, Set 23 School Records in 2007

UofL closed the 2007 BIG EAST Indoor Championships with eight individual champions and 17 medalists during the two days of competition in Akron, Ohio. The UofL men had wins in the high jump (Tone Belt), long jump (Belt), triple jump (Andre Black), weight throw (Arthur Turland), shot put (Steven Hnat) and 5,000m (Wesley Korir), while the women won the weight throw (Emily Turland) and 200m (Elisabeth Slettum).

Overall, the Cardinal men and women set 23 school records (15 men, eight women) and earned 11 NCAA qualifying marks (eight men, three women) in 2007.

### Belt Named USTFCCA SE Region Men's Field Athlete of the Year

On March 6, Tone Belt was named the Southeast Region's Men's Field Athlete of the Year by the USTFCCA. Belt entered the NCAA Championships with the nation's top performance in the long jump (26-1) and eighth-best mark in the high jump (7-3). He was the outstanding field performer at the Big East Conference Championships, scoring 26 points as the Cards finished second overall.

# 2007 University of Louisville Indoor Track & Field Notes

## UofL Men Earn Eight Qualifying Marks for NCAA Championships

The University of Louisville men's track & field team earned eight NCAA qualifying marks for the 2007 NCAA Indoor Championships, including one automatic qualifier and seven provisional qualifiers.

Sophomore Tone Belt leads the way with qualifying marks in three events, an automatic mark in the long jump and provisional marks in the high jump and triple jump.

Sophomore Andre Black is next for UofL with provisional marks in the triple jump and long jump. Also earning NCAA provisional qualifying marks are seniors Wesley Korir (5,000m) and Arthur Turland (weight throw) and sophomore Rudon Bastian (long jump).

## Women Earn Three Qualifying Marks for NCAA Championships

The University of Louisville women's track & field team earned three NCAA qualifying marks for the 2007 NCAA Indoor Championships in the throwing events. Senior Emily Turland earned a provisional mark in the weight throw, junior ZeNai Savage earned a provisional mark in the shot put and freshman Theresa Lewis earned a provisional mark in the 60m hurdles.

## Belt Ranked Wins Long Jump National Title; Unbeaten in 2007

Sophomore Tone Belt remained perfect in the long jump against collegiate competition and became UofL's first national champion with his win the long jump at the NCAA Indoor Championships on March 9. He also has long jump wins this season at the BIG EAST Championships, the SIU Fast Start Invitational, the Rod McCravy Memorial, the Kentucky Invitational and the Tyson Invitational. Overall, Belt has won nine of his 13 collegiate long jump competitions at UofL.

On March 6, Belt was named Southeast Region Men's Field Athlete of the Year and on Feb. 24-25, he became a five-time BIG EAST champion with his wins in the long jump and high jump. Entering the meet, he had also won the 2006 outdoor long jump and high jump titles and the 2006 indoor long jump championship.

## Black Wins NCAA Triple Jump: Three-Time BIG EAST Champ

Sophomore Andre Black won his first national title after winning the triple jump on March 10 at the NCAA Indoor Championships. The title caps a strong season, which included remaining perfect in the triple jump in the BIG EAST after winning his third straight conference title in the event at the BIG EAST Indoor Championships.

In winning the 2007 BIG EAST triple jump, Black successfully defended his 2006 indoor title, and he is also the reigning outdoor triple jump champion with his victory last May.

## Arthur Turland Earns All-America Honors in Weight Throw

Senior Arthur Turland won this third career BIG EAST title and successfully defended his 2006 title by winning the 2007 weight throw title at the 2007 BIG EAST Indoor Championships. Along with his two weight throw titles, Turland is also the reigning BIG EAST outdoor hammer champion.

## UofL Men Win Five Field Event Titles at BIG EAST Indoors

The University of Louisville men's track and field team continued its recent domination of the BIG EAST field events by winning five of six individual titles at last month's BIG EAST Indoor Championships in Arkon, Ohio.

The Cards won the long jump (Tone Belt), high jump (Tone Belt), triple jump (Andre Black), shot put (Steven Hnat) and weight throw (Arthur Turland) events. The Cards also earned a medal sweep in the long jump as sophomores Tone Belt, Andre Black and Rudon finished 1-2-3.

In three BIG EAST championship meets over the last 12 months (two indoor and one outdoor), the Cardinal men have won all three triple jump titles, all three long jump titles, both indoor weight throw titles, two of three high jump titles, one shot put title and one hammer title.

## 2007 Men's National Rankings

Entering last week's NCAA Indoor Championships, the Cardinal men's team was ranked eighth in the Trackwire 25 and 12th in the USTFCCCA Top 20. The No.5 ranking on Feb. 20 was the highest ranking in the program's history. UofL's highest previous national ranking prior to this season came on May 9, 2006, when the Cardinal men's team entered the Trackwire Outdoor Top 25 at No. 23 overall, the program's first ever national ranking.

# 2007 Indoor Meet Recaps

## **SIU Fast Start Invitational Carbondale, Ill. December 8, 2006**

**CARBONDALE, Ill.** – The University of Louisville men's and women's track and field teams opened the indoor season in impressive fashion earning four NCAA Championships qualifying marks, winning four event titles and setting eight school records at Friday's Fast Start Invitational hosted by Southern Illinois University.

Leading the way for the Cards at the unscored meet was two-time All-America performer Tone Belt who earned a pair of NCAA qualifying marks with first-place and school record performances in the high jump and long jump. Belt, a sophomore from Berkeley Springs, W.Va., won the high jump clearing an indoor personal best height of 7 feet, 1.75 inches breaking his own previous school record of 7-01.50 set at last season's Indiana Open. In the long jump, Belt had a career best distance of 25-07.50 to break the previous UofL record of 24-11 set by teammate Andre Black at last season's Fast Start Invite.

Black also had a record-setting day in Carbondale earning a first-place finish and an NCAA qualifying mark with a school record performance in the triple jump. The sophomore from Mobile, Ala., won the event with a personal best jump of 51-02.25 breaking the previous school record of 50-06.50 set by Ray Buchanan in 1991.

The Cards' fourth NCAA qualifying performance was turned in by senior Arthur Turland with a first-place finish in the weight throw with a mark of 65-08.25.

The Cardinal men had two more school record performances on Friday led by sophomore Steven Hnat who finished second overall in the shot put with a mark of 55-11.25 breaking the previous UofL record of 55-00.50 set by James Dennis in 1998. The final school record came from junior Robbie Moore who finished third overall in the pole vault with a cleared height of 14-11.00 breaking his own previous record of 14-09.00 set at last year's BIG EAST Indoor Championships.

Leading the way for the Cardinal women's team was junior ZeNai Savage with a school record mark of 49-10.00 in the shot put to finish second overall in the event. The native of Indianapolis, Ind., broke the previous school record of 49-09.75 set by Shola Kadiri in 2002.

Another record-setting performance was turned in by sophomore Siedre Forde, who finished second overall in the triple jump with a mark of 40-11.00. The native of Green's St. George, Barbados, broke the previous UofL record of 39-06.50 set by Ily Akubeze in 2004.

The final school record showing of the day for the Cards came from freshman Theresa Lewis who matched the UofL record in the 60-meter hurdles with a time of 8.66 seconds to finish second overall in the race. The time matches the school record set by Cardinal senior Aajah Showell at last year's Meyo Invitational.

## **Kentucky Invitational Lexington, Ky. Jan. 12-13, 2007**

**LEXINGTON, Ky.** – University of Louisville sophomore Tone Belt won his second straight long jump title of the season and the Cards set five school records during the final day of competition Saturday at the Kentucky Invitational.

Belt, a native of Berkeley Springs, W.Va., won the long jump with a mark of 25 feet, 5.25 inches for his second event title of the weekend. On Friday, Belt won the high jump with a school record and NCAA qualifying mark of 7-03.00. Overall, Belt is unbeaten through the Cards' first two meets of the season with a pair of long jump titles and a pair of high jump titles.

The Cards also added five school record performances on Saturday led by junior ZeNai Savage's third-place finish in the women's shot put. A native of Indianapolis, Ind., Savage had a career-best and NCAA qualifying throw of 50-04.50 to shatter her previous school record of 49-10 set at last month's SIU Fast Start Invitational.

Freshman Elisabeth Slettum added a second school record performance for the Cardinal women with her time of 24.18 seconds in the 200m and fifth place overall in the event. In her collegiate debut in the event, the native of Stavanger, Norway, broke the previous UofL record of 25.52 set by LaShondra Durias at last season's Meyo Invitational.

Another freshman, Theresa Lewis, added a third record performance for the Cardinal women with her fifth-place finish in the 60-meter hurdles. Her time of 8.66 seconds matched the school record set by Aajah Showell at the 2006 Meyo Invitational.

The Cardinal men had the final two school records on the day led by freshman Shaquan Brown in the 60-meter dash. Brown's time of 6.81 seconds in his collegiate debut broke the previous school record of 6.96 seconds held by Riley Fitzpatrick (1981) and Joey Smith (1990).

Sophomore Bryan Webb of Knoxville, Tenn., had the final record setting performance of the day for UofL with his sixth-place time of 21.80 seconds in the 200m breaking the previous record of 22.02 set by Robert Amedee at last year's BIG EAST Championships.

"I'm very pleased with our showing this weekend in our first meet after the holiday break," said UofL head coach Ron Mann. "Over the two days, we had seven school records and numerous NCAA and BIG EAST qualifiers, so this is definitely something strong for us to build on."

### **Day One Recap**

The UofL men's and women's track and field teams returned to action following the holiday break on Friday night earning a pair of event titles and setting two new school records at UK.

Leading the way for UofL on the first of two days of competition was sophomore Tone Belt who won the high jump title with a school record and NCAA indoor qualifying mark of 7 feet, three inches. The jump bested Belt's previous school record of 7-01.75 set last month at the SIU Fast Start Invite.

On the women's side, senior Emily Turland led the way with school record and NCAA indoor qualifying mark of 63-04 to finish second overall in the weight throw. The career-best throw for Turland shattered her previous school record mark of 61-04 set at last year's DePauw Invitational.

The Cards' second event title came from sophomore Andre Black, who won his second straight triple jump title of the season with a mark of 51-01.50. The jump was just short of his school record mark of 51-02.25 set at last month's SIU Fast Start.

Also turning in solid performances for the men were senior Arthur Turland and sophomore Andrew Hackney in the weight throw. Turland finished second with a mark of 63-03.50, while Hackney was fourth with a career-best throw of 61-04.

## **Rod McCravy Memorial Lexington, Ky. Jan. 19-20, 2007**

**LEXINGTON, Ky.** – Wesley Korir won the mile run in school record time while Tone Belt won his third straight long jump title to lead the No. 10 ranked University of Louisville men's track and field team on the final day of competition at the Rod McCravy Memorial Saturday at the University of Kentucky's Nutter Field House.

Korir, a junior from Eldoret, Kenya, defeated a field of 21 other runners in the mile run with a time of 4:10.29 breaking his previous school record time of 4:12.44 set at the 2006 Illinois Invitational in Champaign, Ill. Overall, the Cardinal men and women set three new school records on Saturday to finish with four overall on the weekend.

Belt, a sophomore from Berkeley Springs, W.Va., stayed unbeaten on the season in the long jump with an NCAA qualifying mark of 24 feet, 11.75 inches. On Friday first day of action at UK, the two-time NCAA outdoor All-American won his third straight high jump title to also remain perfect in that event in 2007.

Joining Korir with school record performances on Saturday was sophomore Bryan Webb in the men's 400m and freshman Theresa Lewis in the women's 60m hurdles. Webb, a native of Knoxville, Tenn., had a time of 47.76 seconds in the 400m to finish eighth overall and break his own previous school record of 48.16 set at the 2006 BIG EAST Championships.

Lewis, a native of Randallstown, Md., finished eighth overall in the 60m hurdles with a time of 8.62 to break the previous school record of 8.66 held by her and Aajah Showell.

Another freshman, Tarah McKay, narrowly missed on a pair of school records in the 800m and the mile run. In the 800m, the native of St. Clements, Ont., finished eighth overall with a time of 2:14.49, the third-fastest time in school history, while in the mile, she finished seventh overall with a time of 4:54.49, the third-fastest time in school history in that event as well. Former UofL standout Bettina Bard is the current school record holder in both the 800m (2:13.6) and the mile (4:51.43) setting both marks in 1996.

### **Day One Recap**

Sophomore Andre Black won his third straight triple jump title while Tone Belt stayed unbeaten in the high jump to lead the 10th-ranked University of Louisville men's track and field team during the first day of the Rod McCravy Memorial Friday at Nutter Field House.

Black, a native of Mobile, Ala., stayed unbeaten in the triple jump in 2007 with a school record and NCAA qualifying mark of 51 feet, 5 inches breaking his own previous school record jump of 51-02.25 set in December at the SIU Fast Start Invitational in Carbondale, Ill.

Belt, a two-time NCAA outdoor All-American from Berkeley Springs, W.Va., added the Cards' second event title on Friday with his third straight high jump title with a mark of 6-11.75.

Leading the way for the Cardinal women on Friday was senior Emily Turland in the weight throw with an NCAA qualifying mark of 63-03.50 and fourth-place overall.



# 2007 Indoor Meet Recaps

## **Gladstein Invitational** **Bloomington, Ind.** **January 26-27, 2007**

**BLOOMINGTON, Ind.** – A pair of freshmen women, Andrea Sabbatine and Elisabeth Slettum earned runner-up finishes on Saturday to lead the University of Louisville track and field team on the final day of competition at Indiana University's Gladstein Invitational.

Sabbatine, from Georgetown, Ky., finished second in a field of 26 entries in the pole vault clearing a height of 11 feet, 5.75 inches to match a career high in the event. Slettum, from Stavanger, Norway, was second in a field of 56 runners in the 200m with a time of 24.53 seconds, the fourth best time in school history.

On Friday, UofL junior Wesley Korir won the men's 3000m run while three other Cardinal athletes earned runner up finishes on the first day of competition at IU. Senior Arthur Turland had a second-place finish in the weight throw, while on the women's side, junior ZeNai Savage and freshman Tarah McKay led the way with runner-up finishes in the shot put and 3000m run respectively.

### **Day One Recap**

University of Louisville junior Wesley Korir won the men's 3000m while three other Cardinals earned runner-up finishes Friday at the Gladstein Invitational hosted by Indiana University.

Korir, a native of Eldoret, Kenya, finished with a time of 8 minutes, 14.68 seconds to defeat a field of 15 other runners in the event and lead the way for the 10th-ranked UofL men's team. Also adding a strong finish on the first day of competition for the Cardinal men's team was Arthur Turland, a senior from Kincardine, Ont., with a second-place finish in the weight throw with a mark of 64 feet, 5.75 inches.

On the women's side, junior ZeNai Savage and freshman Tarah McKay led the way with runner-up finishes in the shot put and 3000m run respectively. Savage, a native of Indianapolis, Ind., had an NCAA qualifying throw of 49-10.50 in the shot put, while McKay, from St. Clements, Ont., had a second-place time of 9:58.43 in the 3000m.

Junior Christine Krellwitz also had a solid showing on the first day of the pentathlon with a win in the high jump clearing a personal best height of 5-06 and a third-place finish in the shot put with a personal best throw of 34-01.75.

"The first day of the meet was a success overall with some ups and some downs," said UofL assistant coach Brice Allen. "The highlight today came from the performances of our throwers with ZeNai Savage and Arthur Turland leading the way."

## **Meyo Invitational** **South Bend, Ind.** **February 2-3, 2007**

**SOUTH BEND, Ind.** – Two-time NCAA outdoor All-American Tone Belt won his fourth straight high jump title and earned an NCAA qualifying mark in the triple jump to lead the 12th-ranked University of Louisville men's track and field team Saturday at the Meyo Invitational hosted by Notre Dame.

Belt, a sophomore from Berkeley Springs, W.Va., stayed unbeaten in the high jump in 2007 besting a field of 27 other jumpers with a cleared height of 7 feet, 1 inch. He also earned an NCAA qualifying mark in the triple jump with his fourth-place and career best jump of 50-07.25. Belt has now earned NCAA provisional qualifying marks in the high jump, long jump and triple jump in 2007.

Joining Belt with strong performances on Saturday for the Cardinal men's team was sophomores Bryan Webb and Andre Black and freshman Chris Brautzsch. Webb, a native of Knoxville, Tenn., set a new school record in the 400m with a time 47.65 to finish seventh overall in the event and break his own previous school record of 47.76 set on Jan. 20 at the Rod McCravy Memorial.

Black, a native of Mobile, Ala., finished third in the triple jump with a mark of 50-10.75, while Brautzsch, from Fort Wayne, Ind., finished eighth in the 60-meter hurdles with a BIG EAST qualifying mark of 8.12 seconds in his first career collegiate meet.

On the women's side, leading the way for the Cardinal women was freshman Theresa Lewis, sophomore Seidre Forde, freshman Elisabeth Slettum and junior ZeNai Savage. Lewis finished sixth overall in the 60-meter hurdles after advancing to the finals with a school record time of 8.55 seconds in the preliminary round breaking her previous school record of 8.62 set at the Rod McCravy Memorial earlier this season. Forde, from Green's St. George, Barbados, finished third overall in the triple jump with a mark of 40-08.25, the second best jump in school history, while Slettum, from Stavanger, Norway, was fifth in the 200m with a time of 24.46 seconds. Savage, from Indianapolis, Ind., earned a fifth-place finish in the shot put with a mark of 48-01.25.

During Friday's first day of competition, UofL junior Wesley Korir recorded the fastest 5,000-meter time in the nation in 2007 and overall the Cards earned three new NCAA qualifying marks and a pair of new school records.

Korir, a native of Eldoret, Kenya, was the top finishing collegiate runner and second-place overall in the event with school record and NCAA qualifying time of 13 minutes, 52.63 seconds in the 5,000m. His time was nearly six seconds faster than the top time in the nation entering the weekend of 13:58.09 set by Oregon's Galen Rupp more than a month ago and also shattered Korir's own previous school record of 14:21.30 set last season at the Meyo Invitational.

"Overall, it was a great day and a great weekend for our team, though we did have one setback with a leg injury suffered by Shaquan Brown today in the 200m," said UofL head coach Ron Mann. "Because of the injury, we weren't able to compete in the men's 4x400m relay and we won't know the seriousness of the injury until we return to Louisville for further evaluation. But despite that injury, things continue to move in a positive direction for this program. Wesley Korir's performance in the 5,000-meter run yesterday was very impressive, so we're looking forward to the upcoming championship events."

Through five indoor events in 2007, the Cardinal men's and women's teams now have a combined nine NCAA provisional qualifiers, including seven by the men and two for the women.

## **Tyson Invitational** **Fayetteville, Ark.** **February 9-10, 2007**

**FAYETTEVILLE, Ark.** – Sophomore Andre Black earned the fourth best mark of the season in the triple jump and shattered his own previous school record to lead the No. 14 University of Louisville men's track and field team on the final day of competition at the Tyson Invitational Saturday at the University of Arkansas' Randal Tyson Track Complex.

Black, from Mobile, Ala., was second among collegiate athletes and third overall in the championship triple jump with a jump of 52 feet, 3.75 inches, more than 10 inches better than his previous school record of 51-05 set earlier this season at the Rod McCravy Memorial in Lexington, Ky. The NCAA provisional qualifying mark should put Black in strong position for next month's NCAA Indoor Championships held at the same facility in Arkansas.

Another school record performance was turned in by sophomore Bryan Webb at the Tyson Invite as the native of Knoxville, Tenn., set a new school record in the 200m with his time of 21.62 seconds, good for 21st overall on Saturday. Webb broke his previous school record time of 21.80 set earlier this season at the Kentucky Invitational.

Joining Black and Webb with strong performances on Saturday was senior Arthur Turland, who earned the sixth best weight throw mark in the nation this season with his first-place and school record throw of 69 feet at the Tiger Indoor Invitational in Greencastle, Ind. A native of Kincardine, Ont., Turland shattered his own previous school record of 66-04.50 set at the 2006 BIG EAST Championships.

On the women's side for the Cards at the Tyson Invitational, freshman Brittany Hotaling finished second in the college high jump with a cleared height of 5-05.00, while sophomore Seidre Forde finished eighth in the championship triple jump with mark of 40-10.50, less than one inch shy of her school record mark of 40-11 set at the SIU Fast Start Invite this season.

### **Day One**

Two-time NCAA outdoor All-American Tone Belt won his fourth straight long jump title and recorded the nation's top mark in the event in 2007 to lead the 14th-ranked University of Louisville men's track and field team on the first day of competition at the prestigious Tyson Invitational Friday at the University of Arkansas' Randal Tyson Track Complex.

Belt, a sophomore from Berkeley Springs, W.Va., entered the day ranked third in the nation in the long jump, but his school record mark of 25 feet, 10.75 inches on his sixth and final attempt of the day moved him to the top of the national list. The mark, which is an automatic qualifying mark for next month's NCAA Indoor Championships also held at the Randal Tyson Track Complex, was more than three inches better than his previous school record mark of 25-07.50 set at the SIU Fast Start Invitational earlier this season. The win was earned against a field of 15 athletes, including a pair of 2006 All-Americans and improved Belt to a perfect 4-0 in the long jump in 2007.

"With 14 of the nation's top 20 teams and many of the nation's very best collegiate athletes competing at this meet, this type of performance says a lot about Tone's competitiveness," said UofL head coach Ron Mann. "This is the kind of performance that he should be able to use as a springboard for next week's BIG EAST Championships and the NCAA Championships in March."



# 2007 Indoor Meet Recaps

## **BIG EAST Indoor Championships (Day 1)** Akron, Ohio February 17-18, 2007

**AKRON, Ohio** – Led by four individual event titles and eight total medalists, the University of Louisville track and field program closed the first day of competition with the outright lead in the men's championship and in a first-place tie in the women's competition Saturday at the BIG EAST Indoor Championships at the Akron Athletics Field House.

Leading the way for the Cards was the husband-and-wife duo of Arthur and Emily Turland, who swept the men's and women's weight throw competitions. Arthur, a senior from Kincardine, Ont., earned an NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 68 feet, 3.25 inches, to win his second straight BIG EAST indoor weight throw title, while Emily, a senior from New Albany, Ind., won the women's title with a school record and NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 66-00.50.

Overall, the Cardinal men, ranked ninth in the nation in this week's Trackwire Top 25 rankings, lead the way with 54 points, followed by Notre Dame in second with 39 points and Connecticut in third with 29 points. On the women's side, UofL is tied with Notre Dame in first with 26 points each, while Providence is third with 25 points, Georgetown in fourth with 24 points and Pitt in fifth with 21 points.

In the final event of the day, Cardinal sophomore Tone Belt stayed unbeaten in the long jump in 2007 with a meet record, school record and automatic NCAA qualifying mark of 26-01.00, the best Division I mark in the nation this season. Belt entered the day already atop the national performance list in the long jump, but Saturday's jump, which clinched his second straight BIG EAST indoor long jump title, was more than two inches better than his previous best mark of 25-10.75 set at last week's Tyson Invitational in Arkansas.

Overall, the Cards scored 27 points in the long jump as sophomore Andre Black had a personal best jump of 25-02.75 to finish second overall, while sophomore Rudon Bastian made it a Cardinal sweep on the podium with the third-place jump of 24-11.00. Another sophomore, Darin Bright, added the final three points in the event for UofL with sixth-place.

The Cardinal men's team's third win of the day came in the men's 5,000-meter run as junior Wesley Korir dominated the field of 16 other runners with a time of 14 minutes, 6.67 seconds to finish more than seven seconds ahead of second place Patrick Smyth of Notre Dame.

Also earning medals for top three finishes for the Cardinal women on Saturday was sophomore ZeNai Savage and freshman Rachel Gehret. Savage finished second in the weight throw behind teammate Emily Turland with a personal best mark of 60-06.50, while Gehret finished third overall in the long jump with a personal best mark of 18-09.75.

Other point scorers for the men on Saturday included Andrew Hackney in the men's weight throw with the fourth-place mark of 60-10.50 and the team of Cory Thorne, Nathan Navaro, P.J. Fox and Soimo Kiplagat, who finished seventh overall in the distance medley relay with a school record time of 9:55.54. Also scoring points for the women on Saturday was sophomore Seidre Forde with the seventh-place mark of 18-04.50 in the long jump.

UofL also had eight athletes advance to Sunday finals led by sophomore Bryan Webb, who advanced in the 200m and 400m, while sophomore Nathan Navaro and freshman Chris Brautzsch each advanced in the 60m hurdles. On the women's side, three athletes advanced after school record performances in the Saturday prelims including senior LaShondra Durias in the 60m (7.59), freshman Theresa Lewis in the 60m hurdles (8.41, NCAA provisional mark) and freshman Elisabeth Slettum in the 200m (24.05). The women's team's fourth finalist was freshman Tarah McKay in the mile (4:54.56).

## **BIG EAST Indoor Championships (Day 2)** Akron, Ohio February 17-18, 2007

**AKRON, Ohio** – The ninth-ranked University of Louisville men's track and field team earned three individual event titles and six medalists on the final day of competition to finish second overall at the BIG EAST Indoor Championships, while the Cardinal women added one event champion and three medalists to finish sixth overall after the final day of action at the Akron Athletics Field House.

The UofL men scored 131 points overall, while Notre Dame edged the Cards with 133.5 points. It was a two-team race for the title as Connecticut was a distant third with 105 points, followed by Georgetown in fourth with 82 points and Rutgers in fifth with 71.5 points. The second place finish matches the program's best ever conference finish, also accomplished at the 2006 BIG EAST Outdoor Championships.

The Louisville women finished sixth overall with 70.10 points, while Georgetown won the women's title with 112 points overall. Notre Dame was second in the women's event with 101.6 points, followed by Connecticut in third (77.6 points) and Pittsburgh and Villanova tied for fourth (76 points).

"One of our primary goals is to be a conference contender on a year-in and year-out basis, and even though that's happened rather quickly on the men's side, it's still very disappointing to be that close and come up short," said UofL head coach Ron Mann, in his third season with the Cards. "We have a number of fierce competitors on this team and they know that losing is never acceptable. But I am proud of the effort we got this weekend because we had a number of kids really step up for us."

Winning event titles on Sunday for the Cardinal men were sophomore Andre Black in the triple jump, sophomore Steven Hnat in the shot put and sophomore Tone Belt in the high jump. Freshman Elisabeth Slettum led the way for the Cardinal women with the win in the 200m.

Black won his second straight BIG EAST indoor triple jump title with a school record and NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 52 feet, 5.5 inches, the third best mark in the nation in 2007. Black, who's top mark came on his first attempt of the day, is now a three-time BIG EAST champion having also won the 2006 outdoor triple jump title.

Hnat won the shot put with a school record throw of 56-09.50, while Belt won the high jump with a cleared height of 7 feet, 3 inches, matching his own school record set earlier this season and a new BIG EAST championships event record.

Belt was also named Most Outstanding Men's Field Performer of the Meet after scoring 26 points for the Cardinal men with wins in the long jump and high jump and a third-place finish in the triple jump. It's his second such award for the two-time NCAA All-American after winning the same honor at the 2006 BIG EAST Outdoor championships.

On the women's side, Slettum won the 200m with a school record time of 23.93 seconds breaking her previous school record of 24.05 set during yesterday's preliminary round.

Overall, the Cardinal men and women combined to earn eight individual conference titles, twice as many as last year's total and 17 total medalists, up from 11 at last year's BIG EAST Indoor Championships. The Cardinal men improved two positions on last year's fourth-place finish at the BIG EAST Indoor Championships, while the women also moved up two positions after an eighth-place finish in 2006.

"There are a number of positives to be taken from this weekend's meet because we've clearly improved from last season," Mann said. "But it's all about executing when things are on the line and when you get that close, you have to learn to get over the hump and finish every event as strongly as possible to score every point that's within reach."

## **USA Indoor Championships** Boston, Mass. February 24-25, 2007

**BOSTON, Mass.** – University of Louisville sophomore Tone Belt closed the final day of competition at the AT&T USA Indoor Track & Field Championships with a fifth-place finish in the long jump, while Emily Turland finished seventh in the weight throw.

Belt, a two-time NCAA All-American from Berkeley Springs, W.Va., had a jump of 24 feet, 11 inches to finish fifth in the field of 11 jumpers, while Trevell Quinley won the event with a jump of 26-06.50. During Saturday's first day of competition, Belt, who has qualified to compete at the NCAA Indoor Championships in the both the long jump and high jump, finished 10th in the high jump with a cleared height of 7-00.50, while Tora Harris won the men's high jump with a cleared height of 7-06.00.

Turland, a native of New Albany, Ind., and the 2007 BIG EAST weight throw champion, finished seventh in the field of 13 with a throw of 64-08.50, while Amber Campbell, a five-time NCAA All-American won the event with a mark of 80-06.25.

## **Alex Wilson Invitational** South Bend, Ind. March 2-3, 2007

**SOUTH BEND, Ind.** – University of Louisville senior Wesley Korir won the 5,000-meter run, while sophomore Andre Black won the long jump to lead the seventh-ranked Cardinal men's track and field team on the first day of competition at the Alex Wilson Invitational Friday at Notre Dame's Loftus Center.

Korir, a native of Eldoret, Kenya and the 2007 BIG EAST champion in the 5,000m, won Friday's race with an NCAA provisional qualifying time of 13 minutes, 53.85 seconds, less than two seconds off of his school record mark of 13:52.63 set earlier this season at the Meyo Invitational at Notre Dame.

Black, a native of Mobile, Ala., won the long jump title with a mark of 24 feet, 4.5 inches, while teammate Rudon Bastian, a sophomore from Nassau, Bahamas, was second with a jump of 24-02.25.

The fourth and final Cardinal athlete competing on Friday was senior Arthur Turland, the 2007 BIG EAST champion in the weight throw, who finished third in Friday's weight throw with an NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 64-01.75.

### **Day One**

University of Louisville freshman Theresa Lewis finished second in the women's 60-meter hurdles, while sophomore Seidre Forde set a school record in the women's triple jump on the final day of competition at the Alex Wilson Invitational Saturday at Notre Dame's Loftus Center.

Lewis, a native of Randallstown, Md., finished second overall with a time of 8.44 seconds in the 60m hurdles. Forde, a native of Green's St. George, Barbados, broke her own school record in the triple jump with a mark of 41 feet, 0.5 inches to finish fifth overall in the event. Her previous school record mark of 40-11.00 was set on Dec. 8, 2006 at the SIU Fast Start Invitational.

This is the Cards' final competition prior to next week's NCAA Indoor Championships. UofL has one automatic qualifier and 10 provisional qualifiers for the national championships and the final field of athletes in each event will be announced by the NCAA on Monday evening.



# 2007 Indoor Meet Recaps

## **NCAA Indoor Championships (Day 1) Fayetteville, Ark. March 9-10, 2007**

**FAYETTEVILLE, Ark.** – On a historic day for the University of Louisville track and field program, sophomore All-American Tone Belt won the program's first ever NCAA championship and U of L's first NCAA title in any sport since the 1986 men's basketball team title with his victory in the long jump competition Friday at the 2007 NCAA Indoor Championships at the University of Arkansas' Randal Tyson Track Center.

Overall, the Cardinal men closed the first day of the two-day indoor national championship meet in eighth place with 11 points, while Wisconsin leads the way with 20 points, followed by Auburn, Tennessee, Arkansas and Florida State all with 15 points each.

Belt had a school record mark of 26 feet, 1.75 inches on his second attempt of the night to dominate the field of 15 of the nation's best collegiate long jumpers. Belt is now a three-time NCAA All-America performer after earning a pair of fifth-place finishes in the long jump and high jump at the 2006 NCAA Outdoor Championships. Friday's jump broke Belt's previous school record mark of 26-01.00 set in winning the BIG EAST title on Feb. 17 and the nation's top mark entering this weekend.

"It feels very good to win this title, but I don't want to get too excited because I'll be back tomorrow for the high jump competition," said Belt, who enters Saturday's high jump competition ranked in the Top 10 in nation in that event. "I know I will be pretty excited when I get a chance to talk to my Mom on the phone later tonight because this will mean a lot to her. I knew after I had the big jump on my second attempt that I had a great shot at top three finish and I was able to pull it off."

The national title, UofL's third NCAA national championship along with the two men's basketball team titles in 1980 and 1986, is the latest performance for a University of Louisville track and field program which continues to make waves on the national scene. Prior to the 2006 NCAA Outdoor Championships, UofL's men's and women's track and field teams had combined for a total of four All-Americans, while in the last eight months alone, the Cards have had five All-America performances, including senior Arthur Turland in the men's weight throw to open Saturday's competition.

"My focus wasn't on winning a national title for me or my own personal record, it was about doing whatever I could for this program to succeed," said Belt prior to being awarded his national title trophy. "We had so many other athletes that were very close to getting here. This team is continuing to grow and improve and I can only imagine how far we can go over the next few years." Earlier in the day, Turland became the University of Louisville's first ever indoor track and field All-American with his eighth-place finish in the men's weight throw. Turland, a native of Kincardine, Ont., had a top mark of 68 feet, 10.5 inches, to finish eighth overall and earn his first All-America honor.

"I'm extremely pleased with the way I performed today because to be at a meet of this caliber and to have the second-best throw of my career is a very good accomplishment," Turland said. "To be the first indoor All-American is a nice honor, but I think I'm just setting the tone for everybody else and the future of this program."

The 2007 BIG EAST weight throw champion and a three-time BIG EAST champion overall, Turland is just the third men's track and field athlete at UofL to earn All-America honors joining current teammate Tone Belt (three-time All-American) and former Cardinal James Dennis (two-time All-American).

With two more All-America performances on Friday, Mann, introduced as UofL's head coach on July 2, 2004 after a highly successful career at Northern Arizona University, has now coached a total of 112 NCAA All-Americans and Belt's win gave the coach his fifth individual national champion.

"I'm so proud of the way Tone and Arthur competed today and the way they continue to represent the University of Louisville with class and dignity," Mann said. "Our track and field program is so fortunate to have such wonderful support from (UofL Athletic Director) Tom Jurich and (UofL Senior Woman Administrator) Julie Hermann, and I truly believe we're just breaking the ice on what can be accomplished at the University of Louisville."

## **NCAA Indoor Championships (Day 1) Fayetteville, Ark. March 9-10, 2007**

**FAYETTEVILLE, Ark.** – The University of Louisville track and field program completed its most impressive weekend ever as sophomore Andre Black won the triple jump national title Saturday night to lead the Cardinal men's team to a 10th-place finish overall at the 2007 NCAA Indoor Championships at the University of Arkansas' Randal Tyson Track Center.

In the program's first-ever appearance at the indoor national championships, the Cards won a pair of individual national titles and produced three All-American performances overall to score 21 points and tie Baylor, LSU and Tennessee for 10th-place overall. Wisconsin won the men's title with 40 points, followed by Florida State in second with 35 points and Texas in third with 34 points.

Following the preliminary round of jumps (three attempts), Black, a three-time BIG EAST champion, was in fourth place overall, and after moving into second place on his fourth attempt, he jumped to the lead on his fifth attempt with a school record mark of 53 feet, 5.5 inches. The native of Mobile, Ala., then held on through the final round of jumps to earn the fourth NCAA title of any kind at the University of Louisville.

"I'm blessed and that's really the only word I can think of to sum up how I feel right now," Black said. "The coaches told me that I had put in the work and made the sacrifice to be at this point and it feels great to see that pay off. I don't think it's really sunk in yet, and it may not for a while. I wasn't happy with the way I started in my first jump, but (UofL jumps coach) Coach (Jake) Jacoby calmed me down and told me to stop trying too hard and just let it happen and it feels great."

Black joins teammate and fellow sophomore Tone Belt as a 2007 national champion after Belt became the Cards' first track and field national champion with his win in the long jump on Friday night with his school record mark of 26-01.75. The tandem has led the way for Cards' amazing move among the nation's elite in track and field over the last two seasons.

"Before I came here, people said that they had never heard of Louisville in track and field, but we're really doing some great things with our team," Black said. "To have three more All-Americans and earn a top 10 finish is a credit to all of our coaches and their hard work and to Mr. Tom Jurich (UofL athletic director) for all of the support he's given to our team. We're climbing that ladder to be with the best teams in the nation and I think there's only sunshine ahead for this program."

Entering the weekend, the University of Louisville had won two NCAA championships all-time, the 1980 and 1986 men's basketball team titles, but by weekend's end, the Cardinal track and field program doubled that number with Belt and Black's individual titles. And for the first time in the highly successful career of Ron Mann, the Cards' head coach had two national champions at the same meet. He's now coached six individual national champions and 113 All-Americans.

"I have to echo what Andre said in that I'm truly blessed to be at the University of Louisville," Mann said. "I'm extremely proud of our coaching staff and all of our athletes for what they've done to get to this point. It's truly a team effort and this weekend is not only for the kids who were here competing, but for every kid on our team. We hope to have more and more athletes earn the opportunity to experience the national championships and to continue to compete on this national stage."

"It was really exciting to watch Andre compete tonight because he stayed focused on what he was doing and executed perfectly. His championship performance exemplifies the type of person he is and he does a wonderful job of representing the University of Louisville."

On the women's side, Emily Turland, a senior from New Albany, Ind., narrowly missed on All-America honors and a spot in the weight throw finals with her top mark of 64 feet, 8.75 inches to finish 10th overall. The 2007 BIG EAST weight throw champion and the first ever UofL women's athlete to compete at the NCAA Indoor Championships, Turland was only one position away from advancing to the finals and improved six positions on her national ranking entering the meet. Junior Brittany Riley of Southern Illinois won the women's weight throw title with a world best mark of 83-10.25.
