

**TED SEARCH**

Position: Guard; Height 6-0; Weight 175; age 20 Year Junior; Home Chester, Illinois.

A newcomer to the University of Louisville this season. Search is a Junior College graduate from Wentworth Military Academy. Coach Hickman got his first look at Search this fall, and thinks that he will use him mostly in a reserve role. Search is fairly fast, promises to be a good defensive man, and he is a fair shooter.

Although it looks like Search will be used mostly on the second team, there is no doubt that he will see quite a bit of action this season, because Hickman is carrying only 12 men on the varsity squad this year, so everybody figures to see a lot of service during the 25 game season.

**BILL SULLIVAN**

Position Guard; Height 5-10; Weight 160; Age 20; Year Sophomore; Home Louisville, Kentucky.

Sullivan saw some service with the varsity last season as a freshman and this season he is counted on as being one of the first six men. He is a peeper-pot type of player, fast, pretty good defensively, and a fair long shot man. If Sullivan can successfully fill one of the departed guards shoes he will go a long way in making this a better than average season.

Sullivan played his high school ball at Male High School in Louisville, Kentucky. He is one of the two local boys on this year's squad. Last season he was used sparingly in 12 games scoring only 8 points, but he is a better scorer than last season's record would indicate.

**BOB WELLMAN**

Position Guard; Height 6-2; Weight 170; Age 22; Year Junior; Home Louisville Kentucky.

Wellman is a letterman at the University of Louisville from before the war. He returned to the campus last fall and was on the basketball squad all of last season, but he was used in only 3 games. He has been looking better in fall practices this year and he will probably see quite a bit of action.

Wellman is primarily a guard, but he has been doing a lot of work at a forward position. He is fast enough to fit into the Cards fast breaking style of play, and he possesses a fairly good eye on long shots. He uses his height to good advantage under the boards, so before the year is over he may be playing more forward than guard. Wellman is a graduate of Louisville Manual High School, where he played two years of varsity basketball on the high school team.
