I further agree to indemnify the UNIVERSITY from any loss, liability, damage or cost it may incur due to my participation in said activity in any way whether caused by the UNIVERSITY or otherwise.

In the event of illness or injury resulting or arising directly or indirectly out of said activity, I hereby give my consent and authorization for (1) the administration of emergency first aid care and treatment at the scene of an emergency by faculty, staff members or volunteers of UNIVERSITY or (2) the administration of any treatment deemed necessary by a licensed physician or dentist and (3) the transfer to any hospital reasonably accessible. This authorization is not intended to cover major surgery unless the medical opinions of two (2) licensed physicians or dentists, concurring in the necessity for such surgery, are obtained prior to the performance of such surgery.

Camp Director Ken Lolla

In his first season as the head coach of the University of Louisville men's soccer program, Ken Lolla guided the Cardinals to their first ever Big East Tournament.

Most recently in 2007, the Cardinals advanced to the Semifinals in the Big East Conference Tournament and the 2nd Round of the NCAA Tournament. The Cards defeated The Duke Blue Devils at home in the first ever NCAA Tournament game for the Men's Soccer Program at University of Louisville. The Cardinals also received a Top 25 Ranking Nationally in 2007. The Cardinals earned a Team High GPA and Community Service Awards for men's sports at University of Louisville in 2007.

Lolla joined the Cardinals after spending 13 seasons with the University of Akron. Lolla guided the Zips to 8 Mid-America Conference Championships and a school record five straight NCAA Tournament appearances.

Lolla has also taken his skills to the national level. In the fall of 1999, he was appointed head coach of the U.S. Soccer Federation Under-15 National Team.

In his playing days, Lolla was considered one of the finest midfielders in the Atlantic Coast Conference, earning all-conference honors three times and earned All-South and All-America honors in 1981 and 1983 while at Duke University.

Assisting Lolla at LASA is Brian Maisonneuve who joins the coaching staff this spring after a three-year stint with US Soccer, working with the Youth National Team Residency Program. Maisonneuve, a former Herman Trophy Winner, is a 9-year MLS veteran, playing with the Columbus Crew, as well as playing in the 1996 Olympics and the 1998 World Cup for the US.

Also on staff is Jeremy Proud, a former Youth National Pool and All-Conference Collegiate goalkeeper. Proud works specifically with the goalkeepers at camp.

Camp Philosophy

Development for the Modern Soccer Athlete

At the Achievement Soccer Academy you will experience a positive and challenging environment which will focus on the development of success principles that will enhance both the physical and mental aspects of your game.
