## Men's Tennis Notes - 4

### The Deal with the Cards

- The University of Louisville men's tennis team is coming off of a successful 2011 campaign. The Cards (18-12) finished the season at No. 24 in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association Team rankings after spending 10 weeks in the top 25. Louisville captured its second consecutive and third overall BIG EAST Conference title.
- U of L made its third straight, and eighth overall NCAA appearance and advanced to the regional final before falling to host, tenth-ranked Kentucky.
- Austen Childs became the Cards' only two-time singles All-American after reaching the round of 16 for the second straight season. The graduating senior was also the only player in Louisville history to earn a spot in the NCAA singles championship in each of his four seasons. He also became the first Cardinal player to reach the finals of the NCAA championship in 2010.
- Austen Childs and Viktor Maksimcuk became Louisville's first doubles All-American following a quarterfinal appearance in the 2011 NCAA doubles championship. The University of Louisville senior Austen Childs was named and Intercollegiate Tennis Association Singles All-American and teamed with fellow senior Viktor Maksimcuk to earn doubles All-American status.

### Austen Childs, Viktor Maksimcuk Named ITA All-Americans

Childs is the only two-time singles All-American in program history, and combined with Maksimcuk to become the Cards' first All-American doubles team. He became the first Cardinal player to reach the NCAA Singles Championship title match in 2010 and advance to the round of 16 this season. He is the only four-time NCAA singles and three-time doubles participant in school history.

Childs, who finished the 2011 season with a 33-11 overall singles record was ranked as high as No. 8 in the ITA singles ranking this season. He owns the school record with 107 doubles wins and is tied with Andy Schrecker for the singles record at 119. Childs is a three-time BIG EAST Player of the Year

The duo of Childs and Maksimcuk advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2011 NCAA Doubles Championship to reach All-American status. Childs and Maksimcuk finished the season with a 20-10 overall record and were ranked as high as No. 16 in the ITA doubles rankings.

### daSilva Named ITA Ohio Valley Region Assistant Coach of the Year

Rodrigo daSilva was named the Intercollegiate Tennis Association Ohio Valley Region Assistant Men's Tennis Coach of the Year.

daSilva is in his third season as assistant coach for the Cards. In 2011, he helped lead the Cardinals to their second straight BIG EAST Conference Championship. Louisville also reached the NCAA for the third consecutive season and was ranked as high as No. 12 while appearing in the top 25 in 10 ranking periods.

### Austen Childs Named BIG EAST Player of the Year

The BIG EAST Conference announced Wednesday that University of Louisville senior Austen Childs and USF senior Lucas Jovita were chosen as the 2011 BIG EAST Men's Tennis Players of the Year. Cardinals Simon Childs

and Viktor Maksimcuk joined Austen on the All-BIG EAST list.

Childs becomes a three-time winner of the BIG EAST Player of the Year honor after he went 30-10 overall and 21-5 in dual matches at the No. 1 singles spot in the 2010-11 season. He was 26-10 overall and 20-5 in dual matches in doubles play. Childs was named the Most Outstanding Player of the 2011 BIG EAST Championship after helping the Cardinals to their second straight BIG EAST title and a spot in the NCAA Championship. Childs is ranked No. 16 nationally in singles play and No. 18 in doubles in the final ITA rankings of the regular season. In addition to competing with the Cardinals in the NCAA team championship, Childs is an automatic qualifier to both the NCAA singles and doubles brackets as well.

### **Austen Childs and Viktor Maksimcuk Selected for NCAA Individual Championships**

Senior Austen Childs was selected as the No. 16 seed in the NCAA singles championship and was selected to team with senior Viktor Maksimcuk to compete in the doubles championship.

The marks the fourth time Childs, who finished runner-up in the 2010 NCAA championship, has been selected to participate the national singles tournament. The All-American and two-time BIG EAST Player of the Year leads the team with a 30-10 overall record and a 21-5 mark in as their top-seeded player. Childs is currently 16th in the ITA singles rankings – he reached a career-high 8th this season and has remained in the top 20 in every ranking period this year.

Childs and Viktor Maksimcuk are No. 18 in the May 2 ITA rankings. The duo compiled a 17-9 overall record and went 11-4 at No. 1 for the Cardinals. They also teamed to win the USTA/ITA Ohio Valley Regional Championship in the fall.

### **Louisville Captures Second Straight BIG EAST Conference Title**

The 24<sup>th</sup> ranked and top-seeded University of Louisville men's tennis team defeated second-seeded host Notre Dame 4-2 in the BIG EAST Conference Championship finals on Sunday May 1. This marked the second consecutive and third overall league title for the Cardinals (17-11). The Cardinals earn the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

En route to the title matchup against Notre Dame, the Cards defeated St. John's 4-0 in the semifinals and Connecticut 4-0 in the quarterfinals.

### **Austen Childs Named U of L's Ed Kallay Senior of the Year**

Austen Childs was named the University of Louisville Athletic Department's Ed Kallay Senior of the Year at the All-Sport Award Banquet on April 25. The Ed Kallay is awarded annually to a senior female and a senior male student-athlete. Seniors are nominated for exemplifying the characteristics of leadership, exuberance for sport, devotion to U of L, commitment to community service, and dedication to excellence in their sport.

### **Simon Childs Named BIG EAST Player of the Week**

Senior **Simon Childs** was named BIG EAST Male Tennis Player of the Week for the period ending April 26.

Childs helped the Cardinals climb from No. 29 to No. 24 in the ITA Tennis Rankings after edging then-No. 28 Notre Dame 4-3 April 23. The senior's win at No. 1 doubles earned UofL the doubles point and his win at No. 3 singles decided the match. Childs paired with senior Viktor Maksimcuk to defeat Niall Fitzgerald and Spencer Talmadge 8-6. The Cardinal duo is ranked No. 59 in the ITA rankings. In singles action, Childs beat No. 109 Daniel Stahl 6-3, 6-4. He improved to 14-9 on the season.

### **Viktor Maksimcuk Earns His Second EAST Player of the Week Honor of the season**

Senior Viktor Maksimcuk was named BIG EAST Men's Tennis Player of the Week for the period ending April

Maksimcuk helped the Cardinals climb from No. 32 to No. 29 in the ITA Tennis Rankings after upsetting then-No. 23 Indiana 6-1 April 17. The 103rd-ranked singles player downed Indiana's 114th-ranked Josh MacTaggart 6-2, 6-3 at No. 2 singles. Maksimcuk paired with senior Simon Childs to beat the Hoosier duo of Santiago Gruter and Jeremy Langer 8-3 in the No. 1 position, clinching the doubles point.

### **Austen Childs Named BIG EAST Player of the Week for Third Season Honor**

For the second straight week, Louisville senior Austen Childs was named BIG EAST male Tennis Player of the Week (April 6). This marked the third conference award for Childs this season and sixth for the Cardinal men.

Childs helped the No. 31 Cardinals down two ITA-ranked opponents last week. In Louisville's 5-2 win against No. 40. VCU April 2, the senior won 6-2, 3-6, 6-3 at the No. 1 spot and teamed with Adam Donaldson for an 8-6 No. 3 doubles victory. U of L defeated No. 45 USF 5-2 April 3 as 16th ranked Childs came from behind to beat No. 73 Lucas Jovita 4-6, 6-4, 6-4. Childs and Donaldson picked up an 8-1 No. 3 doubles win.

### **Austen Childs takes over first place on All-Time Doubles Victories List**

On April 2 senior Austen Childs set a new school record for the most All-Time Doubles victories with an 8-6 win over Virginia Commonwealth's team of Alejandro Argente and Jordan Dyke. Childs teamed with junior Adam Donaldson for his 96th career doubles victory. The win puts him at the top of the record books, followed by Brendan Burke (1984-1987) with 95 All-time doubles wins.

Throughout his career, Childs has posted a 97-48 overall doubles record. On the season he has teamed with Donaldson and senior Viktor Maksimcuk for a 21-9 overall record and a 13-4 dual record.

Childs also sits at second in the record books for singles victories. He has amassed 111 singles wins in his four year career, eight wins under Andy Schrecker (1988-1992) who holds the record with 119 career victories.

### **Cardinals Perfect at Home**

The Louisville men's tennis team compiled an 11-0 record when playing at the Bass Rudd Tennis Center this season. The Cardinals were also perfect at the BRTC during the 2010 season, going 12-0. Combined, the team has put together a streak of 29 unbeaten matches at home, dating back to a 4-3 victory over Notre Dame on April 11, 2009.

During the streak, Louisville has hosted 15 ranked opponents including six teams ranked in the top 25 of the ITA national polls. Among the ranked teams to have visited the Bass Rudd Tennis Center were Notre Dame (2009 and 2011), Virginia Tech (twice) in 2010, and Mississippi, Oklahoma, Maryland and Indiana so far this season.

On top of regular season match play, the BRTC has also served as a host site for several national tournaments. In 2010, the Cardinals were selected to host the 1st and 2nd rounds of the NCAA championship where they defeated Eastern Kentucky and Virginia Tech. Earlier in the 2011 season, Louisville hosted the ITA National Kick-off Weekend which they won by beating Columbia and Oklahoma.

### **Austen Childs Named BIG EAST Player of the Week**

Senior Austen Child was named BIG EAST Player of the Week following dominating performances during the period ending on Feb. 22. He became the fourth Louisville player to earn the honor in four weeks.

Childs led the No. 15 Cardinals, going 2-1 in No. 1 singles action and 2-0 in No. 1 doubles play at the ITA National Indoor Championships. Childs, No. 11 in the ITA singles rankings, downed No. 6 UCLA's 63rd ranked Daniel Kosakowski 6-2, 6-2 on Feb. 18. The senior defeated No. 16 Georgia's 24th ranked Javier Garrapiz 7-6 (7-4), 6-0, before dropping a 3-6, 3-6 decision to fourth-ranked Steven Johnson of No. 2 Southern California.

In No. 1 doubles action, the 26th ranked team of Childs and Viktor Maksimcuk beat UCLA's Alex Brigham and Amit Inbar 8-5. The Cardinals duo also defeated USC's Daniel Nguyen and Emilio Gomez 8-1.

### **Louisville falls at National Indoor Championship**

The No. 12 men's tennis team suffered three defeats at the National Indoor Championship Feb. 18-21 in Seattle,

Wash. The team first matched up against No. 6 UCLA where they lost 4-1 with their point coming on senior Austen Childs' 6-3, 6-2 victory over No. 63 Daniel Kosakowski.

The Cards met No. 16 Georgia in the consolation match where they lost 4-1. Again senior Austen Childs was able to capture a point for Louisville, beating No. 24 Javier Garrapiz 7-6 (7-4), 6-0. In their final match of the competition, the Cards faced No. 2 Southern California and lost 4-0.

This is the second time that the Cardinals have advanced to the Indoor Championships. They made it during the 2010 season where they also were ousted in the first round.

Louisville served as the host site for the Kick-off Weekend qualifying tournament. They defeated No. 48 Columbia and No. 18 Mississippi to earn their spot in the championship.

### **Andrew Carter Named BIG EAST Player of the Week**

Junior Andrew Carter was named BIG EAST Men's Tennis Player of the Week for the period ending Feb. 14. This marks the third consecutive league honor for the Cardinals in the 2011 season.

Carter clinched the Cardinals' 4-3 win over No. 24 Oklahoma, helping Louisville achieve its best start in program history at 8-0. Carter defeated Oklahoma's Lawrence Formentera 4-6, 6-0, 6-4 at the No. 5 position and teamed with Simon Childs to defeat the 38<sup>th</sup> ranked duo of Warder and Formentera 8-5 at the No. 2 spot in doubles.

### **Cardinals Win 2011 Kick-off Weekend Tournament**

The Louisville men's tennis team was selected as a host site for the 2011 ITA Kick-off Weekend Tournament. The event took place January 28-30 at the Bass Rudd Tennis Center.

Along with the #13 Cards, the event featured the No. 18 Mississippi Rebels, the No. 35 Tulsa Golden Hurricane and the No. 48 Columbia Bears.

In the opening round, first-seeded Louisville defeated fourth-seeded Columbia 4-0 behind strong play from seniors Viktor Maksimcuk and Simon Childs.

The final matched the Cardinals against second-seeded Ole Miss. Louisville dropped the doubles point before rallying to win the match 4-2. Senior Alejandro Calligari clinched the match for Louisville in a three set victory.

### **Viktor Maksimcuk BIG EAST Player of the Week**

Louisville's Viktor Maksimcuk was named the league's first player of the week for the 2011 season on Feb. 2. The senior went 2-0 at the No. 2 singles spot and 2-0 as the No. 1 doubles team at the Kick-off Weekend Tournament. Maksimcuk's performance led the Cards to their second consecutive regional victory.

In singles action, Maksimcuk, who was ranked 75th in the ITA singles rankings, defeated Columbia's No. 48 Cyril Bucher and No. 107 Tucker Vorster of Mississippi on the weekend. He combined with teammate Austen Childs for two wins in doubles action, including an upset of Ole Miss' second-ranked duo of Chris Thiemann and Marcel Thiemann.

### **Alejandro Calligari BIG EAST Player of the Week**

Louisville senior Alejandro Calligari was named BIG EAST tennis Player of the Week on Feb. 9 following his dominating performance the week prior. Calligari helped the No. 13 ranked Cardinals to a 2-0 record, going 2-0 at the No. 3 singles spot and 2-0 in No. 3 doubles.

In singles action, Calligari defeated Murray State's Luka Milicevic 6-0, 6-1 in U of L's 7-0 victory on Feb. 3. He also downed Morehead State's Nathan Martin 6-0, 6-2 as the Cards posted their second shutout of the Feb. 3 double header. In No. 2 doubles, the senior combined with Amaury Derognat to beat Murray State's Milicevic and Renaldo Domoney 8-3, while edging Morehead State's Roger White and Hugo Almonte 8-5.

### **Cardinals Earn Best Start in Program History**

With a 4-3 defeat of No. 24 Oklahoma, the Cardinals improved to 8-0 on the season and set a new record for best start in program history. Louisville set the previous mark, 7-0, during the 2010 season where they fell to then No. 2 Ohio State for their first loss.

The Cardinals edged Oklahoma for the doubles point with the combination of Austen Childs and Viktor Maksimcuk beating the Sooners' Ionut Beleleu and Costin Paval 9-7 while Cardinals Simon Childs and Andrew Carter downed John Warden and Lawrence Formentera 8-5.

In singles action, Austen Childs beat Beleleu 6-1, 6-2 and Dante Terenzio defeated Tsvetan Mihoy 6-2, 6-3 to give the Cards an early 3-0 lead. Louisville dropped a point before eventually clinching the victory on Andrew Carter's 4-6, 6-0, 6-4 victory over Formetera.

### **Louisville's Austen Childs named a BIG EAST Scholar-Athlete of the Year**

Senior Austen Childs was one of 16 male student-athletes - one from each BIG EAST institution - to be awarded a \$2,000 scholarship as the winner of the 2010-11 American Eagle Outfitters BIG EAST Institutional Male Scholar-Athlete Awards. The selections were made by the conference's Academic Affairs Committee. The 16 selections represent some of the best and brightest in BIG EAST athletics.

Childs, the 2010 national runner-up and All-American, is a three-time All-BIG EAST team member and two-time league Player of the Year. The 2010 season marked the third consecutive year Childs competed in the NCAA singles championship and the first time he advanced past the first round. The 2010 (and 2009) BIG EAST Player of the Year also became only the second All-American in program history when he reached the NCAA round of 16.

Rex Ecarma is in his 21st season as head coach of the University of Louisville. During his time at U of L, the Cards have won two conference championships and have made six NCAA regional appearances including three regional finals. Louisville is coming off of a 21-8 season and competed in the team, singles and doubles NCAA Championships marking the fourth year in a row the Cards have had a doubles team in the championship and the third time in four years a singles player has been selected.

During the 2010 season, Ecarma earned his 300th career victory over Oklahoma State on February 27. The 6-1 win made him one of the youngest head coaches to reach the milestone.

The 2009 season marked one of the most successful seasons in program history in which the Cards reached as high as No. 14 and finished the year at No. 22 in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association rankings. The remarkable year saw Louisville with three ranked singles players and doubles teams, three All-BIG EAST selections and Austen Childs earning league Player of the Year honors. For the second season in a row, Childs earned a spot in the NCAA singles championship and teamed with fellow sophomore Simon Childs for a doubles appearance. The duo also achieved the program's highest ranking at No. 6 and finished the season at No. 29.

In 2007, Ecarma oversaw the Cardinals to a runner-up finish in the BIG EAST tournament and guided seniors Damar Johnson and Slavko Radman to Louisville's second consecutive appearance in the NCAA Doubles Championship. The pair also reached the program's highest doubles rankings at number seven.

In 2006, the Cardinals opened their first season in the BIG EAST Conference by capturing the tournament title and earning their third consecutive NCAA tournament appearance - the school's fifth appearance since 1998. U of L was also selected to host the 2006 NCAA first and second rounds for the first time in school history and advanced to the second round of the regional for the second season in a row. In addition, the Cardinals won the 2006 HEB National Invitational and achieved the highest team ranking in program history at No. 12 and had three singles players and two doubles teams ranked.

Ecarma was named Conference USA Coach of the Year in 2000 after guiding the Cardinals to their first ever conference title and their second NCAA tournament appearance in three years. Ecarma led the Cards to more overall team wins (162) than any other Conference USA team since 1996, the league's inaugural season.

In 1990, he became one of the youngest head coaches in Division I tennis in the country at the age of 23. Under Ecarma's tutelage, the school has attained its highest national ranking at No. 12 in the ITA computer rankings, while spending several weeks among the nation's top 25.

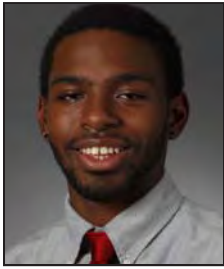
