## Four Cardinals Advance to 2008 NCAA Indoor Championships

The University of Louisville will have four athletes traveling to Fayetteville, Ark., for the 2008 NCAA Indoor Championships on March 14-15. The Cardinal women will have a school record number of three athletes competing led by junior Jere' Summers, who qualified in the weight throw and shot put. Also representing the Louisville women will be senior captain ZeNai Savage in the shot put and junior Seidre Forde in the triple jump.

Representing the Louisville men at the national championships will be junior Rudon Bastian in the long jump. Last year, the Cards swept the men's long jump and triple jump titles as Tone Belt and Andre Black became the first pair of teammates to win those indoor titles at the same NCAA meet.

### Cardinals Have Set 15 School Records in 2008

U of L has set 15 school records in 2008, including eight for the men. Leading the way is Chris Danks in the 800m (1:51.81) and he's joined by Edmund Yeboah (60m, 6.79), Joey Hodges (600m, 1:22.75), Luc Schout (mile, 4:06.10), Cory Thorne (3000m, 8:06.65), Kyle Gann (pole vault, 15-9), Steve Hnat (shot put, 58-6.75) and Andrew Blaser (heptathlon, 4,702 pts).

The Cardinal women have seven records led by Seidre Forde (triple jump, 43-04.25; long jump, 19-10.25) and Jere' Summers (shot put, 53-09.75; weight throw, 67-0.75) in two events each. They're joined by Kat Alcorn (800m, 2:21.96), Taryn Gibson (3000m, 9:39.040, and the team of Lotte Jacobs, Alexandra Mobley, Alcorn and Emily Borsare in the DMR (11:57.97).

### Cards Finish with Nine NCAA Provisional Qualifiers Overall

U of L finished with nine total provisional qualifying marks for the NCAA Indoor Championships. Leading the way for the women was junior Jere' Summers (54-0.5, shot put; 67-0.75, weight) in two events and senior ZeNai Savage in two events (53-7.5, shot put; 65-1.25, weight). Also earning an NCAA mark was junior Seidre Forde (42-11.75, triple jump).

Leading the way for the Cardinal men was junior Rudon Bastian in the long jump (25-06), junior Steven Hnat in the shot put (59-0.25), senior Chris Danks in the 800m (1:49.76) and junior Cory Thorne in the 3000m (8:00.98).

### NCAA champions Tone Belt & Andre Black Redshirting in 2007

Juniors Tone Belt and Andre Black, the first pair of athletes from one school to sweep the NCAA indoor long jump and triple jump titles in the same year and the Cards' first ever NCAA event champions, each have the necessary qualifying standards in their primary events (Belt in the long jump and Black in the triple jump) to compete at the 2008 US Olympic Team Trials on June 27-July 6 in Eugene, Ore., and with both athletes aspiring to represent Team USA at the 2008 Summer Olympics, Mann made the decision to limit their competition schedule early in the calendar year (indoor season) to improve their chances for strong results at the Trials.

# 2008 Indoor Meet Recaps

## SIU Fast Start Invitational Carbondale, Ill. December 7, 2007

**CARBONDALE, Ill.** – The University of Louisville opened the indoor season with four event titles, three NCAA Championships qualifiers and three school records Friday at Southern Illinois University's Fast Start Invitational at the SIU Recreational Center.

Leading the way for the Cardinal women were juniors Seidre Forde and Jere' Summers who each earned NCAA qualifying marks with school record setting performances. Forde, a native of Green's St. George, Barbados, was the top collegiate jumper and second overall in the triple jump with a leap of 42 feet, 11.75 inches shattering her own previous school record mark of 41-00.50 set last season.

Summers, a native of Oakland, Calif., and a transfer from Cal State Northridge, won the shot put with a school record setting and NCAA qualifying mark of 53-03.00. In her first ever meet with the Cards, Summers shattered the previous shot put school record of 50-04.50 set by ZeNai Savage at last season's Kentucky Invitational.

Joining Forde and Summers as a school record setter on Friday was sophomore Amaka Omenyinma with her second-place finish in the long jump with a mark of 19-06.25 breaking the previous school record of 19-01.25 set by Ajajah Showell at the SIU Fast Start in 2005.

Also winning event titles for the Cardinal women on Friday was sophomore Kat Alcorn in the mile run with a time of 5:11.38, while senior Christine Krellwitz and sophomore Rachel Gehret each cleared a career best 5-08.75 to tie for the high jump title.

Leading the way for the Cardinal men on Friday was junior Rudon Bastian who earned an NCAA qualifying mark en route to winning his first career long jump title with a career best leap of 25-06.00.

## Indiana Open Bloomington, Ind. January 12, 2008

**BLOOMINGTON, Ind.** – The nationally ranked University of Louisville men's and women's track and field program won eight event titles, earned three regional qualifying marks and added two new school records Saturday at the unscored Indiana Open at the Harry Gladstein Fieldhouse on the campus of Indiana University.

Leading the way for Louisville were the Cardinal women with five event titles and a pair of NCAA qualifying marks, including a pair of wins for junior thrower Jere' Summers. A native of Oakland, Calif., and a transfer from Cal State Northridge, Summers won her second straight shot put title of the season with a regional qualifying mark of 51 feet, while also winning the weight throw title with a distance of 60-07.

Joining Summers with an NCAA qualifying mark on Saturday was senior ZeNai Savage with her mark of 50-00.75 in the shot put, good for second place in the event and her first NCAA mark of the early season. Also winning event titles on Saturday for the Cardinal women was sophomore Amaka Omenyinma in the long jump as she matched her own school record with a leap of 19-06.25. Other wins for U of L came from freshman Lotte Jacobs in the 3,000m run with a time of 10:12.00 and sophomore Rachel Gehret in the high jump with a leap of 5-07.00.

On the men's side, the No. 6 ranked Cards won three event titles, set two school records and earned one NCAA qualifying mark. Leading the way was junior Steven Hnat with his win in the shot put with a school record and NCAA qualifying throw of 58-04.50 breaking his own previous record of 56-09.50 set at last year's BIG EAST Championships.

Other event winners on Saturday for the Cards included junior Andrew Hackney in the weight throw with a mark of 58-11, while junior Cory Thorne won the 3,000m run with a time of 8:23.11. Senior Nathan Navaro set a new school record in the 600m run with a time of 1:23.31 to finish ninth overall and break the previous record of 1:23.64 set by Chris Bright in 1996. Also, freshman Kyle Gann matched Robbie Moore's school record in the pole vault with a mark of 14-11.00 to finish sixth overall in the event.

Debuting as Cardinals on Saturday were mid-year arrivals Seon Powell and Luc Schout, who both joined the program earlier this week with the start of the spring semester. Powell, a freshman from St. Elizabeth, Jamaica, finished second in the triple jump with a leap of 48-07.50, while Schout, a sophomore from Best, The Netherlands, was second to Thorne in the 3,000m with a time of 8:30.73.

## Gladstein Invitational Bloomington, Ind. January 25-26, 2008

**BLOOMINGTON, Ind.** – The nationally ranked University of Louisville men's and women's track and field program closed the final day of competition at the Gladstein Invitational by setting four school records, winning two event titles and earning two NCAA qualifying marks Saturday at Indiana University.

Leading the way for the Cardinal men, ranked sixth in the preseason USTFCCA Top 30, was junior Steven Hnat with a school record and NCAA provisional qualifying throw of 58 feet, 6.75 inches to finish second overall in the shot put. Hnat, a native of Floyds Knobs, Ind., surpassed his own previous school record of 58-04.50 set two weeks ago at the Indiana Open.

Joining Hnat with an NCAA provisional mark on Saturday was junior Rudon Bastian with a leap of 25-03.35 to win his second straight long jump title this season. The native of Nassau, Bahamas, also won the long jump title at the season-opening SIU Fast Start on Dec. 7.

The Louisville men had four more school record performances on Saturday as junior Cory Thorne set a new record in the 800m run with a time of 1:53.66 to finish second overall and break the previous fast time of 1:53.71 set by Jeff Beyst in 1993. The next school record performance of the day came from sophomore Joey Hodges in the 600m run with a time of 1:22.75 to finish fifth overall and break the previous record of 1:23.31 set by teammate Nathan Navaro two weeks ago at the Indiana Open.

There were two records set in the multi events as freshman Andrew Blaser from Meridian, Idaho, made his collegiate debut with a record setting performance in the heptathlon scoring a U of L record 4,685 points breaking the previous school record of 4,596 points set by teammate Robbie Moore last season. The last school record of the day came from freshman Kyle Gann in the pole vault in the heptathlon as the native of Kokomo, Ind., cleared a U of L record height of 15-05.00 to win the event title and break the previous record of 14-11.00 first set by teammate Robbie Moore last season and matched by Gann earlier this season.

On the women's side, the Cards were led on Saturday by the Distance Medley relay team of freshmen Lotte Jacobs and Alexandra Mobley, sophomore Kat Alcorn and freshman Emily Borsare with a first-place and school record setting time of 11:57.97. Not only was it a winning time, but it was nearly 10 seconds faster than the previous school record of 12:06.97 set in 1995 at the Indiana Invitational.

### Day One

The nationally ranked University of Louisville men's and women's track and field program won a pair of event titles, set one new school record and earned one NCAA qualifying mark on the first day of competition Friday at Indiana University's Gladstein Invitational.

Leading the way for the Cards with event titles on Friday was the women's duo of Jere' Summers and Lotte Jacobs. Summers, a junior from Oakland, Calif., won her third straight shot put title of the season with an NCAA provisional qualifying throw of 51 feet, 11.25 inches, her second best throw of the year. Jacobs, a freshman from Helmond, The Netherlands, won her first career event title with a first-place time of 4:57.62 in the mile run.

Also earning a strong finish for the Cardinal women on Friday was sophomore Rachel Gehret in the high jump. A native of Altoona, Pa., Gehret finished second overall in the high jump and was the top collegiate finisher with a cleared height of 5-08.50, the second best cleared height of her career.

Leading the way for the Louisville men was sophomore Cory Thorne, who set a new school record in the mile run with a time of 4:08.24 to finish third overall in the race. A junior from Portsmouth, N.H., Thorne broke the previous school record of 4:10.29 set by Wesley Korir last January in Lexington, Ky.

Earning a runner-up finish for the Cardinal men on Friday was freshman Seon Powell in the triple jump with a leap of 47-05.25.



# 2008 Indoor Meet Recaps

## Rod McCravy Invitational Lexington, Ky. February 1-2, 2008

**LEXINGTON, Ky.** – Junior Cory Thorne, freshman Edmund Yeboah and sophomore Kat Alcorn each set new school records to lead the University of Louisville men's and women's track and field teams during Saturday's final day of competition at the Rod McCravy Invitational at the University of Kentucky's Nutter Field House.

Thorne, a native of Portsmouth, N.H., earned a third-place finish in the men's mile run with a record time of 4:07.81 improving on his previous record time of 4:08.24 set last week at Indiana. A 2007 NCAA All-American in cross country, Thorne is the Cards' school record holder in two indoor events (mile, 800m) and one outdoor event (3000m steeplechase).

Yeboah, from Upland Vasby, Sweden, earned a ninth-place finish in the 60m dash with a school record setting time of 6.80 seconds in his first career collegiate meet after enrolling at U of L in January. The record setting time broke the previous mark of 6.81 set by Shaquan Brown last January.

Alcorn, a native of Hebron, Ky., earned an 11th-place finish in the women's 800m run with a school record time of 2:12.96 improving on the previous record time of 2:13.6 set by former Cardinal great Bettina Bard in 1996. Alcorn is also the Cards' school record holder in the indoor 1,000m at 2:59.32.

Adding another NCAA qualifying performance on Saturday was junior Jere Summers in the shot put with a throw of 52-10.75, her second best mark of the season and the second best throw in U of L history behind only her school record throw of 53-03 at Southern Illinois on Dec. 7. On Friday, Summers earned an NCAA provisional qualifying mark in the weight throw with a career best mark of 63-08.25 to finish second overall in the field of 24.

Also adding top eight finishes for the Cardinal men on Saturday was Michael Eaton in the mile (fourth, 4:09.09) and Luc Schout in the 3,000m (seventh, 8:23.80). Other top eight finishers for the Cardinal women on Saturday included Rachel Gehret in the high jump (third, 5-06.00), Lotte Jacobs in the 3,000m (seventh, 9:46.55) and Brittany Hotaling in the high jump (eighth, 5-02.25).

### Day One

Juniors Jere Summers and Seidre Forde each earned runner-up finishes with NCAA provisional qualifying marks to lead the University of Louisville track and field team during the first day of competition at the Rod McCravy Invitational Friday at the University of Kentucky's Nutter Field House.

Summers, a native of Oakland, Calif., had a career best mark of 63 feet, 8.25 inches in the weight throw to finish second overall in the field of 24. A transfer from Cal State Northridge, Summers' mark is the 13th best throw in the nation this season and the fourth best in school history. With Friday's performance, Summers is now an NCAA provisional qualifier in both the weight and shot put in 2008.

Forde, a native of Green's St. George, Barbados, had a leap of 41-07 on her sixth and final attempt of the night to finish in second place overall. Friday's mark was the second best leap in school history behind only her school record leap of 42-11.75 set earlier this season, which ranked fourth in the nation in 2008 entering this weekend's action.

Joining Summers with a career best mark on Friday was senior captain ZeNai Savage with her throw of 60-10.50 in the weight to finish third overall. The throw was 4.5 inches better than her previous personal best mark of 60-06 set on Jan. 12 at the Indiana Open.

## Meyo Invitational South Bend, Ind. February 8-9, 2008

**SOUTH BEND, Ind.** – Juniors Seidre Forde and Jere Summers each won event titles, while senior Chris Danks and sophomore Luc Schout set new school records to lead the Louisville track and field team on the final day of competition at the Meyo Invitational Saturday at the University of Notre Dame's Loftus Center.

Forde, a native of Green's St. George, Barbados, won the women's triple jump with an NCAA provisional qualifying leap of 42 feet, 10.75 inches, the second best jump in school history. It's the second time this season Forde has earned an NCAA mark with her top mark of 42-11.75 ranking sixth in the nation this season. On Friday, Forde earned a runner-up finish in the long jump.

Summers, a native of Oakland, Calif., and a transfer from Cal State Northridge, won her fourth shot put title of the season in five events with a throw of 51-08.25. On Friday, won her second weight throw title of the season with a mark of 65-02.25, the second best mark in school history and the seventh best throw in the nation in 2008.

For the Louisville men, Danks earned an 11th-place finish in the 800m with a school record setting time of 1:51.81 breaking the previous U of L record time of 1:53.66 set by teammate Cory Thorne two weeks ago. In the Meyo Mile, Schout earned a 12th-place finish in the elite field of milers with a school record time of 4:06.10 breaking the previous school record of 4:07.81 set by Thorne last weekend at the Rod McCravy Invite.

Thorne, competing in the open mile, finished third overall with a time of 4:06.13, just .03 seconds behind Schout's new school record, while freshman Seon Powell earned a fifth-place finish in the triple jump with a career best leap of 50-04.75.

### Day One

Junior Jere Summers won her second weight throw title of the season with the second best mark in school history and the seventh best throw in the nation in 2008 to lead the University of Louisville track and field team on the first day of the Meyo Invitational Friday at the University of Notre Dame's Loftus Center.

A native of Oakland, Calif., Summers had a career best mark of 65 feet, 2.25 inches to defeat a field of 20 other throwers on Friday night in South Bend. The throw, second only to school record holder Emily Turland's 2007 mark of 66-00.50, is 18 inches better than Summers' previous personal best moving the transfer from Cal State Northridge up in the national rankings from 14th to seventh.

Joining Summers with strong finishes on Friday were junior Seidre Forde and sophomore Rachel Gehret with runner-up finishes in the long jump and high jump respectively. Forde, from Green's St. George, Barbados, had a school record leap of 19-10.25 to finish second in the field of 32 in the long jump and break the previous U of L record of 19-06.25 set by teammate Amaka Omenyinma at the season-opening SIU Fast Start on Dec. 7.

Gehret, from Altoona, Pa., cleared a height of 5-08.00 to finish second overall in a field of 32.

Leading the Louisville men on Friday were redshirt freshman Michael Eaton with a fourth-place finish in the 5,000-meter run (14:13.46) and junior Rudon Bastian with a fifth-place finish in the long jump (23-08.75).

## Tyson Invitational Fayetteville, Ark. February 15-16, 2008

**FAYETTEVILLE, Ark.** – Juniors Jere Summers and Seidre Forde moved up the NCAA event rankings with school record performances and top five finishes to lead the University of Louisville track and field team Saturday at the prestigious Tyson Invitational at the University of Arkansas' Randal Tyson Center.

Summers set a new school record and finished fourth overall in the shot put with a mark of 53-09.75, the eighth best throw in the nation in 2008. The throw breaks Summers' own previous school record throw of 53-03 set in December at the SIU Fast Start.

In the triple jump, Forde earned a fifth-place finish with a school record leap of 43-04.25, the eighth-best jump in the nation in 2008. With Saturday's performance, Forde improves on her previous school record leap of 42-11.75 set at SIU in Dec. She is the U of L record holder in both the triple jump and the long jump.

For the Louisville men, freshman Seon Powell led the way with a sixth-place finish in the triple jump with a leap of 49-09.25, while junior Andrew Hackney and freshman Phil Feinberg earned seventh-place finishes in the weight throw and high jump respectively. Hackney had a throw of 62-02.50, while Feinberg had a cleared height of 6-08.75.

### Day One

Throwers Jere Summers and ZeNai Savage earned NCAA provisional qualifying marks and top five finishes in the weight throw to lead Louisville on the first day of competition at the Tyson Invitational.

Summers had a throw of 63 feet, 8.25 inches, which matches her second best mark ever and the fifth-best throw in school history. She finished second overall in the field of 34 of the top collegiate throwers in the nation.

Savage finished fourth overall with a career-best throw of 62-07.75, nearly two feet better than her previous best throw from earlier this season. The throw is Savage's first career NCAA provisional qualifying mark in the weight throw. She also has an NCAA provisional qualifying performance in the shot put in 2008, joining Summers as the Cards' only NCAA qualifiers this season in two events.

## Hoosier Hills Invitational Bloomington, Ind. February 15, 2008

**BLOOMINGTON, Ind.** – With a split squad and a limited number of athletes competing, the University of Louisville track and field team earned five top five finishes Friday night at the Hoosier Hills Invitational.

Leading the way for the Cardinal women was sophomore Theresa Lewis with a runner-up finish in the 60-meter hurdles with a time of 8.56 seconds, while sophomore Lindsey Cook earned a third-place finish in the weight throw with a personal best mark of 53-03.

Also earning top five finishes for the women at IU was sophomore Andrea Sabbatine with a fourth-place finish in the pole vault as she matched a career best with a cleared height of 11-11.75, while sophomore Jenean Pressley was fourth in the triple jump.

On the men's side, senior Soimo Kiplagat earned a fourth-place finish in the 3,000m with a career best and BIG EAST qualifying time of 8:18.82. Also earning good finishes on Friday for the men was freshman Kyle Gann who matched his own school record in the pole vault with a cleared height of 15-05 to finish sixth overall, while freshman Neil Angermeier was sixth in the high jump with a leap of 6-04.75.



# 2008 Indoor Meet Recaps

## BIG EAST Championships

**NEW YORK** – Senior captain ZeNai Savage won Sunday's shot put title to lead the University of Louisville women's track and field team to a third-place finish at the 2008 BIG EAST Indoor Championships, while the Louisville men closed the meet with a fifth-place finish overall.

Savage, a native of Indianapolis, Ind., won her first indoor conference title and her second career BIG EAST title (2007 outdoor shot put) with an NCAA provisional qualifying throw of 52 feet, 10.75 inches, while teammate Jere' Summers was second in the shot put with a throw of 52-09.25. The Cards scored 24 total points in the shot put as freshman Chinwe Okoro was fourth with a personal best mark of 49-08.25, while freshman D'Ana McCarty was eighth at 45-05.75.

Overall, the Cardinal women finished the BIG EAST event with 79 points matching the program's best ever indoor conference meet finish, while Connecticut won their first ever BIG EAST title with 103.5 points. Georgetown was second in the field of 16 teams with 92 points, followed by U of L, Villanova in fourth with 75 points and Pittsburgh in fifth with 71.5 points.

Another medal winning performance for the Cards was turned in by junior Seidre Forde, who finished second in the triple jump with an NCAA provisional mark of 42-09.50. Also scoring points for the women on Sunday was sophomore Theresa Lewis with a fourth-place finish in the 60m hurdles with a time of 8.48 seconds, while sophomore Rachel Gehret was fifth in the high jump with a cleared height of 5-08.75. The final points of the day for the Louisville women came from senior Taryn Gibson with a school record time of 9:39.04 to finish seventh in the 3000m and break the previous U of L record of 9:40.17 set by Michelle Borgert in 1995.

On the men's side, the Cards scored 75.5 points overall to finish fifth in the field of 12, while Connecticut won its second BIG EAST title in three years with 167 points. Notre Dame was second with 139 points, followed by Georgetown in third with 107 and Villanova in fourth with 79 points.

Leading the way for the Cards on Sunday was freshman Edmund Yeboah with a second-place finish in the 60-meter dash with a school record time of 6.79 seconds, which breaks Yeboah' previous school record time of 6.80 set earlier this season.

Joining Yeboah with a school record performance on Sunday was junior Cory Thorne with a third-place finishing time of 8:06.65 in the 3,000m breaking Wesley Korir's previous school record time of 8:06.69 set at last year's BIG EAST Indoor Championships.

Also winning a medal on Sunday for the Louisville men was junior Steven Hnat with a third-place finish in the shot put with a throw of 55-09.75. Also scoring points for the Cards on Sunday was senior Chris Danks with a fifth-place finish in the 800m with a time of 1:54.31, freshman Phil Feinberg with a sixth-place height of 6-07.50 in the high jump, freshman Weston Banks in the shot put with a sixth-place throw of 51-11.25, sophomore Chris Brautzsch with seventh in the 60m hurdles with a time of 8.11 and junior Rudon Bastian in eighth in the triple jump with a leap of 47-01.00.

## Day One

After one day of competition at the 2008 BIG EAST Indoor Track & Field Championships, the University of Louisville women's team leads the way while the Cardinal men stand in second place. Overall, U of L won three event titles and won six medals Saturday at the New Balance Track & Field Center at The Armory.

The Louisville women scored 36 points to lead the way, while USF is second with 26.5 and Notre Dame is third with 26. On the men's side, the Cards scored 42.5 points to trail only Notre Dame's 48 points, while Georgetown is third with 22 points.

Leading the way for the Louisville women was junior Jere' Summers with a win in the weight throw with an NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 65 feet, 4 inches, her best throw of the season. Also earning medals on Saturday for the Louisville women was senior captain ZeNai Savage with a second-place finish in the weight throw with a mark of 62-02 and sophomore Amaka Omenyinma with third in the long jump with a leap of 19-09.75.

The Louisville men won two event titles on Saturday led by junior Andrew Hackney in the weight throw with a personal best throw of 63-04 to clinch his first ever BIG EAST title. Junior Rudon Bastian added the Cards' final BIG EAST title on Saturday winning the long jump with a leap of 24-05.50 marking the third straight year the Cards have won the BIG EAST indoor long jump title.

Also earning medal performances on Saturday for the Louisville men was a third place finish by the Distance Medley Relay team of Luc Schout, Nathan Navaro, Chris Danks and Cory Thorne with a school record time of 9:45.11 breaking the previous U of L record of 9:55.54 set at last year's BIG EAST meet. The Cards also got a school record performance from freshman Kyle Gann in the pole vault with a cleared height of 15-09 to finish fourth overall. The leap improves on his previous school record height of 15-05 set on three different occasions this season.

The Cards had three athletes advance to Sunday finals with preliminary performances on Saturday. For the Louisville men, sophomore Chris Brautzsch finished seventh in the prelims of the 60m hurdles with a personal best time of 8.09 seconds, while senior Chris Danks finished ninth in the prelims of the 800m with a time of 1:53.76. For the Louisville women, sophomore Theresa Lewis had a season's best time of 8.49 seconds in the 60m hurdles to advance to the Sunday final.

## Virginia Tech Last Chance Blacksburg, Va.

**BLACKSBURG, Va.** – Junior thrower Jere' Summers set a pair of school records to lead the University of Louisville track and field teams to a combined five school records and eight NCAA provisional performances at Saturday's last chance meets at Virginia Tech and Notre Dame.

Summers, a native of Oakland, Calif., and a transfer from Cal State Northridge, opened her day at the Virginia Tech Last Chance meet in Blacksburg, Va., by winning the shot put title with a record setting mark of 54-00.50, more than two inches better than her previous school record of 53-09.75 set earlier this season. With her performances on Saturday, Savage will have a solid chance at earning bids in each event for next week's NCAA Indoor Championships.

The final NCAA provisional performance of the day for the Louisville women was turned in by junior Seidre Forde with a fourth-place finish in the triple jump with a leap of 42-10.25, the fourth-best jump in school history. Forde entered the weekend ranked 13th in the nation in the triple jump and should be in position to earn a bid to the national championships.

The Cardinal men earned three NCAA provisional performances and set three school records on Saturday, led by senior Chris Danks and junior Cory Thorne at the Alex Wilson Invitational in South Bend, Ind. Thorne, a native of Portsmouth, N.H., won the 3000m with a U of L record time of 8:00.98, nearly six seconds faster than his previous school record time of 8:06.65 set at the BIG EAST Championships on Feb. 24.

Danks, a native of Florence, Ky., won the 800m with a record time of 1:49.76, more than two seconds faster than his previous school record of 1:51.81 set at the Meyo Invitational on Feb. 9. The final school record of the day for the Louisville men was turned in by junior Steven Hnat in the shot put at Virginia Tech as he finished sixth overall with a mark of 59-00.25, an improvement on his previous school record of 58-06.75 set at the Gladstein Invitational on Jan. 26.
