

Nell Knox not only led the Metro in scoring last season, but she became the all-time leading scorer in Louisville history.

Louisville returned home for two crucial Metro Conference games.

First, revenge for an early season loss was on the mind of the Cards as they hosted Tulane, February 8. Sophomore Jennifer Bursley provided a huge lift off the bench with eight clutch points in an 87-74 win.

In the second game of the two game home stand, Louisville used a 24-2 run in the first half and several clutch

baskets in the paint by Knox in the closing minutes to hold off a late rally by VCU and preserve 59-54 victory.

Louisville then traveled to battle state-rival Western Kentucky. The Lady Cards had not defeated Western in eleven years and, as the final horn sounded, the Cards would have to wait at least another year to end the losing streak as they fell 76-69.

Next stop on the Cardinal road show was UNC Charlotte. Louisville improved its overall record to 14-9 with an 86-82 win. Rose tossed in 15 points in the victory which moved her over the 1,000 point mark for her career.

Last stop on the road trip was Virginia Tech. Virginia Tech, behind five players in double figures, defeated the road-weary Cards, 82-61.

The Lady Cards dropped their second straight game as they ended the Metro Conference regular season schedule on a

down note with a 71-65 home loss to regular-season champion Southern Miss.

The Lady Cards ended the regular season on the road with a 93-61 drubbing of Northeastern Illinois. Junior Nova Sweet scored a career-high 15 points and collected a career-high 12 rebounds in the victory. Louisville finished the regular season with a 15-11 mark.

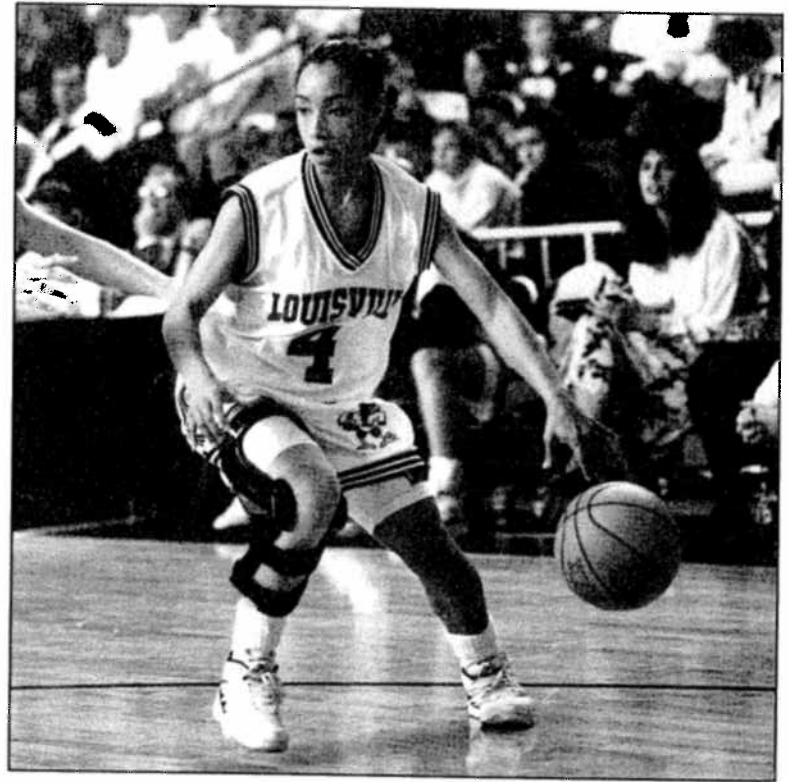
