## THE HIGH SCHOOL CAMP EXPERIENCE



The high school camp is an overnight residential camp designed to provide players ages 14-18 with the highest level of training under the guidance of the University of Louisville's coaches and players. Each player will receive intense training suited to her needs within a group environment that will allow her to develop both technically and tactically.

High school campers will also have an opportunity to enjoy classroom discussions on various topics, including a seminar on college recruiting and leadership development. Players will also receive an overview on strength and conditioning and see first hand the benefits of a strengthening program. Technical and tactical goalkeeping training will also be provided for goalkeepers wishing to hone their skills.

Teams are welcome to attend this camp and will be allowed to train as a group for the entire week. This is an excellent way to prepare your high school team for the upcoming season. Teams of 10 or more are also allowed to have one coach attend the camp for free, and if you bring 18 or more players then two coaches may attend.

### COST AND DEPOSIT

The cost of the High School Residential Camp is \$395, which includes room and board, instruction, and a Louisville Soccer T-Shirt. Camp size will be limited so that players will receive individual attention from the UofL coaching staff.

The cost of the Future Cardinals camp is \$125, which includes instruction throughout the week and a Camp T Shirt for each player

A \$50.00 *non-refundable* initial deposit is required with the application and will be subtracted from the total camp fee. All balances are due in full at registration. All cancellations must be received in writing 10 days prior to the first day of camp in order to qualify for a refund - less \$50.00 deposit. Failure to meet this deadline will result in forfeiture of all payments.
