Meet the Coaches:

Head Coach Missy Beseres



In only her first season as head softball coach at Loyola University Chicago, Missy Beseres accomplished more than nearly any other first-year coach in school history. The former Penn State standout sculpted a young but talented Loyola squad into a 26-win outfit and she also became the first coach in school annals to earn Horizon League Coach of the Year honors in her first season at the helm of the Rambler program. In 2011, Beseres turned a team that was picked to finish sixth in the Horizon League Preseason Poll into the conference's regular-season champion.

The first Loyola coach ever to earn Horizon League Coach of the Year recognition in her first season on the job, Beseres guided the Ramblers to a school-record-tying 16 Horizon League wins in 2011 as the team claimed the regular-season title for the fifth time in the last 11 seasons.

Assistant Coach Jeff Tylka



Jeff Tylka, who has spent the last three seasons as the head softball coach at Antioch High School in Antioch, Ill., is in his first season as assistant softball coach on Missy Beseres' staff at Loyola University Chicago. Over the last three seasons, Tylka compiled a 91-17 (.843) record at Antioch and saw a multitude of his players move on to play collegiate softball.

In 2010, Tylka steered Antioch to a school-record 32 victories and a third-place showing at the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) 3A state tournament.

Assistant Coach Nicole Pauly



Nicole Pauly, a former standout player at Northwestern and member of the Akron Racers of National Professional Fastpitch, is in her second season as a graduate assistant softball coach at Loyola University Chicago. A native of Palatine, Ill., Pauly was a four-time All-Big Ten performer at Northwestern.

One of the most accomplished players in Northwestern history, Pauly concluded her collegiate career with 53 home runs, 168 RBI, 149 runs scored and a .604 slugging percentage, while starting all 215 games Northwestern played during her four years in Evanston. A three-time Academic All-Big Ten selection, Pauly was a 2010 Second Team ESPN Magazine Academic All-District V pick.
