### FIRST SERVE

Loyola wraps up its 2011 season with its annual swing through Northeast Ohio to take on Cleveland State and Youngstown State.

The Ramblers are coming off two tough home losses to Wright State (3-2) and Butler (3-1) last weekend. Freshman Laura Purcell was terrific in both, leading Loyola with 33 kills (3.67 kps), including smashing 18 in the loss to the Bulldogs.

Both Cleveland State and Youngstown State are searching for season sweeps this weekend. Loyola squandered chances in each of the first two sets in a 3-0 loss to the Vikings while the Penguins were able to claim a 3-1 win in the first meeting this season.

## HEAD COACH CHRIS MUSCAT

California native Chris Muscat is in his first season at the helm of the Loyola women's volleyball program, succeeding Marcie Wolbeck to become the ninth head coach in program history. Muscat arrived in Rogers Park after a two-year stint as an assistant coach at Missouri, where he helped the Tigers advance to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament last year. He began his collegiate coaching career in 2007 at Stanford, under the guidance of legendary coach John Dunning, after a stellar playing career at UCLA (Class of 2001), where he was part of two national championship teams (1998, 2000). He got his first coaching win on Sept. 4 against Montana State and brings a 4-20 (.167) record into play this week.

## THE CLEVELAND STATE SERIES

Friday night will be the 42nd meeting between the conference foes, with Loyola holding a 27-14 lead in the all-time series. The Ramblers are a solid 11-6 in Cleveland since the Vikings joined the Horizon League for the 1994 season, however, CSU has won five of the last six meetings here, with a five-set Loyola win on Sept. 19, 2008 the Ramblers' only win in that span. Cleveland State won the first meeting between the two teams this season behind 14 kills from Marie Frease in a match that Loyola had their chances in each of the first two sets.

## THE YOUNGSTOWN STATE SERIES

Saturday afternoon marks the 24th meeting between Loyola and Youngstown State with the Ramblers owning a 16-7 lead in the all-time series. The Penguins are looking for the season sweep, as the Ramblers dropped a four-set decision at the Halas Sports Center despite hitting .254 as a team. Laura Purcell was terrific in that match, burying a season-high 19 kills to lead Loyola. The Beeghly Center, traditionally, has been a tough place for Loyola to find wins as the Ramblers are just 6-4 all-time in Youngstown. Loyola grabbed a 3-2 win there last year to snap a three-match road losing streak in the series.

## MAYBE IT IS HOW YOU START

One troublesome thing for Loyola has been its struggles in the opening set of matches. The Ramblers have dropped the opening set in 19 of its 24 matches and are just 1-18 in those matches, with the lone win coming back on Sept. 9 against Oakland. Loyola can certainly claim that it has had its chances as the team has scored at least 20 points in 11 of the 19 first-set losses.

## FIRST TEAM TO 20 WINS?

While Loyola has gotten off to slow starts in matches this season they have also struggled at times to close out sets. Seven different times during Horizon League play the Ramblers have been the first team to 20 points only to lose the set, a sure sign of growing pains with a young and inexperienced group on the floor. The most recent example came last Friday night, as the Ramblers held a 23-20 lead on Wright State in the pivotal opening set before watching the Raiders rally for a 27-25 that spurred the visitors to an eventual five-set win. The stat fails to account for a similar issue that Loyola had in the fifth set against WSU, as the Ramblers jumped out to a 12-5 lead but could not find the final three points, eventually dropping the set and the match, 16-14.

## THE KIDS CAN PLAY

Loyola's lineup has been dominated by freshmen, as the Ramblers have routinely featured four rookies on the floor at the same time. The group has slowly matured through the first half of the Horizon League season and has accounted for a majority of the team's scoring with the five freshmen notching 648 of the squad's 968 kills this season (66.9%).

## PLENTY OF PURCELL

Freshman hitter Laura Purcell has established herself as one of the Horizon League's top newcomers and has been the leader of the Rambler offense for much of the year. The Louisville, Ky. native drilled a season-high 19 kills in the first meeting against Youngstown State blasted 18 in last Saturday's loss to Butler. In all, Purcell has led Loyola in kills in 15 of its 24 matches this season, including 10 of 14 Horizon League outings. She enters the week sixth in the Horizon League with 3.05 kills per set, tops among freshmen.

## THIS IS MY TEMPORARY HOME

With the only gym that Loyola volleyball has ever known falling victim to the wrecking ball this summer, the Ramblers will use the recently upgraded Halas Sports Center as its home for the 2011 season. Built in 1923, the venerable old Alumni Gym housed the Rambler volleyball program since its inception, with its low ceiling and cozy bleachers creating a daunting homecourt advantage that helped LU post a 209-85 (.711) record from 1987-2010. Loyola will play in Halas this season before moving into Gentile Arena in 2012.

## STYLER WITH SOLID ROOKIE SEASON

Freshman Mary Kate Styler has put together a solid rookie season thus far, however, like many freshmen, has experienced some ups-and-downs. After reaching double figures in kills in four straight matches from Sept. 30-Oct. 9, Styler had been held to single-digit kills in five straight outings before racking up 12 kills in the loss at Green Bay. In addition to the dozen put-aways, Styler racked up a career-best 14 digs against the Phoenix for her first collegiate double-double, and followed that up with another (10 kills, 14 digs) last Friday night against Wright State.

## AND A FRESHMAN SHALL LEAD?

As noted earlier, freshmen Laura Purcell and Mary Kate Styler have carried the Loyola offense this season. Purcell currently leads all Horizon League freshmen, and ranks seventh overall, with 3.05 kills per set with Styler checking in third among freshmen with 2.71 kps. Only once in program history (accurate stats available from 1988-present) has a freshman led the Ramblers in kills, with Sarah Poglits accomplishing the feat in 1998. Listed below are the best offensive seasons by freshmen in Loyola history (sorted by kills per set) and where Purcell and Styler rank.

## KRISTEN'S FRONT (ROW) AND CENTER

After playing exclusively in the back row during her first two-plus years, junior Kristen Hagggenjos has played all six rotations in Loyola's last four matches. The West Dundee, Ill. native racked up five kills against both Bradley and Green Bay and ripped a career-best six kills (to go with nine digs) last Saturday against Butler.

## LIBBY FINISHING STRONG

After struggling a bit during the middle portion of the season, freshman middle Libby Bresser has been playing some solid volleyball of late. Bresser reached double figures in kills for the third time this season with 11 kills against Wright State and is hitting a solid .329 (40-14-79) over her last five matches. Despite her ups-and-downs, offensively, her blocking has been a constant. Bresser leads the Ramblers with 0.88 blocks per set for the season and her 20 solo stuffs place her in a tie with Melissa Craig (2007) for fifth on Loyola's single-season solo blocks list in the rally scoring era.

## WROBEL RUNNING THE SHOW

Fellow freshman Vicki Wrobel has also performed admirably this season after being thrust into the setter role due to Natalie Fiore's injury. Wrobel dished out a season-best 51 assists in Loyola's win over Oakland and has shown steady improvement as the season has worn on. Her defensive improvement is illustrated by the fact that she has recorded double-doubles in her last three matches, including a 49-assist, 12-dig effort last Saturday against Butler. In addition, Wrobel has also given the Ramblers a presence at the service line as her 30 service aces (0.34 aps) rank second in the Horizon League.
