## LMU LIONS (17-20, 10-5 WCC) vs PORTLAND PILOTS (13-22, 6-9 WCC)

**LMU:** Snapped a three-game skid with win over USF on 4/13, but had a three-game win streak snapped on Tuesday at LBSU ... has dropped back-to-back games and eight of the last 12 ... won seven straight games from 3/9 - 3/20 ... seven-game win streak was longest since winning eight straight from 3/24/17 - 4/4/17 ... started the season 3-10 for the first time since 2010 ... 2010 squad then won its next five straight and 10 of next 11 ... LMU went 9-2 over next 11 this year ... is 36-for-52 in stolen bases, and started the year 11-for-11 ... had a string of eight of nine games decided by two runs or less from 2/18 - 3/3 (2-6 in those eight) ... is 5-5 in one-run games this season and 3-2 in extra-inning affairs ... played consecutive extra-inning affairs on 2/18 and 2/20 for the first time since playing 10 and 9 (scheduled for 7) at UCSB and at Texas on March 4 and March 11, 2012 ... last played consecutive 10+inning extra-inning affairs on April 30 and May 1, 2011 at San Francisco ... has played for the WCC Championship three of the last four years (losses to Pepperdine in 2014 and 2015, loss to BYU in 2017) ... last earned an NCAA berth in 2000 ... is picked to finish fifth in the WCC Preseason Coaches' Poll ... is also picked fifth according to D1Baseball.com.

**LION TRACKS:** Dillon Paulson launched a pair of homers and lefty John Beller allowed just two hits over 8.0 solid innings on the mound as USC two-hit LMU in a 6-1 victory on Wednesday ... Beller allowed just a leadoff infield single to Billy Wilson in the first and a double in the fifth inning to Brandon Shearer en route to throwing 8.0 strong frames that included nine strikeouts ... Beller was charged with an unearned run after Jamal O'Guinn dropped a fly ball in right field in front of a sacrifice fly from Kenny Oyama to break up a shutout bid in the eighth ... while Beller was busy twirling a gem, USC's power bats came alive, with Paulson connecting for a two-run homer in the top of the first and eventually adding a solo shot in the fifth ... Lars Nootbaar also launched a homer, connecting for a two-run homer in the third.

**THIS WEEK:** LMU will welcome Portland to Page Stadium for a three-game WCC series beginning on Friday at 6 p.m. ... live links to follow the action can be found at LMULions.com.

**NIKO DECOLATI:** Has managed 10 multi-hit games, including three of the last six games ... second on the team in triples (2), doubles (8), runs scored (26) and homers (3), and is third in steals (6).

**TREVIN ESQUERRA:** Has batted .450 (9x20) with four runs scored and two doubles over the last 5 games ... has managed seven runs scored, three doubles and four RBI over the last 10 games.

**NIKO PACHECO:** Second on the team in average (.312) ... has driven in eight runs over the last 10 games ... batting .367 with three doubles and nine RBI in WCC play.

**BRANDON SHEARER:** Hitting .316 with nine runs scored, three doubles and eight RBI in WCC play.

**JAMEY SMART:** Named a candidate for Senior CLASS Award ... has hit safely in 28 of 37 games this year with 11 multi-hit games ... had multiple hits in 7 games over 12-game hit streak from 3/9-3/29 ... batted .444 (24x54) with 3 R, 5 2B and 21 RBI over hit streak ... has managed two homers and 8 RBI over the last 10 games ... batted .571 (8x14) with a run scored, a double and five RBI in the sweep over Valpo ... named Rawlings WCC Player of the Week on 3/26 after batting .312 with two doubles and seven crucial RBI in helping LMU to a 3-1 week the previous week ... leads the team in RBI (35), and is third in doubles (7) and home runs (2) ... batting .338 with five doubles, two homers and 20 RBI through 15 WCC games ... returns after being named first team All-WCC in 2017.

**NICK SOGARD:** Has collected team-best 12 multi-hit games ... has hit safely in 25 of his 35 games played this year ... batted .692 (9x13) with three runs scored, a homer and two RBI while stealing a pair of bases over four games against Long Beach State and Pepperdine from 3/20 - 3/25 ... hit .455 (5x11) with two runs scored, two doubles and four RBI in the sweep of Valpo ... has collected five RBI over the last five games ... team leader in average (.339) and stolen bases (10), and is third in runs scored (23) and home runs (2) ... hit safely in six straight from 3/16-3/25 (.500 (12x24), 6 R, 2B, HR, 2 RBI) ... batting .346 with 14 runs scored, two doubles and five RBI through 15 WCC games.

**BILLY WILSON:** Has been hit by a pitch 13 times this year, and 49 times in his LMU career - matching the record previously set by Jim McNaney - 49 from 1984-87 ... batted .455 (5x11) with four runs scored, two triples and six RBI in the sweep over Valpo ... posted a pair of triples in the final game against Valpo on 3/11, and currently owns 15 in his career to tie Matt Lowenstein (2010-13) for fourth in LMU's record book ... has hit safely in 27 of 37 games this year, including posting 11 multi-hit games ... leads the team in triples (4) and runs scored (27), and is second in RBI (21).

**NOT AN AVERAGE YEAR:** LMU is hitting just .251 as a team so far this year, and if the season were to end today, that would be the lowest mark since at least 1968 ... LMU hit .261 in 1974, which is the current low over the span ... the lowest average under Jason Gill came in 2012 when the Lions hit .263.

**LOOKING TO STAY ON TRACK:** LMU, which has won three of the last five, will look to keep a rough stretch of play in the rear-view mirror after sweeping San Francisco to move into a tie for first in the WCC standings ... the Lions have been on the wrong end of a lopsided affair in four of the last 10 games, suffering 13-1, 11-4, 18-6 and 13-4 losses ... the Lions are being outscored 82-42 over the last 10 games, which includes a 4-3 win over San Diego on 4/6, a pair of 6-3 wins over San Francisco, and a 4-3 walk-off triumph over the Dons.

**BEER WHILE YOU CHEER:** All Sunday West Coast Conference baseball games will feature free beer for all LMU students, faculty, staff and season ticket holders ... an extension of the successful basketball campaign, those 21 and older with a valid one card will be able to enjoy a beer while cheering on the Lions at the remaining Sunday home WCC games ... season ticket holders will have to show a valid ticket for admission into the serving area ... the location of the serving station will be down the right field line in the "picnic area" of the stadium ... beer will be served beginning 30 minutes prior to first pitch, and will be served up until the fifth inning.

**A CLASS ACT:** Senior Jamey Smart is one of 30 NCAA baseball student-athletes selected as candidates for the 2018 Senior CLASS Award® ... to be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition ... an acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities ... the 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot ... ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one candidate who best exemplifies excellence in the four C's of community, classroom, character and competition ... the Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2018 College World Series® in June.

**MIDWEEK FREE PASSES:** LMU has played nine midweek games this year (1-8) and has walked 57 hitters in those contests (6.49 BB/9 IP) while also hitting 19 - helping to lead to a 7.86 ERA ... in the other 28 games played this year, LMU is 16-12 overall and has walked 94 (3.39 BB/9 IP) and hit 29 - helping to keep the ERA at 4.55 ... the Lions have walked a season-high 10 batters twice this year, issuing 10 and hitting two more in the 13-1 loss to UCLA on 4/3 before walking 10 and hitting three at Long Beach State on 4/17 ... the 10 walks are the most allowed since LMU walked 15 vs. UC Santa Barbara on March 30, 2004.

**IT HURTS SO GOOD:** Senior Billy Wilson drew his 13th hit by pitch of the year in the three-run LMU third inning against San Diego on April 7 ... that was a meaningful bruise, as it was also his 49th career hit-by-pitch - matching the LMU record set by Jim McNaney from 1984-87.

**PASSED BALLS HELPING LMU:** While LMU's catching corps has allowed just six passed balls on the year, LMU has benefitted from 15 offensively ... no two have been bigger than the pair that have resulted in two of LMU's five victories in their final at bat this year ... Nick Sogard scampered home in the top of the ninth at Hawai'i on March 1 as LMU broke a scoreless tie and eventually won 3-0 ... Alex Lambeau scored similarly in the top of the 12th at BYU on March 16, scoring the go-ahead run of a 9-8 victory over the Cougars ... the Lions have also walked-off on a wild pitch, doing so in the bottom of the 11th against USF on 4/15.

**A WHOLE NEW STAFF:** LMU returns just 154.2 innings from last year's pitching staff that logged a combined 502.1 (31%) ... in addition, 12 of those returning innings came from players who are not expected to pitch in 2018 (Steven Chavez and Niko Decolati) ... LMU's staff also returns only nine of its 56 starts from a year ago, with all nine coming outside of a traditional three-game weekend series.

**AND IT'S A YOUNG STAFF:** LMU has used 14\* pitchers this year, but only two have been an upperclassman - junior Codie Paiva and redshirt-senior Tyler Cohen ... in addition to Paiva and Cohen, LMU has used seven true freshmen, a red-shirt-freshman, three true sophomores, and a redshirt-sophomore ... removing position players who have pitched (5.0 total innings), 191 of LMU's 323.1 innings have come from freshmen arms (59%). \* - see "POSITION PLAYERS PITCH WELL" note that follows.

**POSITION PLAYERS PITCH WELL:** All four of LMU's pitchers used on 4/18 vs. USC had seen time as offensive players this year, with Ryan Ruley, Rob Diaz and Harry Hibberd all making their first collegiate pitching appearance ... freshman Austin Carder, who is a legitimate two-way player with innings of work prior to the game, got the start and took the loss after allowing five runs on six hits and a walk over 4.0 innings ... Ruley tossed 2.0 innings and gave up only a solo homer ... Diaz walked just one batter over 2.0 scoreless innings before Hibberd tossed a perfect ninth.

**JOURNEY TO THE TOURNEY:** For the sixth consecutive year, the West Coast Conference will hold a WCC Championship Tournament at Banner Island Ballpark in Stockton, Calif. from May 24-26 to decide who will claim the WCC's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament ... the top-four teams will compete in the tournament, with the #1 seed facing #4 and #2 facing #3 in first-round play ... the tournament is double elimination throughout, with the winner of the tournament earning the WCC's automatic bid ... LMU has played for the WCC Championship in three of the last four years (losses to Pepperdine in 2014 and 2015; loss to BYU in 2017).

**BREAKOUT WEEKEND?** LMU entered the three-game series with Valparaiso hitting just .205 as a team ... through those first 13 games, LMU was 3-10 and was being outscored, 70-43, while averaging 3.31 runs per game ... no everyday player was hitting above .300, as Nick Sogard led the way with a .293 average ... LMU exploded against Valpo pitching, hitting .371 over the course of the three games and outscoring the Crusaders, 32-12 ... LMU featured five players who hit above .400 in the series, including Jamey Smart who went 8-for-14 (.571) with five RBI and Billy Wilson who batted .455 (5-for-11) with two triples and six RBI ... LMU averaged 10.67 runs per game in the sweep of Valpo ... the Lions also collected 16 extra-base hits, including 10 doubles, five triples and a homer after posting just 21 extra-base hits in the first 13 contests combined ... thanks to the outpouring of offense, LMU raised its team average more than 30 points (.237) ... LMU went 9-2 over 11 games beginning with the Valpo series.

**IT'S JUST A NUMBER:** LMU is 34-46-1 against ranked-opponents under head coach Jason Gill over his 10 years as head coach ... the Lions are also 8-10 in weekend series against ranked teams over that span ... LMU is currently 0-2 this year after finishing 2-2 last year ... LMU went 2-7 against ranked-foes in 2016 ... LMU's best record under Gill against ranked-teams came in his first year (2009) when the Lions went 9-2.

**THE SMART PICK FOR WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Senior Jamey Smart was named Rawlings WCC Player of the Week on March 26 after batting .312 with two doubles and seven crucial RBI in helping LMU to a 3-1 week the previous week ... the native of San Ramon, Calif. batted .364 with two doubles and six RBI in the series win over Pepperdine, and all six were critical to LMU's series win ... Smart came up with two out, the bases loaded and LMU trailing 3-2 in the seventh inning on Saturday, and delivered a bases-clearing three-RBI double to hand LMU the 5-3 win to even the series ... in the rubber game of the set on Sunday, Smart punched home the first two runs of the game in the first inning, and added an RBI-double in the seventh that proved to be the game-winner as LMU held off Pepperdine, 4-3, to earn the series win ... Smart, who also had the walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 10th during LMU's 5-4 win over Long Beach State on 3/20, hit safely in all four games that week, posting a .333 on-base percentage and a .438 slugging percentage.

**PAIVA'S GEM EARNS PITCHER OF WEEK:** After throwing a complete-game shutout at Hawaii on March 1, junior Codie Paiva was named WCC Rawlings Pitcher of the Week on March 5 ... pitching in Hawaii for the first time since the Hawaii State Tournament as a high school player, the right-hander tossed a complete-game shutout against the Rainbow Warriors as LMU posted a 3-0 victory over Hawaii ... Paiva was efficient in posting the complete-game shutout, throwing just 86 pitches, 64 for strikes, while scattering four hits and a walk with four strikeouts ... the complete-game shutout was the first since Cory Abbott went the distance and blanked Gonzaga on May 13, 2017.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** In its 36th season as the home of Lion baseball in 2018, George C. Page Stadium is also in its fifth year under the lights ... the 2018 LMU baseball schedule features 24 home games ... LMU, which is 10-6 so far this year, went 17-10 last year at home after going 9-12 at home in 2016 ... the Lions, who have posted a 570-426-4 (.572) overall record in the park's 35+ seasons, have claimed six conference titles while calling Page Stadium home ... the first Page Stadium conference title came in 1986, when the Lions posted a 24-8 record at home ... the best record came in 1988, when LMU was 30-5 at home (.857) ... LMU's historic first game in Page Stadium was played on March 19, 1983, with a 5-1 loss to Cal State Fullerton ... the Mikos Blue Monster in left field stands 130-feet wide and 37-feet tall.

**SCOUTING THE PILOTS:** Portland enters the weekend series with LMU sporting a 13-22 overall record and a 6-9 mark in the WCC ... the Pilots dropped consecutive games to UNLV in the midweek this week, but took two-of-three at home against BYU last week ... Beau Brundage paces the offense with a .400 batting average, 26 runs scored, 11 doubles, two triples, a homer and 19 RBI ... Cody Hawken and Daniel Lopez have each connected for five homers, as Lopez has driven in a team-best 29 runs ... the Pilots are hitting .266 as a team ... RHP Eli Morse is scheduled to toe the rubber on Friday, carrying a 2-5 record and a 4.00 ERA through nine starts ... lefty Corbin Powers will get the ball on Saturday, carrying a 3-4 record and a 5.16 ERA through nine starts ... Powers has struck out 53 in 52.1 innings of work ... Connor Knutson has converted four saves at the back end of the bullpen ... the Pilots are led by third-year head coach Geoff Loomis.

**COULDN'T BEAT THE BUZZER:** In a sport that does not feature a game clock, LMU baseball may have run out of time on 2/25 as they attempted to come from behind to defeat Oregon at LMU's Page Stadium ... the Lions scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth to cut a five-run deficit to 9-7, but the game was called due to curfew after eight innings ... due to a flight schedule for Oregon, the two sides agreed to not start a new inning after 4:45 p.m., and the Lions were busy putting together the rally in the eighth as the clock moved past the deadline ... Ryne Nelson, who took over on the mound and walked in the final Lion run of the game, eventually struck out Jamey Smart and Trevin Esquerria to seal the victory and strand the bases loaded.

**BULLPEN WOES AGAINST OREGON:** While LMU starters combined for a .48 ERA (1 ER in 18.2 IP) with 19 strikeouts in the series against Oregon, the bullpen had consecutive tough outings while trying to hold LMU leads in the final two games of the series ... the Lions led 1-0 headed into the eighth on Saturday vs. Oregon, but the bullpen surrendered a run in the eighth and the go-ahead in the ninth as LMU fell, 2-1 ... LMU then carried a 4-0 advantage into the sixth on Sunday, but Oregon got to the bullpen for four in the sixth, four in the seventh and one in the eighth to capture the series by way of a 9-7 come-from-behind triumph ... LMU's 'pen posted a 19.50 ERA (11 ER in 5 IP) over the those final two games ... six different relievers appeared over the span, as they combined to issue 10 hits, eight walks and two hit batters while allowing a .455 average against ... overall this year, LMU's 'pen has pitched to a 5.16 ERA in 45.1 innings.

**IN 2017:** LMU earned a share of the 2017 WCC Championship to record the program's seventh WCC title and the first since 2000 ... was picked to finish seventh in the 2017 WCC Preseason Coaches' Poll ... was ranked as high as #23 in the nation according to D1Baseball on May 8 ... won 10 of last 14, 16 of last 21, 27 of last 35, and 30 of last 40 ... had seven players named to All-WCC teams, headlined by Cory Abbott being named WCC Pitcher of Year ... dropped one weekend series (11-1-1) and lost back-to-back games just three times ... did not lose consecutive road games all season ... 13 of 18 losses were decided by 3 runs or less, but one more loss came on a walk-off grand slam ... offensively, led the WCC in hit-by-pitches, stolen bases and triples, and was second in batting average and on-base percentage ... on the mound, was first in ERA, shutouts, WHIP and hits allowed per nine, and second in walks per nine and strikeout-to-walk ratio ... recorded its third of six shutouts this year on 3/25 vs. BYU as Cory Abbott tossed first perfect game in LMU and WCC history to beat Cougars, 2-0.

**ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNERS:** LMU returns two players who received All-WCC recognition at the end of the 2017 season, including senior Jamey Smart (first team) and sophomore Cooper Uhl (All-Freshman) ... Smart led the way offensively for LMU during WCC play, hitting .394 with 24 runs scored, six doubles, four homers and 24 RBI ... the native of San Ramon, Calif. hit .326 overall, appearing in all 56 games and starting 55... over the course of the year, he scored 35 runs and collected team-high 41 RBI while notching 11 doubles and six homers ... Uhl appeared in 44 games and started 36 in his freshman season, hitting .210 with 17 runs scored, three doubles and 12 RBI.

**THROW STRIKES AND PLAY CATCH:** LMU has played well on the defensive side of the ball throughout Jason Gill's tenure, with last year serving as no exception ... LMU's pitching staff walked just 150 batters last year - second best in LMU history ... three of the top-five single-season walks-per-game marks have also come in the last two years, as Blake Redman set a new LMU record (.98) in 2016, followed by J.D. Busfield at #2 (1.02 in 2016) and Redman at #5 (1.51) in 2017 ... behind the pitchers in 2016, LMU's defenders recorded the second-fewest errors in LMU history (55) and second-best fielding percentage (.973) ... overall, Gill has seen his pitchers record the four lowest team walks marks in LMU history, claim all but one of the individual top-10 single-season walks-per-game marks, earn the top-two, and three of the top-four, best ERA marks, and has seen his defense register the top-three, and five of the top-six, fielding percentages.

**FOLLOW IT LIVE ONLINE:** LMU Athletics will once again video stream every home baseball games this year through the LMU Sports Network and theW.tv ... the video stream is free of charge, and will be accompanied by an audio play-by-play broadcast ... all road games will once again feature an audio play-by-play broadcast ... to watch any and all home games this year, and to listen to the audio on the road, please check the LMU baseball schedule.

**SIMPLY...PERFECT:** Cory Abbott dealt the first perfect game in LMU and West Coast Conference history on Saturday, March 25, 2017 in a 2-0 victory over BYU ... the right-hander struck out a career-high 13 hitters and used 106 pitches to dispatch of the Cougars ... the perfect game was the first at the Division I level in 2017, and was the 26th since 1957 (last: Jesse Scholtens, Wright State, 3/11/16 ... Abbott sealed the perfect game with a strikeout of pinch hitter Tanner Chauncey, striking Chauncey out on a 3-2 pitch ... LMU had thrown two previous no-hitters, including current volunteer assistant Matt Florer's no-hitter against Cal State Northridge on April 23, 2013 ... Bob Seus had LMU's first-ever no-hitter, limiting Long Beach State to just two walks and a hit batter on March 14, 1980 ... Abbott found himself in only four three-ball counts all day, and had only one real scare on a hard hit ball, with Niko Decolati diving forward to steal a potential hit from shortstop Daniel Schneemann with one out in the seventh ... for his efforts, Abbott was named WCC Pitcher of the Week and a National Pitcher of the Week according to Collegiate Baseball and Perfect Game.

**LIONS IN THE DRAFT:** LMU had three players drafted in the 2017 MLB Draft ... Cory Abbott was selected in the second round by the Chicago Cubs with the 67th overall pick ... the second-round selection is the highest for LMU since 2000, when Billy Traber was taken in the first round by the New York Mets, followed by Michael Schultz in the second round by the Arizona Diamondbacks ... after Abbott was selected, Harrison Simon became the second Lion off the board this year when the Padres took him with the 708th overall pick in the 24th round ... ## HEAD COACH JASON GILL



2018 marks the 10th year at the helm of the LMU baseball program for Jason Gill, as LMU's head coach most recently guided the Lions to the 2017 West Coast Conference Championship and its third appearance in the last four years at the WCC Championship Tournament.

Under Gill's guidance, LMU has accumulated 50 All-WCC selections, one WCC title, four Freshmen All-Americans, one Collegiate Baseball All-American, two WCC Defensive Players of the Year, a WCC Pitcher of the Year, an ABCA All-West Region selection, two WCC Freshmen of the Year, 29 Academic All-Conference selections, an Academic All-District selection, 24 players drafted in the MLB Draft (not including 2017 MLB Draft), and has played for the WCC Championship four times.

Gill guided his 2017 squad to a 38-18 overall record and a 20-7 mark in the WCC to earn a share of the West Coast Conference Championship and a berth into the WCC Championship Tournament. The 38 wins are tied for sixth-most in LMU history, and are the most since 2000 (40-19). LMU's .679 winning percentage is fourth-best in LMU history, and the best mark since 1990's .726 percentage. LMU lost just one weekend series, finishing the year 11-1-1 in weekend sets. The Lions also dropped consecutive games just three times in 2017, and 13 of its 18 losses came by three runs or less.

Gill's 2017 offense boasted six players with .300 or better averages - the most in a season for LMU since 2009. LMU's .410 slugging percentage was also best for the Lions since the beginning of the BBCOR era. Finally, the 2017 squad managed the best team batting average (.292) since the BBCOR bat was introduced in 2011. Gill saw his 2017 Lion pitching staff turn in the sixth-best ERA in program history (3.46) while setting new program marks in walks per nine innings (2.69) and shutouts (6), and placing third in strikeouts (446). On the conference and national levels, LMU's hurlers led the WCC in WHIP (1.19) and ERA, while placing 5th and 18th in the nation, respectively. Junior Cory Abbott led the way for the Lions on the mound in 2017, going 11-2 with a 1.74 ERA and 130 strikeouts over 15 starts and 98.1 innings. Abbott, who earned WCC Pitcher of the Year, first team All-American honors and a finalist spot for National Pitcher of the Year, managed the lowest opponent batting average (.173) and most strikeouts-per-nine innings (11.90), second-best ERA (1.74), second-most shutouts (2), fourth-most strikeouts (130), and seventh-most wins (11) in LMU history over the course of the 2017 season.

Including Abbott being named a first team All-WCC pick and the conference's Pitcher of the Year, LMU featured seven All-WCC selections in 2017. Joining Abbott on the first team were position players Phil Caulfield and Jamey Smart. Jimmy Hill and Brenton Arriaga found spots on the second team, while Spencer Erdman earned an honorable mention nod. Freshman Cooper Uhl rounded out the selection, taking home an All-Freshman team selection.

Consistently bringing top talent into his program, Gill's 2011 recruiting class was ranked #23 in the nation according to Baseball America, marking the first top-25 class for LMU in 15 years. He then posted a #22 recruiting class in 2013, giving the Lions two Top-25 classes in three years. LMU was one of only six private schools that had a Top-25 recruiting class from 2011 to 2014, and one of only two Non-BCS schools to have had a Top-25 recruiting class over that span (Cal State Fullerton). In addition, LMU was the only non-BCS private school to have a Top-25 recruiting class during those years, and was the only WCC school to twice have a Top-25 recruiting class. Gill's incoming class for the 2014 season was tabbed as the 34th-best in the nation according to Collegiate Baseball. LMU was just one of four non-BCS schools to make the list, and just one of five private schools lauded. The class was also tied for the best in the West Coast Conference.

The Lions finished the 2016 campaign with a 26-27 overall record and a 13-14 mark in the WCC while playing a tough schedule that featured just 21 home games and no non-conference home weekend series. A personal highlight for Gill in the season came on Opening Night at #11 TCU as the Lions beat the Horned Frogs to capture Gill's 200th career victory. Following the season, Gill saw two of his players selected in the 2016 MLB Draft, as JD Busfield was taken in the seventh round by the Tampa Bay Rays and Cassidy Brown went in the 12th to the Cincinnati Reds. RHP Michael Silva also began his professional career, signing a free agent deal with the Kansas City Royals.

Prior to returning to LMU for the 2017 season, Gill spent the summer of 2016 serving his second stint with Team USA's Collegiate National Team. The 2016 Americans posted an 11-7-1 record, including recording the first-ever series win at Cuba (3-2). For their efforts, the Collegiate National Team was named USA Baseball's Team of the Year.

The 2015 season saw the Lions go 33-21-1, reaching the WCC Championship Game for the second straight year. The 33 victories were the most for a Lion team since recording 40 in 2000 (40-19). Seven Lion players garnered All-WCC honors, including David Fletcher earning a spot on the first team for the second straight year. David Edwards, Austin Miller and Colin Welmon found themselves on the second team, while J.D. Busfield, Trevor Megill and Sean Watkins took home honorable mention honors. Watkins would also receive Freshman All-American accolades as a two-way player. In the June Amateur Draft, LMU had a player selected in the sixth, seventh and eighth rounds, marking the first time since 2005 that LMU has had three players selected in the top-10 rounds.

The Lions finished 2014 with a 32-24 overall record (best since 2004) and a 17-10 mark in the WCC to claim second place and a spot in the WCC Championship Tournament. David Fletcher and Austin Miller earned first team Freshman All-American honors, including

becoming the first duo to be tabbed in the same year by Baseball America. Fletcher also took home WCC Defensive Player of the Year in his freshman season, keeping the award with the Lions for the second straight year.

The 2013 season saw Gill's arsenal of talented pitchers finish the year with an LMU record 3.17 ERA, led by a trio of All-WCC selections in right-handers Colin Welmon, Aaron Griffin and Patrick McGrath. The Lions also featured the WCC Defensive Player of the Year in Colton Plaia and honorable mention selections in David Edwards, Zac Fujimoto and Cullen Mahoney.

Gill guided his 2012 squad to a share of third place in the West Coast Conference. In a year that saw the Lions earn the 23rd spot in Baseball America's Top-25 recruiting classes, Gill helped his players to six All-WCC selections at the end of the season, including freshmen Trevor Megill and Colin Welmon as staples of the class. Reaching a coaching milestone, Gill earned his 100th career victory on April 20, 2012, a 5-3 victory over Portland.

At the conclusion of the 2012 campaign, Gill spent the summer of 2012 serving as an assistant coach for the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, helping the squad to a 12-5 record and a bronze medal after finishing 5-2 at Honkbal Week hosted at Pim Mulier Stadium in the Netherlands.

Gill's 2011 Lions posted an overall record of 20-25, the best record since 2004 to that point. The Lions, who finished tied for third in the West Coast Conference, began the year with a 7-1 record and closed the year by winning four of their last five games. Gill and his coaching staff also guided the LMU pitching staff to a 3.25 team ERA in 2011. The Lions placed five players on All-Conference teams, while four were taken in the MLB draft, including three in the first 12 rounds for the first time since 2005.

The 2010 season saw the Lions record a series sweep over perennial powerhouse Cal State Fullerton, including a victory over then-No. 9 Fullerton on May 18, and a series victory over Fresno State on the road. The 2010 season also culminated in the first All-American selection under Gill as a head coach, as 2010 West Coast Conference Freshman of the Year Matt Lowenstein was named a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and Ping!Baseball.

LMU finished in second place in the WCC in 2009 after posting a 30-29 overall record and a 13-8 mark in conference play to earn a spot in the WCC Championship Series. The Lions' 8-2 start in 2009 was the best since the 1988 season, and it was also the best start over the first 10 games for a first-year skipper in LMU program history. Gill's 2009 squad finished the year with a 9-2 record against ranked-opponents, including recording a four-game sweep of then-defending National Champion Fresno State and a crucial three-game sweep over WCC-foe San Diego. Proving they can play with any team in Southern California, widely considered one of the toughest regions in the country, LMU also knocked-off perennial powerhouses, then-No. 5 UC Irvine and sixth-ranked Cal State Fullerton, in 2009. Although those victories were highlights for LMU players and fans alike, they were likely even bigger for Gill, as he coached at both programs after taking the field as a player for the Titans in 1994.

For the four years preceding his start as LMU's seventh skipper in program history, Gill worked under head coach George Horton at Oregon and Cal State Fullerton, serving as an infield coach, recruiting coordinator and as a primary hitting instructor. Gill is no stranger to starting a program from the ground up, taking on the task twice, most recently at the University of Oregon. Gill was Horton's first hire as both men left Cal State Fullerton to begin the reconstruction of the Duck baseball program in 2007. Always considered one of the best recruiters in college baseball, Gill's 2007 recruiting class was ranked in the top-10 in the nation by both Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America.

In the three years preceding the move to Eugene, Ore., the Titans made it to Omaha and the College World Series twice, won two Big West Conference titles and had 35 players drafted. The three-year stint under Horton was Gill's second on the Fullerton coaching staff, having started his coaching career as an undergraduate assistant for legendary skipper, and Division I baseball's all-time winningest coach, Augie Garrido. In that first term, Gill served essential roles on both the 1995 National Championship and 1996 Fullerton squads.

Before his return to Fullerton, Gill spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for UC Irvine, as the coaching staff resurrected the baseball

program from extinction. After just three years of developing the program, Gill helped lead UCI to a NCAA Regional in 2004.

Furthering his reputation as a standout recruiter, the Anteaters' 2002 recruiting class was ranked eighth in the country by Baseball America, with the following two classes among Collegiate Baseball's top-30. Overall, Gill has served as a collegiate recruiting coordinator directly for seven years, recording six recruiting classes in the top-30 and two in the top-10 over that span.

Prior to UCI, Gill was an assistant coach at Loyola Marymount where he helped guide the Lions to their most recent WCC titles and playoff berths in 1999 and 2000. Over that two-year span, nine LMU players moved on to professional baseball. Perhaps the most successful draft year in LMU history, Gill watched six of his Lion ballplayers sign professional contracts in 2000, including one player in each of the first three rounds.

Coach Gill also served two years as an assistant coach at Nevada in 1997 and 1998. While there, the Wolfpack made the postseason for just the second time in school history. Serving as the team's hitting coach and working closely with the infielders, Gill guided the 1997 team to nine offensive team records at Nevada. In addition, his tutelage of the infielders was instrumental in placing Nevada first in the country in double plays in both seasons.

Before embarking on his coaching career, Gill played one year at Cal State Fullerton, hitting .345, scoring 28 runs and starting 43 games at third base as a senior. That year, the All-Big West Conference infielder helped the Titans to a 47-16 overall record and a College World Series berth. Gill started his collegiate career playing two seasons at Cuesta College before playing his junior campaign at Cal State Dominguez Hills.

Overall, Coach Gill has been to Omaha four times as a player and a coach. In addition, he has been to the postseason a total of nine times, coached four Conference Players of the Year, including three infielders directly under his guidance, and been a part of six Conference Championships.

A local product who prepped at Mater Dei High School in Santa Ana, Calif., Gill received his bachelor's degree from Cal State Fullerton in kinesiology in 1996. Gill, who was born on April 7, 1970, lives with his wife, Kacey, and his son, Shane.
