## WWPA Championships & NCAA Appearances



### Back on Top

The 2007 LMU Men's Water Polo team earned the program's fifth WWPA title in seven years, defeating No. 1 seed UC Davis 7-6 as the No. 3 seed in Air Force.

#### 2007 • 13-17

The Loyola Marymount men's water polo played one of the toughest schedules in the nation, playing 26 games against ranked opponents. However, they peaked at the right time and won their fifth WWPA title in seven seasons, this time as the No. 3 seed. They adjusted their training for the altitude of Air Force in the Rockies of Colorado and it paid off. They defeated six-seed Redlands 16-8 to open and then avenged a regular season setback to No. 2 seed Santa Clara, 12-8. The Lions then played UC Davis for the fourth time on the season, losing the previous three by a combined five goals. This time they trailed 6-5 in the third but shutout UCD in the fourth and Tim Heafner scored in the final minutes to push the Lions back to the NAAs. In the final four, the Lions gave USC all they wanted but fell down the stretch to the top-ranked Trojans, 8-4. In the consolation game, the Lions fell to No. 9 Navy, 7-6, the seventh one-goal game on the season for the Crimson and Navy.

#### 2005 • 19-16

The Loyola Marymount men's water polo team finished its best for last in the 2005 season, winning eight of their last 11 as they won their third straight Western Water Polo Association championship and fourth in the last five years. The Lions, considered the underdog to rival UC San Diego, earned a thrilling 7-6 win over the Tritons at the Burns Recreation and Aquatics Center, giving the Lions the automatic bid to the NCAA Men's Water Polo Championship. The Lions pushed Stanford to the brink, falling 7-6 in the semifinals before defeating 11th-ranked Saint Francis, 10-6, in the third place match. The Lions finish 19-16 overall, 10-3 in the WWPA and ranked eighth in the nation.

#### 2004 • 21-11

In a season that was supposed to be a rebuilding type year, the Loyola Marymount University men's water polo team proved everyone wrong as they worked themselves to a second straight Western Water Polo Association championship in 2004 with a 21-11 final record. The Lions, coming one win shy of tying the program record in wins, took third in the 2004 NCAA Men's Water Polo Championships with a 6-5 win over Princeton. The one-goal win over Princeton was part of a theme for the Lions in 2004 as they made a habit of pulling out the close wins. LMU went 12-4 on the season in games decided by two goals or less. In the stretch the Lions went 3-0 in overtime games, winning all three by one goal. They defeating No. 7 Long Beach State, 8-7, No. 17 Whittier, 12-11, and No. 13 UC Davis, 7-6. The wins over Whittier and UC Davis helped the Lions advance to the WWPA title game.

#### 2003 • 17-14

The seventh-ranked Loyola Marymount University men's water polo team won the 2003 Western Water Polo Association title and finished third in the 2003 NCAA Men's Water Polo Championship in December. It marks the second time in three years the Lions have earned the conference crown and a third place finish in the NCAA tournament. The Lions finished the season 17-14 overall and 12-3 in the WWPA. The Lions claimed a 6-5 win over seventh-ranked UC San Diego in the championship game of the Western Water Polo Championships at Redlands University. It was a fitting reversal of fortunes for the Lions. In the regular season the Lions were on the wrong end of heartbreakers all season, losing 10 of their 14 games by one-goal or in overtime. All 10 of those games came against teams ranked in the top-20 nationally, including two games at the hands of the

Tritons. The Lions opened up the NCAA Men's Water Polo Championship against the 2002 National Champions, Stanford. In an offensive showcase, the Lions fell to the Cardinal in their home pool 14-8. In the third place game, the Lions posted four unanswered goals in the first period to earn a 10-7 win over 11th-ranked Navy.

#### 2001 • 15-14

The 2001 season set in motion a new era for LMU men's water polo as the team went 15-14 overall and won their first Western Water Polo Association Championship with a 4-2 win over UC San Diego at the brand new Burns Recreation and Aquatics Center. Opened that season, the Lions posted 10 wins at home that helped them to the programs first ever NCAA tournament. The Lions made their first trip a memorable one as they battled UCLA to the end in a 7-5 setback in the semifinals before making it look easy in the third place game. They defeated UMass 14-6 to pick-up the program's first win in NCAA tournament play.

**A YOUTHFUL UPRISING**

Lions, with youngest roster in at least 11 years, earned fifth WWPA title and NCAA bid since 2001 with a thrilling 7-6 win over UC Davis.

**F**or the fifth time in seven years, Loyola Marmount returned to the National Collegiate Men's Water Polo Championship and won the Western Water Polo Association championship. Since 2001, the Lions have claimed the WWPA title every year except 2002 and 2006, winning it this season with a 7-6 victory over No. 9 UC Davis. The Lions, who featured the youngest squad in program history, finished the year 13-17 and in fourth place finish at the NCAA Championship in May.

**INSIDE THE LIONS**

LMU went 13-17 on the 2007 season and finished at the No. 11 spot in the national rankings. The Lions won their fifth Western Water Polo Association Championship thanks to a 7-6 win over then No. 9 UC Davis in the title game. Leading the way for the Lions was junior Mark Milovic, a first-team All-WWPA selection and an honorable mention ACWPC All-American. He did a little of everything for the Lions, sitting second on the squad with 29 goals. On defense, goalie Andy Stevens, who was named third-team ACWPC All-American and the Western Water Polo Association Newcomer of the Year, was second in the WWPA and the nation with 10.6 saves per game and finished ranked seventh in the nation with 297 saves. Offensively, the Lions were led by freshman Tibor Forai. He moved his team-leading total to 50, while earning honorable men-

tion ACWPC All-American and second-team All-WWPA honors and All-Freshman Team honors. He scored nine goals in the WWPA tournament, earning MVP honors. Junior Julien Lormant was third on the team in goals with 25. Lormant earned All-WWPA honorable mention honors and second-team WWPA All-Tournament Team honors.

**TOUGH STRETCH**

Playing with its youngest squad in the tenure of Head Coach John Loughran, the Lions went through its growing pains. With just two seniors, the Lions were put to the test early and often, playing 28 of its 30 games against ranked opponents. On the season, 15 of the Lions' 17 set-backs came against teams ranked in the nation's top-10. All 15 came by an average of just under three goals a game. The Lions actually led or were tied in the fourth quarter in 11 of those 17 games. Included in that list was three overtime contests and the one-goal setback to Navy in the NCAAAs. The Lions fell to No. 7 Long Beach State 11-8 on Oct. 4, to No. 16 Santa Clara 8-7 on Oct. 26. The third overtime contest ended as the longest game in LMU history as they fell in a rematch to the 49ers, 8-7 in six overtimes.

**WINNING THE WWPA**

LMU used an impressive fourth quarter rally to defeat ninth-ranked UC Davis 7-6 in the title

game of the 2007 WWPA Men's Water Polo Championship at Air Force. The fourth battle of the season between LMU and UC Davis was tight throughout as the Aggies took a 6-5 lead into the fourth quarter. Ryan Fair would tie the score at 6-6 with three minutes remaining right after a 6-on-5 opportunity expired. The Lions then set up an isolation play for junior Tim Heafner at two-meter who lobbed a shot over the goalie's head from two meters at the 1:49 for the winner. The Lions jumped out early and led 4-3 after one. UC Davis scored the only goal as both defenses held the other offense without a goal in a quarter. The lone goal of the second made it 4-4 at the break. The Aggies looked to take control of the game as they put in a pair to just one for the Lions in the third to make it 6-5 and set-up the come back for the Lions.

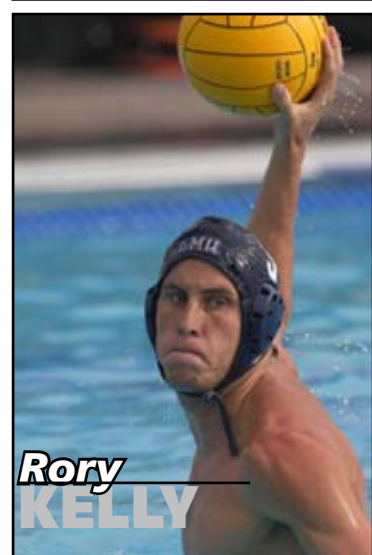
