Jim Parady begins his 16th season, as the head football coach at Marist College and in the process becomes the longest tenured coach in the varsity program's 28-year history. Parady is already the winningest coach with 82 in his 15 seasons and has helped to make Marist a force to be reckoned with at the I-AA level and within the Metro Atlantic Athletic (MAAC) Football League. During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams, and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field.

During his 15 seasons as the Red Foxes head coach, Parady has posted a 82-69-1 record, including nine seasons of winning football. In its first year as a member of the MAAC Football League Parady led the Red Foxes to a 6-1 mark against league opponents, and earned the conference title. Again in 2006 Parady led his troops to the Conference Title. Marist is always a perennial contender for the conference's top spot.

## Qualifications

**The Marist Football Camp is open to boys who are age 8 to 18. Teams and instructional groups will be determined by age and level of ability.**
