**THIS AFTERNOON'S TILT:** Marist plays its second straight home game, as the Red Foxes host 2008 PFL champion Jacksonville on Alumni Weekend. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m. at Tenney Stadium at Leonidoff Field.

**ON THE AIR:** This afternoon's game will air live on WKIP 1450 AM, with **Ed Weir** providing the play-by-play and **Geoff Brault** handling the color analysis. The broadcast will also be available online at [GoRedFoxes.com](http://GoRedFoxes.com) free of charge through Stretch Internet. The pregame show starts at 12:45 p.m. EDT.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Marist snapped a three-game losing skid with a 34-13 win over Campbell on Oct. 3. The victory was the Red Foxes' first in PFL play in program history. The Red Foxes rushed for 263 yards and five touchdowns in the contest, as four different players (**Ryan Dinnebeil** - 2, **O'Neil Anderson**, **Chris Debowski** and **Greg Whipple** - 1 apiece) scored touchdowns. Defensively, Marist shut out Campbell in the second half. The Red Foxes scored the final 21 points of the game.

**SCOUTING JACKSONVILLE:** The Dolphins enter today's game at 2-2 overall and 1-0 in PFL play. In Jacksonville's league opener last Saturday against Davidson, the Dolphins recorded a 27-21 home victory. Last season, Jacksonville earned a school-record nine victories en route to claiming the PFL championship. Head Coach **Kerwin Bell** is in his third season at the helm.

# MEET THE HEAD COACH



**Jim Parady**  
18th Season  
Career Record: 91-87-1  
Maine/1983

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through nearly two decades of growth, is in his 18th season as the program's head coach and 19th overall with the Red Foxes.

With 90 victories, Parady is the winningest coach in program history. He has made Marist a force to be reckoned with both at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), formerly known as I-AA, level.

During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won three league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch.

In the last 17 seasons, Parady has posted an 89-84-1 record, including nine winning seasons. The Red Foxes won the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007.

Last season saw the Red Foxes compile a 4-7 record competing as an FCS independent. Marist won three of its final five games, including a triumph at future Pioneer League foe Davidson to close out the season. Running back Obozua Ehikioya set the program record for touchdowns and the school's FCS record for career rushing yards, while quarterback Chris Debowski tied the program record for touchdown passes in a game with four in the Red Foxes' 34-7 win over Bryant. Right guard Jake Dembow was named an FCS Academic All-Star and was a national semifinalist for the Draddy Award. Both Dembow and Ehikioya were selected to play in the East Coast Bowl.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters during his career. Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth.

## History vs. Jacksonville

### First meeting

**TOP 10 DEFENSE:** The Marist defense enters today ranked ninth in the country in average yards allowed per game at 246.0. The Red Foxes are also 10th nationally in passing defense, allowing 138.8 yards per game.

### O'NEIL ANDERSON ON THE

**CARRY:** In each of Marist's last two games, senior running back **O'Neil Anderson** has rushed for over 130 yards, amassing a career-high 133 at Bucknell on Sept. 26 and 132 against Campbell on Oct. 3. Anderson's 31-carry effort at Bucknell was the highest total for a Red Fox since **Obozua Ehikiويا** set the program record with 38 rushing attempts at Columbia on Sept. 22, 2007.

**TOPS IN THE PFL:** With his average of 88.6 rushing yards per game, senior running back **O'Neil Anderson** currently ranks first in the Pioneer League and 26th in the country.

**FAVORITE TARGET:** Senior wide receiver **James LaMacchia** leads Marist in receptions (32) and receiving yards (460) through five games. He ranks 12th in the country in receiving yards per game and T-20th in catches per game.

**MOVING UP THE CHARTS:** Senior wide receiver **James LaMacchia** now has 71 career receptions, putting him in fourth place on Marist's all-time Football Championship Subdivision list. He is just two receptions behind behind **Prince Prempeh** (2003-06) for third.

**TACKLING MACHINE:** Through five games, senior linebacker **Kevin Foley** leads Marist with 45 tackles. Foley led the Red Foxes with 90 tackles in 2008.

**DEFENDING SHORT FIELDS:** The Marist defense has allowed 16 scoring drives this season (12 touchdowns, four field goals). Seven of the drives have started in Marist territory.

**DIFFERENTIAL:** Through five games, Marist is minus-10 in turnover differ-

ential, committing 14 turnovers (nine lost fumbles, five interceptions) while forcing four (all interceptions).

### SECOND HALF SLOWDOWN:

Through five games, Marist has outscored the opposition 60-42 in the first half, but has been outscored 51-37 in the second half. However, Marist did shut out Campbell while scoring 14 points in the second half of its 34-13 victory on Oct. 3.

### FIRST START, MANY TACKLES:

Making his first career start on Oct. 3 vs. Campbell, sophomore safety **Rodney Hill** had 13 tackles. That is the highest total for any Red Fox this season.

**AWARD WINNER:** On the strength of a 73-yard kickoff return at Bucknell, sophomore **Jaquan Bryant** was named PFL Special Teams Player of the Week for Week Four. It was the second weekly honor of the season for Bryant, who was named Defensive Player of the Week in Week One.

**AIRING IT OUT:** Making his second career start, sophomore quarterback **Tommy Reilly** completed 24 passes in 32 attempts for 237 yards at Bucknell on Sept. 26. The 24 completions were the second-highest single-game total in program history, behind **Steve McGrath's** 28 at Sacred Heart on Oct. 20, 2007. The 32 attempts were the most by a Red Fox since McGrath threw 40 times in the same game at Sacred Heart, and are the sixth-highest total in the program's FCS history.

**SLOW STARTS:** Marist's record the last four seasons prior to October is just 3-16.

**BUT IN OCTOBER ... :** Dating back to last year, Marist has won its last three games played in October.

**REILLY'S FIRST START:** Sophomore quarterback **Tommy Reilly** made the first start of his career at San Diego on Sept. 19, subbing for an injured **Chris Debowski**. Reilly completed 12 of 21 passes for 139 yards and one touchdown, a one-yard pass to **Ray**

who accomplished the feat twice.

**ANOTHER BIG KICK:** Two weeks after setting the program record with a 46-yard field goal, junior kicker/punter **Kevin Pauly** hit a 45-yard field goal at San Diego on Sept. 19. It was the ninth field goal of 40 or more yards in program history, five of which were converted by **Brett Biggs**.

**PFL DEBUT:** Marist played its first Pioneer Football League game in program history on Sept. 12, when the Red Foxes suffered a 34-6 home loss to Drake.

**TURNOVERS COSTLY:** The Red Foxes turned the ball over six times while not forcing any in falling to Drake 34-6 on Sept. 12. The average starting position for Drake's six scoring drives was the Marist 32.

**NICE OPENER:** Marist's 31-12 win at Sacred Heart in the season opener on Sept. 5 gave the Red Foxes their first win in a season opener since 2002, when they also defeated Sacred Heart.

**JAQUAN FOR SIX (TIMES TWO):** Sophomore cornerback **Jaquan Bryant** returned two interceptions for touchdowns in Marist's win at Sacred Heart, scoring on Marist's first defensive snap of the game and again in the fourth quarter. Bryant, who named PFL Defensive Player of the Week, became the first FCS player this season to return two interceptions for touchdowns.

**LAMACCHIA'S BIG NIGHT:** Senior wide receiver **James LaMacchia** had eight receptions for 153 yards and a touchdown at Sacred Heart, including three catches of at least 20 yards. The receptions total was tied for third in a single game in program history, and the yardage total was fifth in a single game in program history. LaMacchia's career high for receiving yards in a game is 154, set in 2008 vs. Bryant.

**200 FOR DEBOWSKI:** Senior quarterback Chris Debowski was 14-for-20 for 217 yards at Sacred Heart, giving him his second 200-yard passing game of his Marist career.

Juniors **Stephen Carretta** (left) and **Chad Connor** (right) made their first career starts at Sacred Heart on Sept. 5.

**BUT NOT ALL IS NEW ON THE O-LINE:** Left tackle **Danny Angelaastro** and center **Neil Walsh** are in their third season as starters, and right tackle **Kevin Ulrich** is a two-year starter.

**HISTORICAL CAPTAIN:** Junior safety **Rory Foley** is the first captain in the 18-year tenure of Head Coach **Jim Parady** who is not a senior.

**FAMILY AFFAIR:** The Red Foxes have a set of brothers on this year's team in offensive linemen **Chad Connor** and **Sean Connor**. Chad, a junior, started Marist's first three games at right guard, and Sean in a freshman. The Connors are from Staten Island, N.Y., and played scholastically at Curtis High School.

**HOW I SPENT MY SUMMER:** Senior nose tackle **Terrence Turner**, one of the five captains on this year's team, was accepted into the undergraduate research program at Albert Einstein

College of Medicine in the Bronx this past summer. Turner is a Biomedical Sciences major.

**MEET THE STAFF:** The Marist coaching staff has a combined 98 years of coaching experience with the Red Foxes alone. Four coaches (Head Coach **Jim Parady** - 18, Associate Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator **Scott Rumsey** - 12, Kickers Coach **Tom Kelly** - 24 and Defensive Backs Coach **Larry Riley** - 23) have been with the Red Foxes for over a decade.

**NEW (BUT FAMILIAR) FACES:** The Red Foxes have three new coaches on this year's staff, but all have a prior connection to the program. New defensive line coach/recruiting coordinator **Tom Taylor** is a 1966 Marist graduate who played on the school's first football team in 1965. New running backs coach **Jason Tillery** played for the Red Foxes from 2005-08, starting all 44 of the team's games in that time at left guard. New wide receivers coach **Nate Fields** was an offensive assistant as undergraduate the last three seasons, working primarily with offensive line coach **Bill Roos**.

**HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE:** This is Marist's 45th season of football,

including its 32nd as a varsity sport and 17th as a Division I program.

**START OF A NEW ERA:** The 2009 season marks Marist's first as a member of the Pioneer Football League, which is composed of 10 schools in eight different states. The Red Foxes played last season as an FCS independent, and were a member of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League from 1994-2007.

**PFL PICKS:** Marist was picked to finish eighth out of 10 teams in the Pioneer Football League preseason poll. San Diego was picked by the coaches to capture the league title. Marist was also picked eighth in The Sports Network's preseason poll. Additionally, three Red Foxes -- punter **Kevin Pauly** (First Team), wide receiver **James LaMacchia** (Second Team) and safety **Rory Foley** (Second Team) -- were chosen as Preseason All-PFL choices by Phil Steele's College Football Preview.

**THIS YEAR'S CAPTAINS:** The Red Foxes have five captains on this year's squad: linebacker **Nick Andre**, linebacker **Kevin Foley**, safety **Rory Foley**, nose tackle **Terrence Turner** and center **Neil Walsh**. Andre and Walsh are both two-year captains.
