## Directions from General Mitchell International Airport to:

---

### MARQUETTE GYM - 1532 W. CLYBOURN ST.

Interstate 94/I-43 North. Stay on I-43 toward Green Bay to Exit # 72A - 10th Street and Michigan/Tory Hill. Turn left onto W. Michigan St. Continue onto W. Clybourn St. Turn right onto N. 16th St. On right side.

### HELFAER TENNIS STADIUM AND RECREATION CENTER

Interstate 94/I-43 North. Stay on I-43 toward Green Bay to Exit # 72A - 10th Street and Michigan/Tory Hill. Turn left onto W. Michigan St. Continue onto W. Clybourn St. Turn right onto N. 16th St. On left side.

### VALLEY FIELDS *(from various locations)*

**(I-94 Eastbound)** – Exit 26th Street (309B), right on St. Paul, right on 25th. Follow 25th (Canal St.) to Fields.

**(I-94 Westbound)** – Exit 25th & Clybourn (309B), go West to 25th Street, Left on 25th to Fields.

**(From 16th Street Viaduct)** – South on 16th Street to middle of viaduct, left at stoplight to bottom of ramp, two additional lefts, Fields will be on right.

**(From 13th Street to Canal)** – Go right on Canal to Fields.

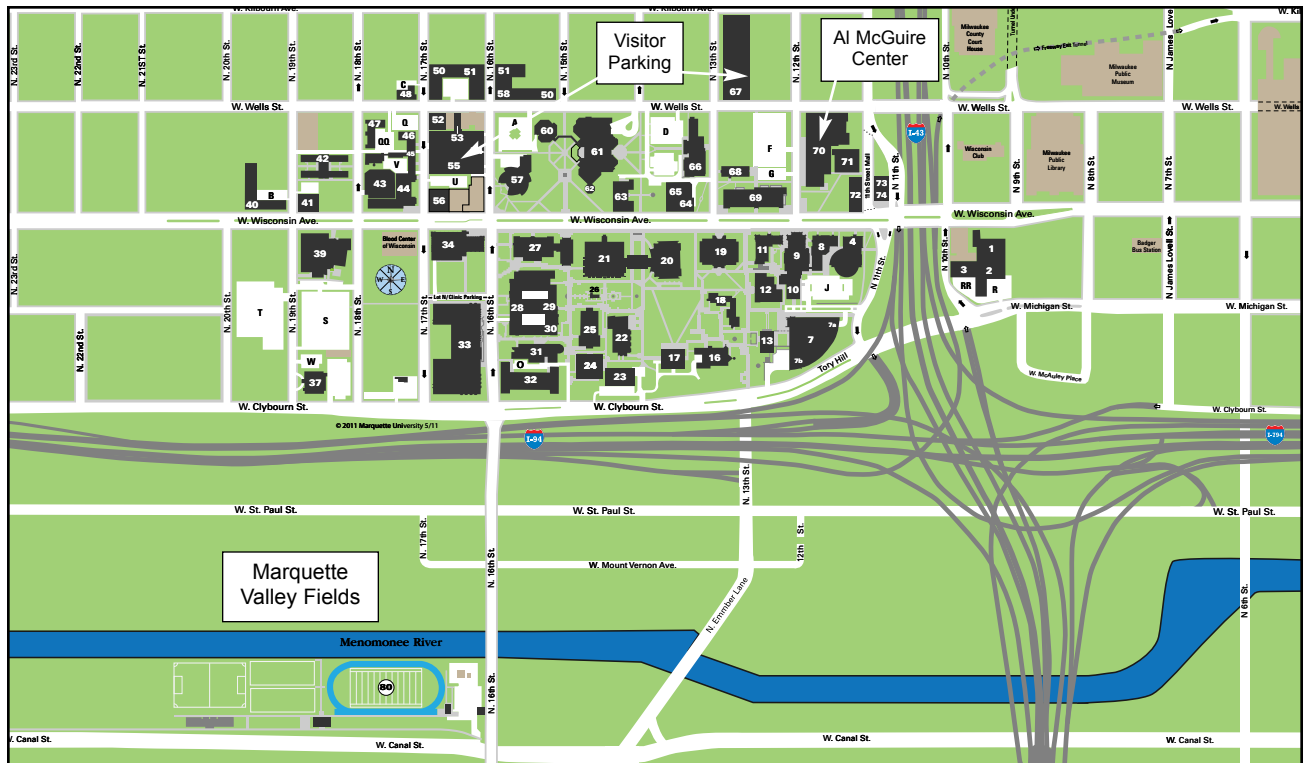

# Directions to Al McGuire Center



## From the South on I-43/I-94 (Chicago and Mitchell Airport)

- Stay on I-43 toward Green Bay to Exit # 72A - 10th Street and Michigan/Tory Hill.
- At bottom of ramp continue straight ahead 1 short block to Wisconsin Avenue.
- Turn L on Wisconsin and go 2 blocks to 12th Street.
- Turn R on 12th and go ½ block = McGuire Center on right.

## From the West on I-94 (Madison)

- Exit #310A - 13th Street.
- Turn L at bottom of ramp and go ½ block to Clybourn Street.
- Turn R on Clybourn and go 3 blocks to 10th Street.
- Turn L on 10th and go 1 block to Wisconsin Avenue.
- Turn L on Wisconsin and go 2 blocks to 12th Street.
- Turn R on 12th and go ½ block = McGuire Center on right.

## From the North on I-43 (Green Bay)

- Exit # 72E - Highland Avenue and 11th Street.
- Turn R at top of ramp - Highland Avenue.
- Get in L lane and immediately turn L on 12th Street.
- Go 3 ½ blocks = McGuire Center on left.

## Team Parking

### **PRACTICES:**

Teams should drop off and enter thru the Al McGuire Center main entrance at 770 N. 12th Street. Bus or vans should then be parked in the turnout lane on 11th Street between W. Wisconsin Avenue & Wells Street on the east side of the Al McGuire Center. Please display parking placard on dashboard.

### **GAMES:**

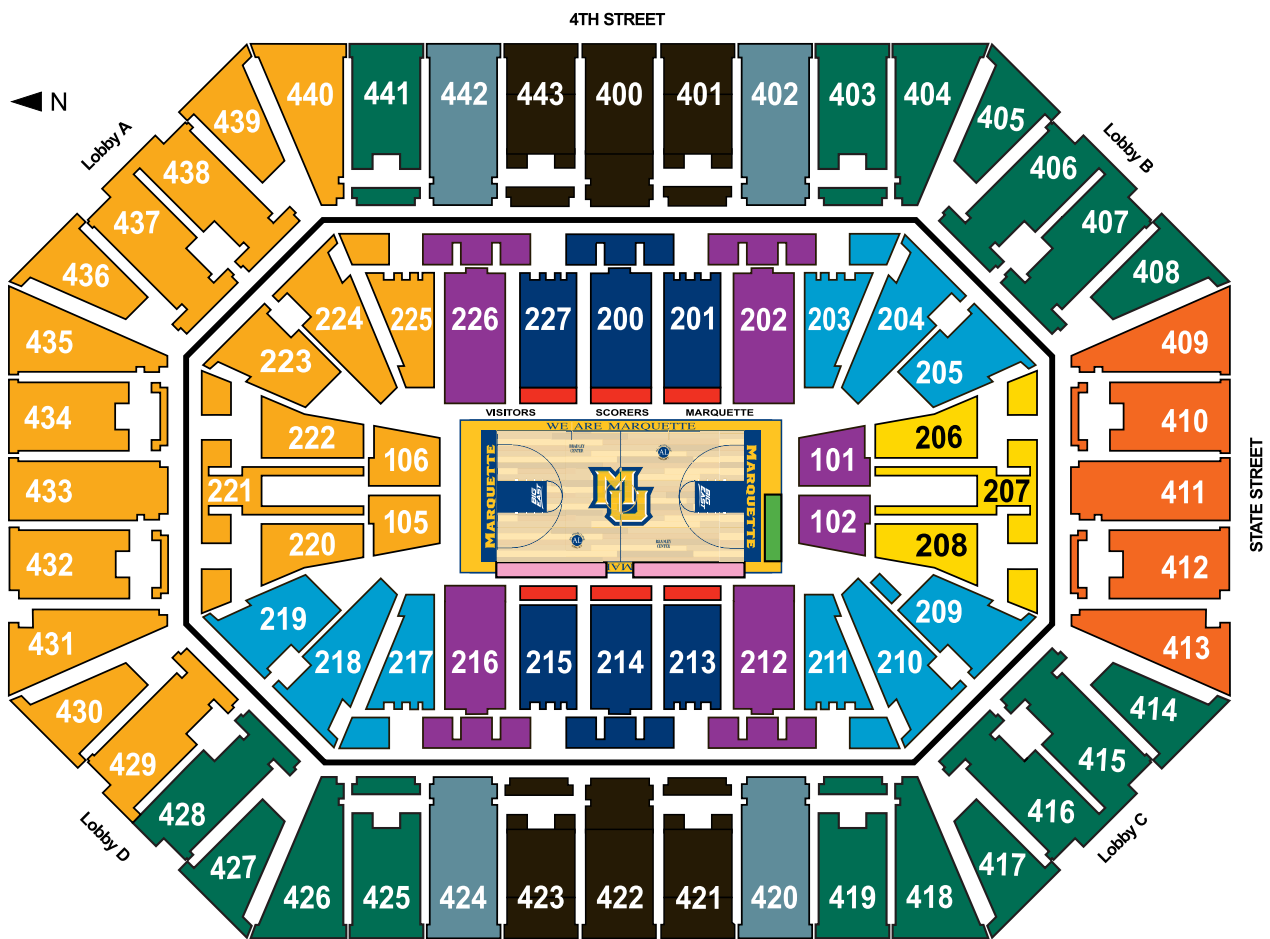
Bus or vans should be parked in the turnout lane on 11th Street between W. Wisconsin Avenue & Wells Street on the east side of the Al McGuire Center. A Marquette representative will meet the visiting team beginning two hours prior to game time at the door on the north-east corner of the Al McGuire Center. The door is marked with a blue "VISITING TEAM ENTRANCE" sign. Please display parking placard on dashboard.

The Bradley Center is an accessible facility with a variety of accommodations for its guests. The main ticket office is located at the northeast corner of the Center. 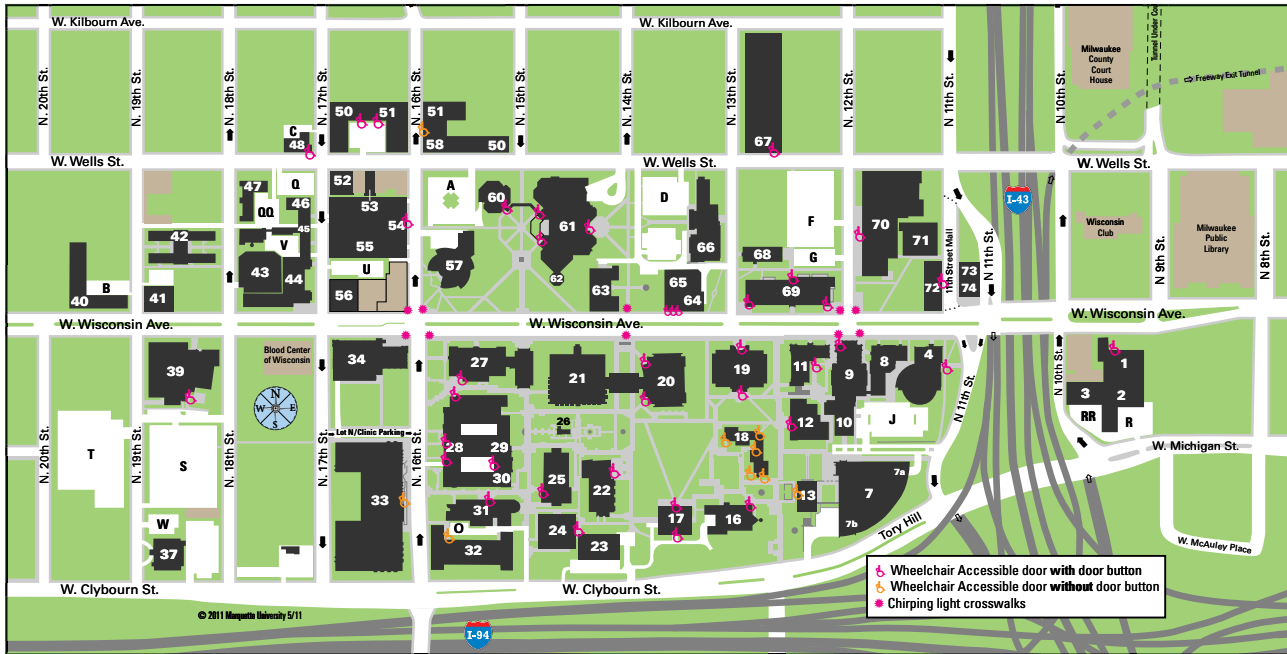
