



## 2008 MARQUETTE TWILIGHT

- Location:** The Melvin “Bus” Shimek Memorial Track & Field Facility at Valley Fields on the campus of Marquette University
- Date:** Saturday, April 26, 2008
- Eligibility:** Open to all colleges, universities and unattached athletes. No high school athletes permitted.
- Entries:** Unlimited entries will be allowed in all events. Entries will be submitted online no later than Wednesday April 23<sup>rd</sup> at NOON (CDT). Only scratches will be allowed the day of the meet.

- Entry Fee:** \$100 per team (Men’s and Women’s teams separate) - \$200 combined. \$10 for individuals.
- Facilities:** The Melvin “Bus” Shimek Track & Field Facility at Valley Fields is located on Canal Street just west of the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Viaduct across from Potawatomi Casino. The eight lane track and all jumping areas were re-surfaced during the summer of 2005 with a Benyon B.B.S.-1000 Embedded Track Surface. Shot and Discus rings are brushed concrete and will be contested at Valley Fields.  
  
Hammer and Javelin will be contested at the MU Throws Field located approximately 1 mile east of the track at 8<sup>th</sup> Street and Canal Street just east of the I-94/I-43 High Rise Bridge. Teams will be expected to provide their own transportation to and from the throws field and the track.
- Medical Facilities:** Trainers will be available prior to, during and after the competition. Water and Ice will be provided. An ambulance will be on site in case of emergency.
- Event Check In:** All running event participants need to check in with the clerk 15 minutes prior to their event. Field event participants must check in with the head event judge 20 minutes prior to the event at the event site. In all horizontally measured field events, we will take nine to the final.
- Weigh In:** Implement weigh in will take place on Saturday at the throws field from 12:00 Noon - 1:00pm, and in the equipment shed at the east end of the track from 5:00pm - 6:00pm.
- Warm-up Area:** All running event warm-ups are to take place on the field to the west of the track.
