**2008-09****Summer Prospectus**

**T**he 2008-09 campaign will mark the beginning of a new era for the Marquette University men's basketball program as new head coach Buzz Williams takes the reigns of a team that has made three-straight NCAA Tournament appearances. The Golden Eagles return all five starters and 10 letterwinners from last season's 25-10 squad, while welcoming three newcomers to the program. MU enters its fourth season in the BIG EAST Conference and will be looking to improve on last year's fifth-place regular season finish and first ever appearance in the league tournament semifinals.

### Williams Tabbed Program's 16th Head Coach

First-year head coach Buzz Williams, who served as an assistant under Tom Crean in 2007-08, will slide up the bench this season as he assumes the role of program mentor.

Tabbed Marquette's 16th head coach on April 8, 2008, Williams' coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has nearly 15 years of experience at the NCAA Division I level. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including one league player of the year and two conference freshmen of the year.

### MU Looking For 30-Year Trend

Marquette's senior class of Dwight Burke, Dominic James, Wesley Matthews and Jerel McNeal are hoping to pace the Golden Eagles to their fourth-straight NCAA Tournament appearance, an accomplishment the program hasn't recorded in nearly 30 years.

MU's 1980 NCAA participation capped a run of 10-straight seasons in the "Big Dance," highlighted by the 1977 National Championship. Of Marquette's 26 all-time NCAA appearances, 15 occurred prior to 1981.

## Marquette Selected For SEC/BIG EAST Invite

The 2008 SEC/BIG EAST Invitational, an ERT owned and operated event that features four games over two nights, will be played Dec. 16 at Nashville's Sommet Center and Dec. 18 at Cincinnati's U.S. Bank Arena and will be televised by ESPN and ESPN2. The annual event matches four teams from the BIG EAST Conference against four teams from the Southeastern Conference.

Tennessee, Vanderbilt, Ole Miss and Mississippi State will represent the SEC, while Marquette, Louisville, Cincinnati and USF will represent the BIG EAST.

On Dec. 16 in Nashville, Vanderbilt will face USF while Marquette squares off with Tennessee. On Dec. 18 in Cincinnati, Mississippi State will face Cincinnati and Ole Miss will play Louisville.

## MU Hoping To Continue Tourney Success

Marquette will be one of eight schools competing in the third annual Chicago Invitational Challenge, scheduled to take place November 28-29 at the Sears Centre in Hoffman Estates, Ill. The Thanksgiving weekend tournament will also include Dayton, Auburn, Northern Iowa, Chicago State, Mercer, Texas Southern and Bethune Cookman.

Marquette will face Northern Iowa at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 28 and will play Dayton on Saturday, Nov. 29. A pair of home games against Texas Southern and Chicago State are also part of the event's schedule.

The Golden Eagles are 12-1 over the course of the past four campaigns in regular season tournaments, included a trio of event championships. The only setback came to Duke last season in the title contest of the EA Sports Maui Invitational.

## Marquette's 20/10 Vision Sign Of Success

The Feb. 23, 2008 victory over Rutgers was Marquette's 20th of 2007-08 and 10th in BIG EAST Conference action.

Marquette, Pittsburgh and Georgetown are the only three programs in the league to claim at least 20 overall decisions and 10 conference victories since the 2005-06 campaign.

Only 16 programs in all of NCAA Division I basketball have reached those benchmarks in the past three years.

## Golden Eagles Remain A Tough Ticket In Milwaukee

Marquette enjoyed another successful season in 2007-08, both on the court and in the stands.

MU averaged a school record 16,239 fans per game to rank third in the BIG EAST and 14th in the nation. The Bradley Center topped 19,000 on three occasions, highlighted by the top mark in program history of 19,085 versus Georgetown on March 1.

Each of the top-10 crowds has now occurred in the last three seasons, with all but one (Wisconsin) coming in BIG EAST play.

## Trio Of Guards To Leave Lasting Impression At MU

In 2007-08, Marquette was one of just two schools in the nation to feature three underclassmen with 1,000 career points and each of those individuals return for their senior campaigns.

Guard Dominic James is currently 15th all-time at Marquette with 1,431 points while Jerel McNeal owns 22nd (1,292) and Wesley Matthews is in the 37th position (1,032).

James has the best shot at eclipsing George Thompson's 40-year-old record of 1,773 points, which he posted from 1965-66 to 1968-69. The Richmond, Ind., native would have to average approximately 11 points per game in 2008-09 to have a shot at the mark.

James, Matthews and McNeal have combined for 287 appearances, second most of any trio in the BIG EAST Conference.

Junior forward Lazar Hayward has 673 career points in his possession and would also need to contribute nearly 11 points per outing if he wanted to become the fourth member of the 1,000-point club on the roster.

Marquette and North Dakota State are the only two programs to return three 1,000-point scorers in 2008-09.

## Hayward Hoping To Continue Improvement

Junior forward Lazar Hayward made dramatic across-the-board improvement last season and will be looking to continue that trend in 2008-09.

An All-BIG EAST Second Team selection in 2007-08, the Buffalo, N.Y., native concluded the campaign averaging 12.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 47.4 percent from the field and 45.1 percent from long distance. He ranked among the league leaders in scoring (23rd), rebounding (17th) and free throw percentage (.773, 11th).

As a freshman, Hayward chipped in just 6.6 points and 3.6 rebounds per contest while knocking down 42.8 percent of his shot attempts.

## Cubillan Tires Of Shouldering The Load

Junior guard David Cubillan is recovering this summer from a pair of offseason shoulder surgeries.

Cubillan had bilateral arthroscopic surgery to repair damage to both his right and left shoulders and is expected to be ready for the start of the 2008-09 regular season in November.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native appeared in 34 games off the bench last season, contributing 5.1 points and 1.3 rebounds per game. He was third on the roster with 39 3-point field goals.

## Marquette Among Nation's Best In Steals

MU finished second in the BIG EAST and 10th in the nation in steals per game (9.3).

The 17-steal effort against Notre Dame on Jan. 12 matched a season high and MU reached double figures 13 times in 2007-08. Junior Jerel McNeal, the 2006-07 BIG EAST Defensive Player of the Year, was second in the league with 2.2 steals per game (30th in the nation) and classmate Dominic James was fifth (1.8 spg.).

Head Coach | First Year | Oklahoma City, 1994

Buzz Williams, a highly respected recruiter and veteran of the collegiate coaching ranks, was named the 16th head coach of the Marquette University men's basketball program on April 8, 2008.

In 2007-08, Williams served as an assistant coach with the Golden Eagles in his first season at Marquette. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has nearly 15 years of experience at the NCAA Division I level. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including one league player of the year and two conference freshmen of the year.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07 and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO (14-17) claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoop Online.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 - 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 - 2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an

assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference.

Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoop Online.

Williams was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M- Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98).

Williams signed the highest-rated recruiting class in the history of the Southland Conference while at Northwestern State. The Demons advanced to their first ever NCAA tournament the following season and two of his recruited players were named all-conference, while one was tabbed Southland Conference Tournament MVP.

His accomplishments at Texas A&M-Kingsville include signing the 1998-99 Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year and a third team All-America guard.

At Texas-Arlington, Williams recruited a Southland Conference Freshman of the Year and signed the first Academic All-American in the school's history. Williams was a student assistant coach from 1992-94 at Oklahoma City University where he assisted the team to the 1994 NAIA championship after it advanced to the Sweet 16 the previous season.

Williams served as a student assistant from 1990-92 at Navarro College (Corsicana, Texas) where the team won consecutive conference titles while sporting a 45-17 record during his tenure.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has one daughter, Zera, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.

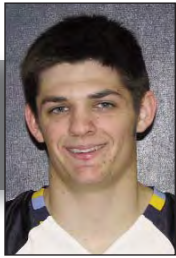
