WEEKLY HONORS

BIG EAST Player of the Week (Jan. 5)

JEREL McNEAL, Marquette, G, Sr.

McNeal averaged 25.0 points, 6.5 assists and 4.5 rebounds to help Marquette to a 2-0 start in BIG EAST play with wins against Villanova and Cincinnati. He was the top scorer in both games and shot a combined 66.7 percent from the field (16-of-24) and 73.3 percent from 3-point range (11-of-15). He scored 24 points with seven assists in the win against Villanova and added 26 points with six assists against Cincinnati.



BIG EAST Rookie of the Week (Jan. 5)

GREG MONROE, Georgetown, C, Fr.

Monroe averaged 15.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game as the Hoyas went 1-1 against a pair of top-3 teams. He scored 16 points with four assists, three rebounds and three steals in a 74-63 win at No. 2/2 Connecticut. He scored 15 points with eight boards in a 70-54 loss to No. 3/3 Pittsburgh.



BIG EAST Honor Roll

DeJuan Blair, Pittsburgh, F, So.

Scored 20 points with 17 rebounds and three assists in a 70-54 win at Georgetown. Averaged 11.0 points and 9.5 rebounds in two games.

Luke Harangody, Notre Dame, F, Jr.

Averaged 27.0 points and 15.0 rebounds in a 1-1 week.

DaJuan Summers, Georgetown, F, Jr.

Averaged 20.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and shot 50.0 percent from the field and 66.7 percent from 3-point range in a 1-1 week.

Sharaud Curry, Providence, G, Jr.

Averaged 14.5 points, 5.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds in a 2-0 week. Game-high 16 points against St. John's.

Paris Horne, St. John's, G, So.

Averaged 15.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals in a 1-1 week. Scored 14 points in win against No. 7/10 Notre Dame.

TODAY IN THE BIG EAST

Georgetown visits Notre Dame Monday on ESPN in another marquee game in the BIG EAST. Both schools were ranked in the top 10 of one of the national polls last week and both enter tonight's game at 1-1 in the BIG EAST. Notre Dame comes into the game with a 43-game winning streak at the Joyce Center — the longest homecourt winning streak in the nation.

Pittsburgh stands as one of four unbeaten teams in Division I (along with Clemson, Illinois State and Wake Forest). The Panthers, who were ranked No. 3 in both national polls last week, could earn the first No. 1 ranking in program history when this week's polls are announced later Monday. The No. 1, No. 2 and No. 4 teams all suffered losses last week, while the Panthers registered a 70-54 win against No. 11/8 Georgetown to extend their winning streak to 14 games.

CINCINNATI

Guard Deonta Vaughn was held scoreless for the first time in his career as the Bearcats fell at Marquette. Vaughn did have a career-high 10 assists.

The Bearcats shot just 32.7 percent from the field and were 3-of-19 from 3-point range against Marquette.

Vaughn is averaging a team-high 14.1 points per game. Freshman forward Yancy Gates is second in scoring at 10.4 ppg and is the team leader in rebounding (6.2 rpg).

Cincinnati plays its next three BIG EAST games at home, beginning with Wednesday's game against Providence. Cincinnati is 1-2 all-time against the Friars, including an 81-79 setback at Fifth Third Arena last season.

CONNECTICUT

Center Hasheem Thabeet led a balanced scoring attack with 15 points in the win over visiting Rutgers. He also pulled down seven rebounds.

Coach Jim Calhoun, who took ill at halftime, missed the second half. The victory was the 786th of his career which ties Lefty Driesell for seventh on the all-time victory list.

Four Husky players average double figures in scoring, led by guard Jerome Dyson, who is at 14.5 ppg.

UConn will be in West Virginia Tuesday and will try to improve on its 11-2 record against the Mountaineers in BIG EAST regular-season play. WVU won the last meeting 78-72 in The BIG EAST Championship quarterfinals in New York last March.

DE PAUL

Guard Will Walker scored a team-high 14 points in the loss at Providence. It was only the second time this season that forward Dar Tucker or center Mac Koshwal did not lead the team in scoring.

Tucker scored 12 points and Koshwal had seven. Both players pulled down 10 rebounds. Freshman forward Krys Faber came off the bench to score 11 points. He had scored only 13 points in the previous 12 games.

Tucker is third in the BIG EAST in scoring (19.6 ppg) while Koshwal is third in rebounding (11.2 rpg).

DePaul is 7-3 when holding its opponent under 70 points and 1-4 when the opponent scores 70 or more.

Last year against Syracuse, the Blue Demons lost 60-55 at home.

The Hoyas' loss broke a seven-game winning streak this season and a 29-game home winning streak.

Forward DaJuan Summers scored a game-high 22 points, including 4-of-5 from 3-point range. Freshman center Greg Monroe added 15 points and eight boards.

Each team committed only eight turnovers, but GU was beaten on the boards 48-23 and shot only 35.3 percent from the floor.

The Hoyas are at Notre Dame Monday night and will try to break the Irish's 43-game home winning streak, the longest in the nation. GU has taken its last five meetings against ND, which included two games at the BIG EAST Championship. Last season, the Hoyas won 84-65 at home.

Guard Edgar Sosa hit a 30-foot shot with 2.8 seconds remaining to give Louisville the win against Kentucky.

Louisville lost a 12-point second-half lead when Kentucky tied the game at 71-71 with 23 seconds left before Sosa knocked down the game-winner.

The Cardinals were 11-of-20 from 3-point range against Kentucky. Louisville is 8-0 this season when the Cardinals make at least eight 3-point shots.

Freshman forward Samardo Samuels leads the team in scoring at 13.8 points per game. Guard Earl Clark averages 12.8 ppg, while forward Terrence Williams is at 12.3 ppg.

Guard Jerel McNeal had a game-high 26 points on 9-of-10 shooting in the win against Cincinnati. McNeal was 7-of-7 from 3-point range.

The Golden Eagles shot 54 percent from the field and 60 percent from 3-point range against the Bearcats.

Marquette ranks second in the BIG EAST in scoring (81.5 ppg) and 3-point field goal percentage (37.8).

Guard Wesley Matthews is fifth in the BIG EAST in scoring (19.1 ppg), while McNeal is sixth (18.1 ppg).

Marquette is 2-1 all-time against Rutgers and has won the last two meetings. Rutgers took the last meeting in Piscataway, N.J., however, with a 91-84 decision Feb. 12, 2006.

Forward Luke Harangody had 28 points and 14 rebounds -- both game highs -- in the loss at St. John's.

The Irish shot a season-low 23.5 percent (4-of-17) from 3-point range. Guard Kyle McAlarney was 1-of-5 from beyond the arc and finished with 10 points.

Notre Dame still leads the BIG EAST in 3-point field goal percentage (.408) and 3-pointers made (9.4 pg).

Harangody leads the BIG EAST in scoring (23.5 ppg) and rebounding (12.5 rpg). He has scored 20-plus points in his last six games, the first ND player to do that since Troy Murphy in 1999-00.



After BYU's loss Saturday, ND's 43-game home winning streak is the longest in the nation. The Irish host Georgetown Monday. In the last meeting between the two teams at the Joyce Center, the Hoyas won 85-82 in overtime on Jan. 24, 2006.

Guard Weynmi Efejuku led four players in double figures with 18 points in the win over DePaul. The Friars held the Blue Demons to 35.1 percent shooting from the floor.

Forward Geoff McDermott posted 13 points and 10 rebounds. It was his fourth double-double of the season and the 26th of his career. He has grabbed at least 10 rebounds 40 times in his career.

PC has held its two BIG EAST foes to a combined 5-of-36 shooting from 3-point range.

The Friars are 2-0 in the BIG EAST for only the third time since 2002-03. This season, PC has won six of its last seven games overall.
