cincinnati wins battle of unbeaten in big east division

MILWAUKEE -- A week's worth of hard work and dedication comes to a close on Friday afternoon, when Marquette's Session I Day Camp will crown its team champions and individual award winners.

While the regular season determines the seeding, previous years have proved that anything can happen once tournament play begins. Senegal, UCLA, Cincinnati and Miami are all in the driver's seat in their respective divisions, but there are plenty of potential spoilers in the field.

In a battle of unbeaten squads on Thursday, Cincinnati edged Pittsburgh in sudden-death action on a free throw. The Bearcats now have the No. 1 seed in tomorrow's tournament, with the Panthers looking for a chance at payback.
