MILWAUKEE -- The second week of Marquette's summer camp schedule got off to a successful start Monday morning at the Al McGuire Center as nearly 300 participants took to the courts.

Game action began right away on Monday, with four divisions battling for a regular season and tournament crown. Team results through Thursday will determine seeding in advance of "Championship Friday," when a tourney champion will be determined. Anything can happen in tournament action, as illustrated by week one's results. In two of the four divisions, the first-place team at the conclusion of the regular season was unable to come away victorious on Friday.

MIKE O'BRIEN (Houston) scored the game-winning basket with 2.2 seconds left in his team's victory over Miami. Georgetown's **ALEX ATHANASIOU** knocked down a trio of 3-pointers in his squad's win over Rutgers, including one at the halftime buzzer. In other action, St. John's rallied for a 33-29 decision behind the leadership of **RYAN VAN BLARCOM**.

The week's first individual awards were claimed by **CODY BOBERT** (Senegal) and **LOGAN MCSHANE** (UConn), who each earned the free throw award. Bobert was crowned champion of the Olympic Division, while McShane topped a group of competitors from the NCAA, BIG EAST and NBA divisions.
