Four Teams Remain Undefeated

MILWAUKEE -- The campers at the Session II Day Camp continued their escape from the balmy temperatures outside with skill development and team play at the Al McGuire Center.

Regular-season competition heated up on the courts as positioning continued for "Championship Friday" and tournament action.

Senegal has the regular-season crown all but wrapped up in the Olympic Division thanks to a sparkling 6-0 record. Three squads (Minnesota, Kansas and Memphis) own identical 6-1 slates in the NCAA Division and West Virginia, Syracuse and Seton Hall remain undefeated in the BIG EAST Division. The NBA Division is far from settled, with three (Milwaukee, Houston and Miami) of the four squads owning identical 4-2 records.

Wednesday's standouts included **CLAYTON VAN TASSEL**, whose layup allowed Minnesota to rally for a victory in overtime. **ANDY RICHTER** collected some key rebounds for USF in the team's first victory.

Daily award honorees included **CODY BOBERT** (USA) and **SPENCER WILKER** (UConn), who claimed the free throw title. Bobert has won two of the three days this week. **WILL SKOWRONSKI** (USA), **MICHAEL JANSEN** (Minnesota), **JEREMY TUTAS** (Pittsburgh) and **DREW DALZIN** (Houston) earned camper of the day accolades.
