The Marquette University men's basketball team (9-4) opens up BIG EAST Conference play Saturday morning at 10 a.m. CT when the squad welcomes West Virginia to the Bradley Center on New Year's Day. ESPN2 will feature MU's fifth national television broadcast of the campaign, with Jon Sciambi (play-by-play) and Fran Fraschilla (analyst) calling the action. The BIG EAST schedule features four games Saturday, with the MU-WVU matchup being the earliest opening tip in advance of several bowl games.

## Golden Eagles Begin Sixth Season In BIG EAST

Saturday's matchup with West Virginia tips off Marquette's sixth year in the BIG EAST Conference.

Picked eighth in the league's preseason coaches poll, Marquette is one of just three programs (Georgetown and Pittsburgh) to claim 10-or-more victories in conference play in each of the last five seasons.

MU is 14-7 all-time in conference openers (Midwestern Collegiate; 1-1, Great Midwest; 3-1, Conference USA; 7-3, BIG EAST; 3-2).

The Golden Eagles opened league action in 2007-08 with a convincing 96-67 home victory over Providence and followed that up with a 79-72 decision over Villanova in 2008-09.

The team defeated UConn in its first-ever BIG EAST game in 2005-06, but fell to the Friars in 2006-07 in the conference lidlifter. Last season, Marquette's upset bid at No. 6/6 West Virginia came up just short thanks to a Mountaineer buzzer beater, resulting in a 63-62 setback.

## MU Sees Familiar 2009-10 Trend Carry Into This Year

In 2009-10, the Golden Eagles played in 16 games (34 total) decided by four-or-less points, the highest total by any program in the nation. No stranger to close contests, MU has already participated in three games in 2010-11 decided by a single possession and two others finishing with five-point margins.

Marquette's four losses this season have come by a total of just 14 points and three of the setbacks were against nationally ranked foes (No. 1 Duke, No. 22 Gonzaga, No. 24 Vanderbilt). MU and Michigan State are the two teams that have come closest to knocking off No. 1 Duke, with both squads falling by five points.

The Golden Eagles also own a 75-72 victory at Milwaukee on Nov. 27 and are 1-2 in one-possession contests in 2010-11 following Wednesday's 77-76 loss at Vanderbilt.

## Balanced Scoring Leading Offensive Attack

Marquette ranks eighth in the nation (through games of Dec. 29) in field goal percentage (.502) and 14th in scoring (81.5 ppg.) thanks in large part to a well-balanced offensive attack.

Wednesday's outing at Vanderbilt marked the third time this season Marquette has had five players finish with double figures in points, and in eight of the squad's 13 contests at least four players have reached the 10-point plateau. A season-best six scorers netted 10-or-more points in the win over Green Bay.

Senior Jimmy Butler has reached double figures in all but one game (Longwood) in 2010-11 and has been joined on at least one occasion by Vander Blue, Dwight Buycks, Jae Crowder, Davante Gardner, Darius Johnson-Odom, Jamail Jones, Chris Otule and Erik Williams.

## Crowder's Career-Best Night Leads MU To Victory

Junior forward Jae Crowder netted 12-straight points in the victory over Mississippi Valley State en route to a career-best 22-point night.

The Villa Rica, Ga., native shot 8-of-15 from the field, including a 3-of-4 effort from behind the 3-point line. In just over a minute of actual game time in the first half, Crowder helped turn a seven-point advantage into a 14-point lead thanks to a trio of treys and a mid-range jumper. His 12-point outburst included three-straight from long distance.

He also found time to chip in five rebounds, three assists, two steals and a block in just 28 minutes of action. For his efforts, Crowder was named to the BIG EAST Honor Roll (Dec. 27) for the first time.

## Free Throw Line Continues To Provide Advantage

The ability to consistently get to the free throw line, as well as convert on those opportunities, has been a team focus since third-year head coach Buzz Williams took over prior to the 2008-09 campaign.

The focus has been evident early in 2010-11, where once again the Golden Eagles have made more free throws (223) than their opponents have even attempted (193). As a result, MU is outscoring its opponents by an average of over eight points per game (17.2-8.9) from the line. The Dec. 21 outing against Mississippi Valley State provided a perfect example of the trend. Marquette finished 26-of-31 from the charity stripe and the Delta Devils were 16-of-20 for the game. With MU fouling on a limited basis, the team has yet to have a player foul out in 2010-11.

In 2008-09, the Golden Eagles knocked down 668 free throws, while opponents attempted just a total of 600 in 35 outings. Last season, Marquette made a total of 489 charity tosses and enemy shooters attempted 542 as a group, but MU was able to average almost four more points per outing at the free throw line.

Since the start of the 2008-09 season, Marquette is 1,380-of-1,900 (72.6 percent) from the free throw line and opponents are 889-of-1,335 (66.6 percent).

## Offense Produces Impressive Halftime Total

The Golden Eagles shot 57.1 percent (20-of-35) from the field in the first half against Mississippi Valley State, finishing the opening 20 minutes with 56 points.

The squad's point total marked the highest in any half since the team netted 57 points in the second half at Villanova on Jan. 9, 2010. The Dec. 21 effort was the best first-half score since Marquette collected 54 points prior to halftime against Eastern Illinois on Nov. 26, 2002 in a 97-74 victory.

## Crowder Nearly Perfect From Deep: On First Attempt

Junior forward Jae Crowder has made at least one 3-pointer in 10 of the last 11 games for Marquette.

He is shooting 10-of-11 from behind the line on his respective first attempt of each outing. Of those 10 treys, six have come from the top of the key. Following his first shot from long distance, however, Crowder has connected on just 3-of-18 attempts dating back to the Nov. 17 contest versus Green Bay. His perfect streak was snapped on a first-half attempt at Vanderbilt on Wednesday night.

For the season, Crowder is connecting on 41.9 percent (13-of-31) from 3-point land.

## Butler Doubles Up For First Time In Nearly A Year

Senior forward Jimmy Butler collected his fifth career double-double in the win over Centenary, finishing with 10 points and 12 rebounds in 31 minutes of action.

The Dec. 18 outing marked the first time since Dec. 5, 2009 against NC State that Butler was able to reach double figures in both points and rebounds. Against the Wolfpack, he finished with 19 points and 12 boards.

## Jones Shows Proper 3-Point Etiquette Against Gentlemen

Freshman forward Jamail Jones had a breakout offensive performance against Centenary, netting a personal-best 11 points in just 11 minutes off the bench.

Jones finished 4-of-6 from the field overall and 3-of-4 from behind the 3-point line. He also chipped in one block and a steal. The Atlanta, Ga., native's trio to treys marked just the third time this season a MU player drained at least three long-distance shots in a sin-

## Blue Picking Up Offensive Production

Freshman Vander Blue has made a habit of consistently contributing in a variety of statistical categories on a game-by-game basis. In recent outings he has managed to increase his offensive production.

The Madison, Wis., native has reached double figures in point on six occasions this year, including five of the squad's last six contests. He is averaging 13.5 points per game during that time, second on the team. Since the Dec. 4 matchup with Longwood, Blue is also contributing 3.5 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.8 steals per game while shooting 57.7 percent (30-of-52) from the field and 20-of-25 (80.0 percent) from the free throw line.

## Is Key To Victory Field Goal Percentage?

Head coach Buzz Williams has stressed defense since he took over the reigns of the program and that focus, along with offensive efficiency, has played a key role in the team's success during his tenure.

Dating back to the start of 2008-09, the Golden Eagles are 40-3 when finishing the game with a field goal percentage even-or-better than their opponents. That includes an 9-2 mark thus far in 2010-11 and a 14-1 record in 2009-10. The only losses came March 6, 2010 versus Notre Dame, Dec. 11, 2010 against Wisconsin and Wednesday at Vanderbilt.

Since 2008-09, MU has finished 50 percent-or-better from the field on 27 occasions and owns an 24-3 record (at Villanova in 2008-09, vs. Washington in 2009-10, at Vanderbilt in 2010-11) in those outings.

## Otule's Vision Is Perfect From The Field Vs. LU

Sophomore center Chris Otule finished a perfect 9-of-9 from the field in the victory over Longwood on Dec. 4, finishing just one basket away from matching former teammate Wesley Matthews' school-best mark (10-of-10 vs. Rutgers, 1/7/09).

The Richmond, Texas, native finished with a career-best 19 points in just 19 minutes of action and was also able to chip in five rebounds and three blocked shots. His efforts earned him a place on the BIG EAST Conference Honor Roll for the week of Dec. 6.

Otule's perfect streak from the field extended to a total of 13 shot attempts and three games before missing against A&M-Corpus Christi.

## MU Extends Series Winning Streak Against Milwaukee

Marquette has now matched up with Milwaukee in men's basketball on 38 occasions all-time, coming away victorious in each of those outings.

The Golden Eagles' current 38-game winning streak is the second-longest active run by any NCAA program against a single opponent and ranks eighth all-time.

Of the 38 matchups, 34 have come in Marquette's home arena. That current home-court run is sixth-best in the NCAA. MU "traveled" to Milwaukee for the first time since 1931 and the three-point victory was the slimmest winning margin in series history.

## Butler Named To CBE Classic All-Tourney Team

With every National Basketball Association squad represented on press row, senior forward Jimmy Butler made a name for himself in the two games at the CBE Classic.

As a result, the Tomball, Texas, native was named to the all-tourney team along with Steven Gray (Gonzaga), Jamar Samuels (Kansas State), Mason Plumlee (Duke) and Kyrie Irving (Duke).

In the two games at the Sprint Center, Butler averaged 22.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 50 percent (16-of-32) from the field.

## MU Runs Past Green Bay With Balanced Scoring

The Golden Eagles shot 58.1 percent from the field in the first half and as a result were able to pull away for an 89-69 victory over Green Bay on Nov. 17.

Six players netted double figures in points for Marquette, led by junior forward Jae Crowder's 17 off the bench. Four of the squad's five starters also reached the 10-point plateau, including a career-best 14 points from freshman guard Vander Blue.

The last time MU had six players reach double figures in points came in 2009-10 against Presbyterian. Forward Lazar Hayward led the way with 23 points in that outing, which resulted in a 102-62 victory over the Blue Hose at the Bradley Center.

## Buzz Claims 50th Victory As Program Mentor

Head coach Buzz Williams collected his 50th victory as Marquette's head coach on Nov. 17 in the team's 89-69 win over Green Bay.

Williams is now 56-26 in just over two seasons at the helm and is the 11th coach in school history to claim at least 50 victories. Legendary coach Al McGuire is the school's all-time leader in wins (295) and winning percentage (.787).

Williams is now 70-43 (.625) overall as a head coach, including his one season at New Orleans.

## Golden Eagles Use 24-0 Run To Rally Past Bison

Trailing 57-45 with 10:22 remaining in the second half against Bucknell, the Golden Eagles put together an impressive 24-0 run to take control of the game.

A layup by junior forward Jae Crowder got things started for MU, which didn't allow the Bison to add to their game total until netting a free throw with 1:41 left in regulation and the Golden Eagles up 12 points.

Freshman Davante Gardner scored eight of his 11 points during that time frame and senior Dwight Buycks, who scored a game-high 17 points, chipped in seven. Newcomer Vander Blue hit a big 3-pointer to close the gap to one point after scoring a layup.



## Buzz Williams

### Character Revealed.

Those two words have served as the foundation of the Marquette University men's basketball team under third-year head coach Buzz Williams ever since he was officially named program mentor on April 8, 2008.

The 2009-10 Golden Eagles were a perfect illustration of Williams' core system of values, working hard on a daily basis to ensure the team's accomplishments on the court and in the classroom would bring a sense of pride to all of the University's supporters.

The team's character was tested from start to finish, beginning with low preseason expectations from the national pundits and concluding with a heartbreaking postseason loss. No team in the nation played in more one-possession games than MU, but that didn't stop the squad from collecting the program's fifth-straight NCAA Championship appearance and 20-win season. Marquette finished 22-12 overall, including an 11-7 mark in the BIG EAST Conference, which was good enough for fifth-place in the 16-team league.

Lazar Hayward (Second Team All-BIG EAST) finished second all-time in scoring at MU and four of the program's top-10 all-time scorers have now graduated within the past two seasons. Junior forward Jimmy Butler was one of the most improved players in the country and as a result was tabbed honorable mention all-league.

Williams directed MU to a 25-10 overall record in 2008-09, which included a school-record 12 BIG EAST victories. The Golden Eagles advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship and were ranked among the nation's top-25 teams the entire campaign. A pair of players, Jerel McNeal and Wesley Matthews, claimed all-league accolades and McNeal also claimed All-America honors.

Off the court, Williams and his staff assembled a consensus top-25 recruiting class in each of the last two years, including a group rated as high as No. 1 in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com (2008-09). The program's community service efforts have also reached new heights under Williams, highlighted by "Buzz's Bunch." This group, founded by Williams, focuses on providing opportunities for special needs children to attend games and summer camps. The Golden Eagles have also continued and strengthened their long-standing relationships with Children's Hospital as well as Special Olympics.

In 2007-08, Williams served as an assistant coach with the Golden Eagles in his first season at Marquette. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has over 15 years of experience at the NCAA Division I level. Williams has recruited and coached over 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including one league player of the year, two conference freshmen of the year and two Associated Press All-Americans (McNeal and Hayward).

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07

and his roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05/2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 25 years in 2005-06 and the previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01/2003-04) at Colorado State, serving as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40-best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference.

Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure and he was named one of the top assistants in the country by HoopScoopOnline.com. Williams was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98).

Williams signed the highest-rated recruiting class in the history of the Southland Conference while at Northwestern State. The Demons advanced to their first ever NCAA tourney the following season and two of his recruited players were named all-conference, while one was tabbed Southland Conference Tournament MVP.

His accomplishments at Texas A&M-Kingsville include signing the 1998-99 Lone Star Conference Freshman of the Year and a third team All-America guard. At Texas-Arlington, Williams recruited a Southland Conference Freshman of the Year and signed the first Academic All-

Williams served as a student assistant from 1990-92 at Navarro College (Corsicana, Texas) where the team won consecutive conference titles while sporting a 45-17 record during his tenure. He began his career under mentor Lewis Orr, who was inducted into the National Junior College Athletic Association Hall of Fame in 1999 after a 37-year career at the junior college level.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple has two daughters, Zera (8) and Addyson (1), and two sons, Calvin (7) and Mason (4).

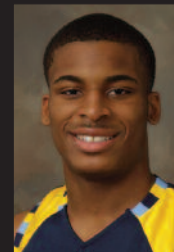

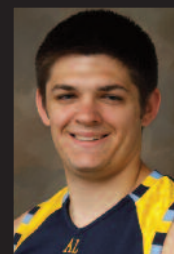
