About the Course: A David Toms signature course, Carter Plantation has a Louisiana Golf Association slope rating of 140 and a course rating of 74.4. Both the front and back nines consist of two par-3s, five par-4s, and two par-5s with eighty-six strategically placed bunkers.

Last Time Out: The Golden Eagles struggled on day one at the Pinehurst Intercollegiate in Pinehurst, N.C., but gradual improvement and adjustments to the course led MU to a modest 10th-place finish out of a total 19 teams. Marquette saved its best round for last with a 290, as did Mike Van Sickle who posted the team's only sub-par round of the tourney with his 71. Van Sickle tied for 10th with a 223.

First Two-Day, Three-Round Tourney of '08: This week's Carter Plantation Invitational is the MU's first two-day tournament of 2008, meaning the Golden Eagles and the rest of the field will play two rounds on the opening day, Monday, March 24. The last time MU played a two-day event was the BIG EAST/MAC Challenge, Oct. 29-30, 2007. MU won the event by five strokes.

Golden Eagles Soaring To New Heights: Marquette captured two tournament titles – the Xavier Invitational and BIG EAST/MAC Challenge – this past fall, matching the most tournaments won by an MU squad during a single season. Overall, MU has placed in the top-3 in five of its six tournaments thus far in 2007-08.

Bielawski, Gray Among MU's All-Time Leaders in Rounds Played

If senior Mike Bielawski plays both his rounds during Monday's opening day of the Carter Plantation Invitational, he will surpass Nathan Colson as the school's all-time leader in rounds played. Bielawski has played 121.0 rounds entering the tourney, while Colson's record is 122.0 rounds. Fellow senior Ted Gray is not far behind. Gray enters this week's event with 117.0 rounds played.

Van Sickle Adds To School Record With 6th win

By successfully defending his title at the Ron Smith/USF invitational in the team's first tournament of the 2008 spring season, Mike Van Sickle earned sixth career victory as a Golden Eagles, thus adding to his school record for tournaments won. Currently in second place is Tom Uutala, who had won three events from 1994-1998.

Four Players Currently Among All-Time Scoring Leaders

Four of the top eight scoring averages all-time at MU belong to members of the current Golden Eagles' squad. Junior Mike Van Sickle ranks first with a 72.15 career average followed by senior Ted Gray (74.14). Fellow senior Mike Bielawski ranks sixth (75.15) and junior Dustin Schwab ranks eighth (75.69).

Van Sickle Invited To Sunnehanna

Mike Van Sickle continued to add to his resume' as one of the nation's elite up-and-coming players by accepting an invitation to play in the 55th Annual Sunnehanna Amateur Tournament for Champions at Sunnehanna Country Club in Johnstown, Pa. in June. Van Sickle also played in the Western Refining All-America Classic this past fall, and he is expected to play in the prestigious Porter Cup in July, although a formal announcement has not yet been made.

MU In The Rankings

As of March 21, GolfStat's Head-To-Head Standings currently ranks Marquette No. 70 in the nation, while the Golden Eagles fall in at No. 76 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Performance Index. Mike Van Sickle is rated No. 34 among individuals, according to Golfweek/Sagarin and is No. 8 in the Golfstat Cup rankings. MU's highest Golfstat team ranking this season was No. 54.

Haase Tabbed As Wisconsin's Top Junior Player

Freshman Matt Haase, who has yet to even break the Golden Eagles' lineup, was named 2007 Junior Boys Player of the Year by the Wisconsin State Golf Association. Haase helped his Medford (Wis.) High School team win three conference titles in four years and won back-to-back conference individual medalist honors as a junior and senior.

Golf World: Van Sickle Best Player You've (Maybe) Never Heard Of

Mike Van Sickle was recently named to the Golf World Mid-season All-American team. Van Sickle was also recognized as the "Best Player You've (Maybe) Never Heard Of," by the publication's senior collegiate writer Ryan Herrington. "The 20-year-old junior wasn't a blue-chip recruit coming out of Wexford, Pa., but the late bloomer is giving golf journalists something to write by becoming the Golden Eagles' all-time best player," Herrington stated in his "Campus Insider Blog."

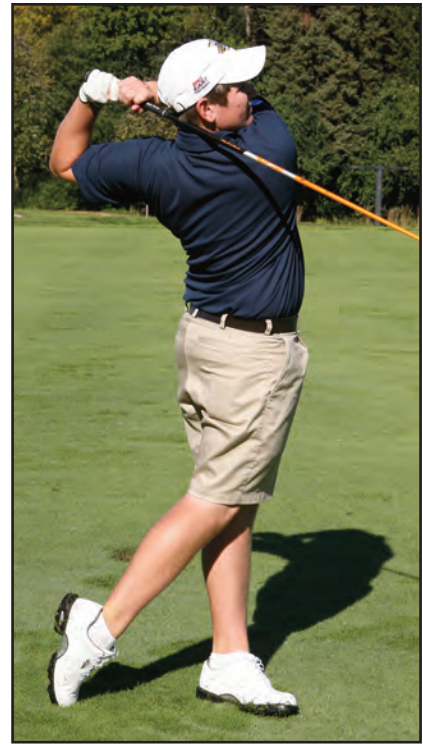
