## 2008 BIG EAST Men's Golf Championship

**Participating Teams (12):** Seton Hall, USF, Marquette, Connecticut, Cincinnati (host), Louisville, Villanova, Notre Dame, Georgetown, St. John's, Rutgers, DePaul.

**About the Course:** Located about 12 miles away from downtown Cincinnati, Ohio, tucked away in the hills of northern Kentucky, the par 72 Traditions Golf Club one of the longest courses MU will have played this season at 7,103 yards. The course rating is 74.4 with a slope rating of 138 on Bent grass. It opened in 1992.

**Last Time Out:** Mike Bielawski carded his best round of the season and tied Mike Van Sickle for third overall with a four-under par 212. Van Sickle has now posted five straight rounds of par-or-better, accomplishing the feat 25 times in his junior campaign and 57 times for his career, both school records. As a team, the Golden Eagles were one stroke back from No. 48 Augusta State and finished fourth overall with a six-over 870. MU has boasted eight top-five finishes in 10 events thus far in 2007-08.

**About the Field:** MU has gone head-to-head with all but three BIG EAST schools this season (Louisville, Notre Dame, Georgetown), posting a 13-0 record in those events, including 3-0 against DePaul and this weekend's host, Cincinnati. Defending tournament champion Louisville is the highest ranked team heading into the event. The Cardinals are ranked No. 28 in the country, according to Golfstats' latest head-to-head ratings. No. 70 MU is the second-highest rated team in the field.

**Ins & Outs:** Mike Van Sickle's six-under 66 in last year's opening round tied a BIG EAST Championship record. He finished at five-under 211, two strokes behind medalist Daryl Fathauer of Louisville. Marquette finished fourth overall and Louisville won the 2007 event, which was held at Cardinal Club Course, UofL's home site.

## CLUBHOUSE BLOTTER

### Teeing Off

MU has been seeded third for the 2008 BIG EAST Championship. Seeding for the men's tournament is done by a random, blind draw by conference officials. Each round of the three-day event will begin at 7 a.m. CT with groups starting at hole one and hole 10. Dustin Schwab will have MU's first tee time on Sunday, April 20. He will tee off at 7:50 a.m. CT. Mike Van Sickle will tee off last for MU at approximately 8:30 a.m. CT. Marquette has been paired with Seton Hall and USF for the opening round. MU's practice round will begin on hole one at 12:30 p.m. CT on Saturday, April 19. Per NCAA rules, participants and coaches are not allowed on the golf course 10 days before the first practice round. The host school, which this year is Cincinnati, is exempt from this policy.

### Best Marquette Team Ever?

Marquette has posted eight top-five finishes in 10 tournaments played, including a pair of event championships to match a school record. While both the team's victories came in the fall, other top finishes this spring included the Ron Smith/USF Invitational where MU tied for second among 18 teams. The Golden Eagles also finished runner-up at the Carter Plantation Intercollegiate at the end of March. Entering the tournament, MU owns a collective 291.21 scoring average, which is on pace to shatter the program's previous single season mark of 293.03 set in 2005-06.

### Van Sickle Among National Statistical Leaders

Mike Van Sickle ranks among this year's national leaders in several statistical categories. As of April 4, the MU junior ranked second in both total number of eagles (7) and birdies (122). His scoring average of 70.72 was eighth in the country and the all-time single-season mark at MU.

### Bielawski, Gray Most Experienced Golfers In MU History

MU senior Mike Bielawski moved ahead of former teammate Nathan Colson earlier this season for most career rounds played. Heading into the BIG EAST Championship, Bielawski has played in 45 collegiate events, including 129 rounds played. Last week, fellow senior Ted Gray also passed Colson (122) and has now played 125 rounds for the Golden Eagles.

### Four Players Currently Among All-Time Scoring Leaders

Four of the top nine scoring averages all-time at MU belong to members of the current Golden Eagles' squad. Junior Mike Van Sickle ranks first with a 72.11 career average followed by senior Ted Gray (74.15). Fellow senior Mike Bielawski ranks fifth (75.13) and junior Dustin Schwab ranks ninth (75.69). Although freshman Kelly Kretz has not played the minimum 45 rounds to qualify, but Kretz's current mark of 74.52 would rank third behind Gray.

### MU In The Rankings

Marquette dropped one spot to No. 70 in Golfstat's head-to-head standings and stays put and No. 77 in the Golweek/Sagarin Performance Index. Mike Van Sickle is currently No. 16 in the Golfstat Cup rankings. MU's highest Golfstat team ranking this season was No. 54 following the conclusion of the fall season in which MU won two events.

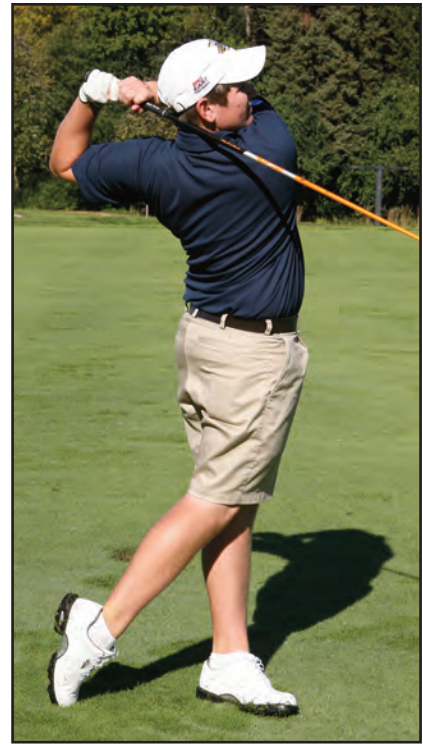
