About the Course: The No. 8 Course opened in 1996, Pinehurst's centennial year. It was the site of the PGA Club Pro Championships in 1997 and 1998. Pinehurst No. 8 was designed by Tom Fazio and features dips and swales around the greens, sloping greens and false fronts with a slope of 74.1 and 138 rating.

Last Time Out: Marquette rallied on days two and three to finish in a tie for second place with Florida Southern College at the Ron Smith/USF Invitational in Dade City, Fla. Mike Van Sickle claimed medalist honors, defending his 2007 tournament title and claiming his sixth career victory, adding to the junior's school record. Van Sickle won by four strokes, while MU finished 14 strokes behind team champion Middle Tennessee State.

McDonald Inserted Into Lineup: Sophomore Mike McDonald beat out teammate Dustin Schwab for the Golden Eagles' fifth and final spot in this weekend's playing lineup. McDonald played in four events as a freshman, but did not play this past fall.

Golden Eagles Soaring To New Heights: Marquette captured two tournament titles - the Xavier Invitational and BIG EAST/MAC Challenge - this past fall, matching the most tournaments won by an MU squad during a single season. Overall, MU has placed in the top-3 in five of its six tournaments thus far in 2007-08.

Bielawski Among MU All-Time Leaders in Rounds Played

Senior Mike Bielawski moved into a tie for second place with Kyle Murphy (2002-06) among MU's all-time leaders with 118.0 career rounds played. The school record is currently held by Nathan Colson (2001-06) with 122.0 rounds. Although Bielawski cannot catch Colson this weekend, he is on pace to become the school's all-time leader midway through the Carter Plantation Intercollegiate on March 25.

Van Sickle Adds To School Record With 6th win

By successfully defending his title at the Ron Smith/USF invitational in the team's first tournament of the 2008 spring season, Mike Van Sickle earned sixth career victory as a Golden Eagles, thus adding to his school record for tournaments won. Currently in second place is Tom Uutala, who had won three events from 1994-1998.

Freshman Making His Mark

Kelly Kretz's career at MU is off to a solid start. His scoring average of 74.00 after six tournaments ranks third-best on the squad and is currently the seventh-best single season scoring average all-time at MU. Kretz posted back-to-back top-10 finishes to end the 2007 fall campaign. Kretz's six rounds under par are also second on the team to Van Sickle (12).

MU In The Rankings

As of March 12, GolfStat's Head-To-Head Standings currently ranks Marquette No. 64 in the nation, while the Golden Eagles fall in at No. 68 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Performance Index. Mike Van Sickle is rated No. 22 among individuals, according to Golfweek/Sagarin and is No. 9 in the Golfstat Cup rankings.

Four Players Currently Among All-Time Scoring Leaders

Four of the top eight scoring averages all-time at MU belong to members of the current Golden Eagles' squad. Junior Mike Van Sickle ranks first with a 72.07 career average followed by senior Ted Gray (74.11). Fellow senior Mike Bielawski ranks sixth (75.17) and junior Dustin Schwab ranks eighth (75.69).

Haase Tabbed As Wisconsin's Top Junior Player

Freshman Matt Haase, who has yet to even break the Golden Eagles' lineup, was named 2007 Junior Boys Player of the Year by the Wisconsin State Golf Association. Haase helped his Medford (Wis.) High School team win three conference titles in four years and won back-to-back conference individual medalist honors as a junior and senior.

Team Scoring Average On Pace To Break Single-Season Mark

MU's team scoring average of 288.06 per round after six tournaments is nearly five strokes better than the program's best-ever single-season mark of 293.03 set after 31 rounds during the 2005-06 campaign.

Golf World: Van Sickle Best Player You've (Maybe) Never Heard Of

Mike Van Sickle was recently named to the Golf World Mid-season All-American team. Van Sickle was also recognized as the "Best Player You've (Maybe) Never Heard Of," by the publication's senior collegiate writer Ryan Herrington. "The 20-year-old junior wasn't a blue-chip recruit coming out of Wexford, Pa., but the late bloomer is giving golf journalists something to write by becoming the Golden Eagles' all-time best player," Herrington stated in his "Campus Insider Blog."

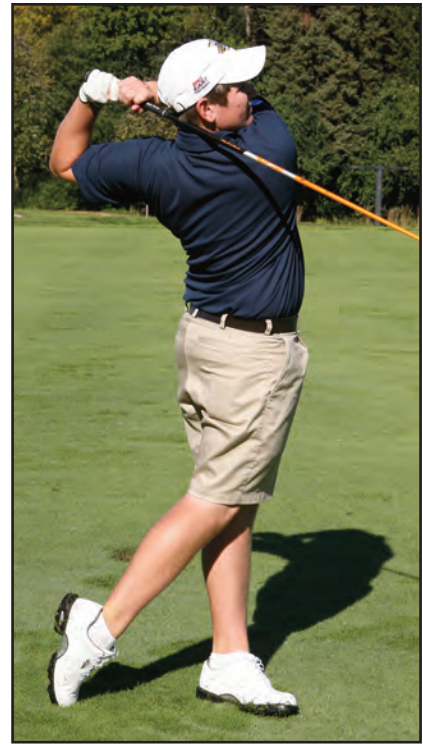

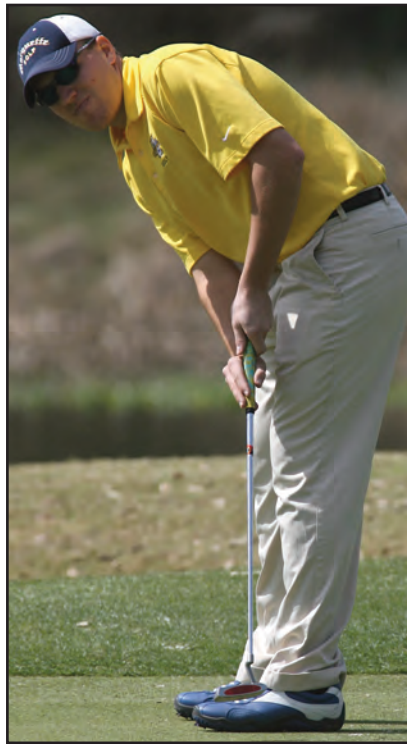
