

SOCCER CAMP INFORMATION

DISCOUNTS

Discounts are available for groups of five or more, who register by May 1, 2006. Applicants that send in their application together receive \$10 off per person.

EQUIPMENT

1. Must provide their own clothing (according to weather).
2. Flat-soled and cleated shoes.
3. Shin guards are mandatory.
4. Drinking water and an athletic trainer will be provided, however each camper is asked to bring his or her own water bottle each session.

INSURANCE/ MEDICAL FORMS

Camper **MUST** have their own health insurance. Each camper must complete and return medical history and medical release forms in order to participate. We cannot permit the camper to be part of the camp unless these forms are returned. You will receive medical forms along with your confirmation, or you can download the medical forms on our website (www.gomarquette.com) and return with your registration.

REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS

No refunds will be given for non-medical reasons once the application has been accepted. Medical excuses must be presented with an authorized doctor's notice. In case of unforeseen circumstances, in which a camp is cancelled, the camp office will notify you two weeks prior to the start of camp. A full refund will be presented.

CONFIRMATION/DEADLINES

Upon receipt of camper's application, we will mail a confirmation sheet along with health and insurance forms to be filled out and returned prior to participation in camp. Registration deadline is seven (7) days prior to the beginning of each session.

LOCATION/VALLEY FIELDS

Camps will be held at the Valley Fields located on West Canal St, Milwaukee WI. Arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of each session.

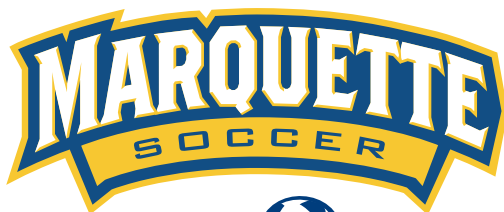

COACHING STAFF



LOUIS BENNETT HEAD COACH

Louis Bennett, a native of Great Britain, Bennett is the new Marquette University head coach. Prior to his appointment he was the head coach at University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee men's soccer team since 1996. His most recent accomplishments include five-straight NCAA Tournament berths, four Horizon League Coach of the Year awards, and he has been named the Great Lakes Region Coach of the Year Twice. His playing experience includes seven years of professional soccer in the U.S. with the Milwaukee Wave, Dayton Dynamo, Memphis Rogues and Kansas City Comets. Bennett played collegiate soccer at Crewe and Alsager College in England, winning a national championship in 1982. He holds USSF, NSCAA and English Football Association coaching Licenses.

STAN ANDERSON ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Stan Anderson joins the coaching staff at MU after a very successful run at UWM. A former college All-American at UW-Parkside, his main priorities are recruiting, on the field coaching, off field program development and working with the goalkeepers. Over the last ten seasons Coach Anderson has compiled some impressive accolades:

- 5 straight NCAA Tournament appearances
4 straight NCAA advancements
- 2 goalkeepers ('02, '05) finishing in the Top 3 in Division 1 goals against average (GAA)
- 2-time national Top Assistant Coach list

He played at the University of Hartford (CT) where his team set school records for wins in a season(17), final national ranking (10th) and advanced to the "Elite Eight" of the 1996 NCAA Tournament. He was drafted by the Mississippi Beach Kings of the EISL in 1998.

The coaching staff's camp experience goes back to 1989 when Coach Bennett and Coach Anderson first worked together at the British American Soccer Program. In addition to ten years of youth camp experience at UWM, Coach Anderson started Stan Anderson's Camp Shutout. This goalkeeper specific camp has blossomed into one of the most attended goalkeeper specific camps in the country.
