

MEET THE COACHES

LOUIS BENNETT -- HEAD COACH

Heading into year three with Marquette, Head Coach Louis Bennett continues to focus on the improvement of the soccer program as a whole.

Widely regarded as one of the top head coaches in college soccer, Bennett is a five-time winner of the Horizon League's Coach of the Year Award and twice was named Great Lakes Coach of the Year. Prior to Marquette, Bennett led the UWM Panthers to five straight NCAA Tournament berths, including four consecutive appearances in the second round of the tournament. The most successful coach in the history of UWM men's soccer, Bennett compiled a 136-63-17 record in 10 seasons.

A native of Great Britain, Bennett has made the Milwaukee area his home since 1985. Bennett played professional soccer for seven years in the U.S., including three seasons with the Milwaukee Wave of the NPSL (1985-87).

STAN ANDERSON -- ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Primarily focused on coaching the Marquette goalkeepers, Stan Anderson is also regarded as one of the most community-active coaches in the country, and has been named to the nation's top assistant coach list by College Soccer News in each of the previous three seasons.

Anderson also spearheads Soccer Mom Camp, a unique five-week long clinic that promotes soccer among adult women and raised \$5,000 for "Kicks Against Breast Cancer."

Possessing 19 years of youth camp experience, Anderson also serves as head coach of the 1991 Wisconsin State Olympic Development Program team.

KHALED EL-AHMAD -- ASSISTANT COACH

An entrepreneur and philanthropist, Khaled El-Ahmad is the founder and owner of the Excellency Clinic, LLC, an organization that raises money for soccer programs and charitable organizations.

El-Ahmad played professionally for Sigma Olomouc of the premier league in the Czech Republic and also had a training stint with the Chicago Fire of Major League Soccer.

JESSE ROSEN -- ASSISTANT COACH

Joining MU from FC Milwaukee, Rosen holds a USSF B License. He has coached 7 State Championship teams and 3 Regional Championship Semi-finalists.

Rosen was a member of the 1996 University of Hartford team that reached the NCAA Tournament "Elite Eight," and he was drafted by the Mississippi Beach Kings of the EISL in 1998.

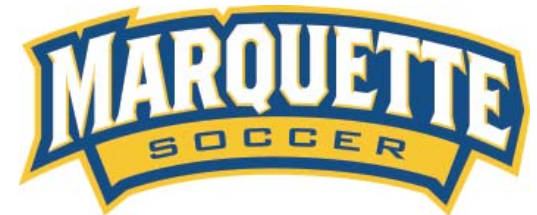

Refunds & Cancellations

Confirmation & Deadlines

A camper's application will not be confirmed until you download the waiver/insurance forms that are found on the web, and return them with your application. You will not be eligible unless we receive the application and waiver forms.

Equipment

3. Shin Guards are mandatory
4. Drinking water and an athletic trainer will be provided, however each camper is asked to bring his or her own water bottle each session
