Two of the early pioneers of women's athletics at Marquette, **TAT SHIELY** and **KATHY ANDRYKOWSKI**, represent the women's volleyball program in the prestigious M Club Hall of Fame.

The Hall of Fame, housed in the Al McGuire Center's "Walk of Champions," includes such Marquette luminaries as Olympic great Ralph Metcalfe, legendary men's basketball head coach Al McGuire and NBA superstar Dwyane Wade.

During her Marquette career, Andrykowski earned four letters each in volleyball and basketball, was a four-time all-conference volleyball player in the Wisconsin Women's Athletic Conference and served as team captain in 1980. Following her time at MU, Andrykowski was awarded the McCahill Award in 1980, honoring her performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics. From 1980-87 she played professional basketball in the United States and across Europe.

Shiely coached the Marquette volleyball team from its inception in 1975 until 1998 season and compiled a career record of 380-477-5. She also coached the women's basketball squad for 11 years.

These trailblazing women followed in the legacy Marquette University laid forth when it became the first Catholic university in the United States to admit women in 1909.
