Player of the Week

Valeria Kovaleva, Sr., OH



Kovaleva earns BIG EAST Player of the Week for her standout role in the Red Storm's 2-0 weekend of league matches. The senior posted a career-high 21 kills, along with 13 digs for a double-double in the Red Storm's 3-1 win against Villanova on Nov. 1. Kovaleva led all players in the 3-1 victory over Seton Hall with 18 kills. She had a team-best .400 hitting percentage in the win to go with seven digs and three service aces. With the two BIG EAST wins, St. John's remains first in the league standings with a 9-1 conference record.

Freshman of the Week

Missy Harpenau, Fr., OH



As Cincinnati collected two BIG EAST wins over the weekend, Missy Harpenau had a great all-around week, notching her fifth kill-dig double-double of the season. In the Bearcats five-set thriller against USF on Oct. 31, Harpenau posted 13 kills and 15 digs to secure the 3-2 victory. The freshman added nine kills and five digs as Cincinnati swept Georgetown 3-0 on Nov. 2. With the pair of wins, the Bearcats have now won 12 straight matches.

BIG EAST NEWS & NOTES

◆**CINCINNATI:** The Bearcats have rolled off 12 straight wins after posting victories over USF and Georgetown last weekend. Cincinnati secured a perfect 11-0 October by beating the Bulls 3-2 on Oct. 31. Sophomore Stephanie Niemer paced the Bearcats with 21 kills, while freshman Missy Harpenau added 13 kills and 15 digs for her fifth kill-dig double-double of the season. Cincinnati had a quicker match on Nov. 2 against Georgetown, registering a 3-0 sweep. The Bearcats used a .391 hitting percentage to their advantage as the Hoyas were held to just a .186 mark.

◆**CONNECTICUT:** With a pair of BIG EAST wins over the weekend, the Huskies improve to 7-3 in league play. No Connecticut players reached double figures in kills as they used a team effort to overcome Seton Hall 3-0 on Oct. 31. Junior Chauntay Mickens registered 14 kills in UConn's 3-0 sweep over Villanova on Nov. 2. Freshman Annie Luhrsen was the match leader in assists with 34.

◆**DE PAUL:** The Blue Demons played two five-set matches last week and split their effort. DePaul picked up a 3-2 victory over Marquette Nov. 1, but fell to Syracuse 3-2 on Nov. 2. The win was the Blue Demons' first over Marquette since 2001. For the week, junior Sarah Cullen paced the squad with 3.70 kills per set and 3.00 digs per set. The Blue Demons break from league action Nov. 4 when they host Valparaiso before heading to Rutgers on Nov. 7.

◆**GEORGETOWN:** The Hoyas faced two 3-0 losses to Louisville and Cincinnati last weekend, bringing their record in BIG EAST play to 5-5. Junior Jessica Hardy led the Hoyas against the Cardinals on Oct. 31 with 12 kills and nine digs. Senior Katherine Niesen had 11 kills and hit .588, but Georgetown could not overcome Cincinnati on Nov. 2.

◆**LOUISVILLE:** The Cardinals continued to be a force in BIG EAST play with two wins over the weekend. Despite a 12-10 overall record, Louisville stands at 8-3 in league play for third place in the BIG EAST standings. The Cardinals made quick work of both Georgetown and USF with 3-0 sweeps. Senior Jana Matiasovska had 16 kills, three aces and a block to lead Louisville past the Bulls on Nov. 2.

◆**MARQUETTE:** After a tough 3-2 loss to DePaul on Nov. 1, the Golden Eagles bounced back against Notre Dame with a 3-2 win of their own on Nov. 2. Senior Ashlee Fisher was one of four Marquette strikers with double-digit kills against the Irish, leading the group with 19.

◆**NOTRE DAME:** Needing five sets to secure a win over Syracuse for the first time since 1990, Notre Dame prevailed over the Orange with a 3-2 victory on Nov. 1. The Fighting Irish posted a .377 hitting percentage to set a school record for a five-set match. The Irish attack was directed by junior Jamel Nicholas with a career-high 68 assists. Playing in its second five-set match of the weekend, Notre Dame stumbled 3-2 versus Marquette on Nov. 2. Junior Serinity Phillips narrowly missed out on notching Notre Dame's first triple-double since 2004, finishing with 25 kills, 10 digs and a career-high nine blocks.

◆**PITTSBURGH:** With only one match all last week, the Panthers held their spot in the top half of the BIG EAST standings with a 3-1 win against Rutgers on Nov. 1. Pittsburgh improved to 7-3 in league play, as senior Kelly Campbell posted a double-double with 14 kills and 10 digs.

◆**RUTGERS:** The Scarlet Knights earned their first BIG EAST win of the season by dealing West Virginia a 3-1 defeat on Nov. 2. Rutgers suffered a 3-1 loss on Nov. 1 to Pittsburgh. Freshman Hannah Curtis was the Scarlet Knights' kills leader with 20 against the Mountaineers.

◆**ST. JOHN'S:** The Red Storm remained strong this weekend, picking up a pair of 3-1 victories over Villanova and Seton Hall at home to extend its winning streak to seven matches. St. John's has won 13 of its last 14 matches and remains atop the BIG EAST standings with a 9-1 record in league play. Senior Valeria Kovaleva tallied a double-double on Nov. 1 against the Wildcats with a career-high 21 kills to go along with 13 digs. Senior Lena Yee became the first Red Storm player to surpass the 2,000 career dig mark, picking up 28 on Nov. 1 before reaching the milestone with 12 on Nov. 2.

◆**SETON HALL:** The Pirates went 0-2 over the weekend, losing 3-0 at Connecticut Oct. 31 and 3-1 at St. John's on Nov. 2. Seton Hall's road struggles continued as they fell to 1-9 away from Walsh Gymnasium. Senior Brittany Rahrer broke the Pirates' career assist record against the Red Storm in the second set. She has 4,600 assists in her three-plus seasons with the Pirates.

◆**USF:** The Bulls surrendered a 2-1 lead to Cincinnati, as the Bearcats rallied at home to take a 3-2 win on Oct. 31. USF traveled to Louisville Nov. 2, losing to the Cardinals 3-0. The Bulls were close in the first set, losing only 25-23, but dropped the next two sets by the same 25-18 score.

◆**SYRACUSE:** The Orange had their nine-match road winning streak snapped at Notre Dame with a 3-2 setback on Nov. 1. Although Syracuse was pushed to a five-set match, the Orange claimed a victory at DePaul 3-2 on Nov. 2. Junior Sarah Morton paced Syracuse with 12 kills and 10 total blocks.

◆**VILLANOVA:** The Wildcats went 0-2 last weekend, dropping matches to St. John's and Connecticut. The Wildcats got their best individual performance of the weekend from senior Dana Tartazky who had 16 kills and six digs in the 3-1 loss to the Red Storm on Nov. 1.

◆**WEST VIRGINIA:** The Mountaineers faced nonconference foe St. Francis (Pa.) on Oct. 31, registering a 3-0 win on the road. Junior Abby Raines struck double-digit kills with 10 and added eight digs. West Virginia was not as fortunate at Rutgers, losing 3-1 with no players accumulating more than nine kills. Freshman Kari Post was a highlight in the Mountaineers' loss with 34 assists and 15 digs.

The 2008 BIG EAST Volleyball Championship will be conducted Nov. 21 - 23 in Pittsburgh, Pa. The single-elimination tournament will include eight of the league's 15 teams. The top eight teams, based on regular season conference records will qualify for the event and will be seeded according to their finish in the league standings. The 26th annual championship will be hosted by the University of Pittsburgh at the Fitzgerald Field House, and ESPNU will air the championship game live on Nov. 23. The champion receives the league's automatic bid to the 64-team NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship.
