# History

The Marshall University baseball program is entering its 101st season this year. In the first recorded game in school history, in 1896, the Marshall College team defeated a team from Huntington Business College, 17-8, on May 14 and baseball was up and running.

Overall, the Thundering Herd baseball team has compiled a 1,132-1,221-11 mark, a winning percentage of .484.

Marshall's first coach came on board for the 1901 season when Professor M.M. Scott led the squad for two seasons. It was not until 1910, however, when Boyd Chambers, a Marshall College graduate, took over that the program had any stability. He coached football, baseball and even basketball for a few seasons from 1909-1917. He was followed by eight coaches in the next nine years.

In 1927, Johnny "Blood" Stuart, a Marshall assistant football coach who had played professionally in the St. Louis Cardinals organization, took over the baseball program and in six seasons won 67 games and four conference championships in the West Virginia Collegiate Conference (today's WVIAC). The conference had been formed by Marshall President Morris Shawkey and other college presidents from around the state to give some direction to their athletic programs.

In 1931, Stuart's team went 11-1-1 and won their fourth consecutive league title. During the four-year run, the team had gone 50-10-1, including 7-2 versus West Virginia University. In 1933 when Stuart left, Athletic Director and WVU Hall of Famer Roy "Legs" Hawley took over and in three seasons set a standard unmatched in Marshall baseball history.

Hawley's teams won three consecutive Buckeye Conference Championships (the Herd was in the league 1933-38) and went 30-5 during this period, a .857 winning percentage, which is still a school record.

Hawley was hired as the Athletic Director at WVU following the 1935 season.

The Marshall baseball team stumbled through the next 13 years with five coaches and no baseball played at all in 1939-41, and 1944-46. Joe Binn would step in for the 1947 season and then ran things in 1948-49 and once again in 1952 after Howard Hood stepped down in 1951 after two seasons.

In 1955, a young man, who was coaching at Huntington High after getting both his bachelor (1952) and graduate (1953) degrees from Marshall, was given the chance to coach the Marshall team on a one-year, interim, basis. Jack Cook, captain for the Herd in 1949, lost a chance to play in the St. Louis Browns organization to fight in the Korean War, and went only 2-11 in that first season.

Cook returned to Marshall in 1967 after stints by Bill Chambers, Alvis Brown and Bob Kruthoffer to become the school's first full-time baseball coach. In the next 23 seasons, Cook won 420 more games to be the school's all-time winningest single-sport coach. His 24 season totals were 422-344-3, a .551 winning percentage.

Cook won two Southern Conference titles (1978 and 1981) and led the Herd to two NCAA tournament appearances: 1973 (18-10) and 1978, which saw the Herd come within one win of advancing to the College World Series. The Herd defeated both Florida State and Clemson to advance to the finals before losing twice to the Miami Hurricanes. Marshall finished 27-13, with 27 wins being a school record.

Following his retirement in 1989, the Jack Cook Most Valuable Player Award was started in his honor. Howard McCann replaced Cook and coached from 1990-95. Craig Antush took over for McCann and coached from the 1996 season through the 1998 season. Former assistant coach and Marshall baseball standout Dave Piepenbrink then took the responsibility of

returning the Thundering Herd program to its former glory. 2004 marked the first time that the Herd had posted consecutive double digit conference win season since returning to the MAC. The team also tied the all-time win record of 27, which was set in 1978.

The program took another step forward last season as Marshall University entered Conference USA, widely recognized as one of the premier baseball leagues in the nation. This year, the Herd enters a new era as Jeff Waggoner takes the reigns of the program.
