Thundering Herd Notes

Marshall vs. Tulane: Marshall leads the all-time series with the Green Wave, 3-0. The Thundering Herd picked up a 31-10 win over Tulane last season at the Louisiana Superdome and in Tulane's only visit to Huntington, back in 2006, Marshall managed a 42-21 victory. The team's first meeting was moved from New Orleans to Mobile, Ala., due to Hurricane Katrina and Marshall escaped that series opener with a 27-26 win at Ladd Peebles Stadium, home of the GMAC Bowl.

Senior Day: Marshall will honor the 2010 senior class prior to the final game at Joan C. Edwards Stadium on Saturday against Tulane. The class includes 19 seniors – Brian Anderson, Mark Cann, Pete Culicerto, Courtney Edmonson, Mario Harvey, Michael Janac, Johnny Jones, Howard King, Cody Ochoa, Kevin Perry, Landis Provanca, Chad Schofield, Lee Smith, Press Taylor, Demetrius Thompson, Tavaris Thompson, Erik Vint, Chuck Walker and D.J. Wingate.

Super Mario: Marshall features one of the nation's top linebackers in senior Mario Harvey. The preseason All-Conference USA pick was one of only 15 semi-finalists for the Butkus Award. He was also named to Phil Steele's Midseason All-America fourth-team. This summer the standout linebacker turned heads when he recorded the second faster 40-yard dash time on the team at 4.35 seconds - very impressive considering Harvey is a six-foot, 247-pound linebacker. He currently has 122 tackles, 14.5 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks. He is currently tied for 7th in the nation in tackles for game with 11.5 per game. With one more tackle he will become only the 8th player in school history to reach the 400-tackle mark for a career.

Anderson Moving Up MU Career Charts: Marshall senior quarterback Brian Anderson now ranks ninth all-time at Marshall in career passing yards list with 5,241, ahead of Stan Hill's 4,711 career passing yards from 2001-04 and behind Bernard Morris' 5,616 yards from 2004-07. Anderson also has 35 career TD passes and is now tied for ninth all-time at Marshall, ahead of Morris' 31 career TD tosses, and tied Eric Kresser (35 TDs in 1996). Anderson needs three touchdown passes against Tulane to match Hill's 38 career TD passes that rank 8th.

Youth Movement: Marshall has played 12 true freshmen and 28 redshirt and true freshmen in 2010. Those figures rank among this

highest in the nation this season. True Freshmen Trevor Black, Zach Dunston, Demetrius Evans, Gator Hoskins, Jermaine Kelson, Tron Martinez, Darryl Roberts, T.J. Ross, Jeremiah Taylor, Garrett Scott, Brandon Sparrow and Eddie Sullivan have all season game action thus far.

Vinny Gets it Done: Thundering Herd junior defensive end Vinny Curry is having a great year with 89 total tackles, 16 tackles for loss and a C-USA leading 11.5 sacks. He was selected to SI.com's Midseason All-America First-Team and was named to Phil Steele's Midseason All-America squad as a third team selection. He currently ranks third in the nation in total sacks with 11.5.

Mr. Smith: Senior Lee Smith is an imposing six-foot-six, 267-pound tight end that is well known for not only his tremendous blocking ability, but his pass catching skills. Smith has been somewhat overshadowed the last two seasons by MU's all-time pass catching leader at tight end – Cody Slate who completed his career last season as a Mackey Award Semifinalist. Despite this, Smith was still voted by his teammates as a team captain a year ago and he earned 10 starts. When Slate was lost to an ACL injury with three games to go, Smith stepped up his role in the receiving game and proved to be a dangerous pass catching threat as well with 23 catches for 335 receiving yards. He earned honorable mention all-conference honors last season and he entered 2010 as the C-USA coaches preseason all-conference selection at tight end. He was named Marshall's prestigious Cam Henderson Scholar for 2010 and has also been nominated for the Allstate Good Works Team for his community service, academic success and athletic achievement. He was also one of 32 tight ends on the preseason John Mackey Award watch list. He and his wife Alisha also are the proud parents of two small children - Brody (2) and Amanda who was born this summer.

Tough Road: Marshall played seven consecutive opponents that advanced to a bowl game last year to start the season. The Thundering Herd opened the season with games at #2 Ohio State, vs #23 West Virginia, at Bowling Green, vs. Ohio, at Southern Miss, vs. UCF and at ECU.

0-For-Texas: Marshall has yet to win a football game in the state of Texas. The Thundering Herd is now 0-7 all-time in games played in the Lonestar State and that total includes losses at UTEP in 2005 and 2009, the 2006 and 2010 losses at SMU, a loss at Rice in 2008, a loss at Houston in 2007. Marshall also lost the 2004 Fort Worth Bowl, in a game played at TCU, to Cincinnati. Interestingly enough, Marshall has never lost to a school from Texas at home. The Thundering Herd is a perfect 7-0 against Texas schools in games played in Huntington. Marshall owns a win over North Texas (1988), a win over Houston (2008), a win over Rice (2007), two wins over SMU (2005 and 2009) and a pair of wins over UTEP (2006 and 2010).

Jackson Picks Two: Marshall's Rashad Jackson recorded two second-half interceptions in the loss at SMU - the first two of his collegiate career. The Marshall junior cornerback is the son of former New Orleans Saint great and Pro Football Hall of Famer Rickey Jackson.

What Can Brown Do For You?: Marshall's secondary is anchored by safeties Omar Brown and Donald Brown (no relation). Omar, a team captain, is third on the team in tackles with 78 and he has an interception on the year. Donald is the team leader in INTs with three and ranks fourth in tackles with 64.

Dobson Produces: Marshall sophomore receiver Aaron Dobson has shown flashes of great potential this season. Dobson had five catches for 119 yards and two scores against UCF and two of his catches were part of ESPN's Top Ten Plays for Oct. 14. In the play ranked No. 3 by ESPN, Dobson makes a juggling catch along the sideline. In the other, judged the top play of the day, Dobson leaps over a UCF defender for a 12-yard touchdown. He also caught an 86-yard touchdown pass, scoring both of his teams TDs. Earlier this year, Dobson was on the receiving end of a 96-yard touchdown pass against West Virginia - that play was the second longest pass play in school history. Dobson is Marshall's leading receiver with 44 catches for 689 yards and five touchdowns. He averages 15.7 yards per catch.

The Doc is in: Marshall University will enter the 2010 season under new leadership. Doc Holliday took over as Marshall's 29th head football coach on Dec. 17 of 2009. Holliday, a Hurricane W.Va. native, is widely regarded as one of the top recruiters in the nation and he brings with him 31 years of collegiate coaching experience to Marshall that includes stops at Florida, N.C. State and West Virginia.

Marshall's New Coaching Staff : Doc Holliday has put together a very impressive coaching staff at Marshall. Holliday has brought in veterans Bill Legg (Offensive Coordinator) and Tony Petersen (Co-Off. Coordinator and Assistant Head Coach) to oversee the offense and Chris Rippon (Defensive Coordinator) to oversee the defense. Holliday also brought in veteran Fred Tate to coach safeties, while retaining secondary coach Mike Cassity and tight ends coach Phil Ratliff. The Marshall coaching staff also features several young coaches in Sean Cronin (defensive line), Zach Smith (WRs) and JaJuan Seider (Recruiting Coord./RBs). Holliday also brought in strength and conditioning coach Frank Piraino from the University of Florida.

Heres Johnny: Marshall senior defensive lineman Johnny Jones has a knack for blocking kicks. So far this season, he has a field goal block at #2 Ohio State that teammate Ahmed Shakoor returned for a touchdown and another field goal block against #22 West Virginia. He now has six career field goal or PAT kick blocks.

Freshmen Get INTs in First Starts: Marshall redshirt-freshman corner Monterious Lovett became the fourth different corner back to start this season for Marshall and responded with an interception, two pass break ups and four tackles. He started opposite true freshman Darryl Roberts who recorded an interception in his first start, just a week before at Bowling Green.

Stadium Upgrades Debut: Marshall's Joan C. Edwards Stadium features two new state-of-the-art Daktronics video boards for the 2010 season. In addition, the stadium sound system has been replaced and new ribbon video displays are installed on the Shewey Athletic Center. The total cost of the new upgrades are estimated at \$3 million and all of the upgrades made their debut in the home opener against West Virginia University.

Troy Brown: Hall of Famer: Marshall's Troy Brown entered the College Football Hall of Fame this summer. The standout all-purpose star led Marshall to a National Championship in 1992 and went on to a tremendous NFL career with the New England Patriots. Brown won three Super Bowls and played in two others. He was honored with an on-field salute during the West Virginia game. Brown is the fifth Marshall player or coach to be enshrined in the Hall of Fame.

We Remember - 40th Anniversary of the Marshall Plane Crash: Sunday, November 14th, was the 40th anniversary of the worst sports-related disaster in American history - the 1970 Marshall Plane Crash. A chartered DC-9 carrying the MU Football team back from a 17-14 loss at East Carolina fell short of the runway on its return to Tri-State airport taking the lives of all 75 persons on board. Every Nov. 14th the Marshall community gathers for a memorial service at the Memorial Fountain in the center of the Marshall campus to remember those lost in the tragedy. During the ceremony the water that flows through the fountain is turned off for the winter. The tragedy and Marshall's commitment to continue its football program was the focus of the 2006 Warner Bros. movie "We Are Marshall" and an award-winning documentary called "Ashes to Glory."

Marshall vs Ranked Opponents

Since moving to Division I-A (FBS) in 1997, the Herd has enjoyed a pair of landmark victories against nationally-ranked opponents. Honoring West Virginia's Fallen Miners: Marshall's football team will wear a memorial helmet sticker in every football game this season to honor the 29 coal miners that were lost in the Upper Big Branch Mine disaster in April. The helmet sticker features the dark outline of a coal miner with number 29 in white.

White Helmet Returns: Marshall's football team will wear white helmets in 2010 with the Marshall's official Block M insignia on both sides. The helmets replace a reverse color scheme that was utilized in the 2009 season.

The Thundering Herd Captains: The Thundering Herd elected #16 Lee Smith (senior tight end), #12 Brian Anderson (senior quarterback), #30 Mario Harvey (senior linebacker), and #31 Omar Brown as the 2010 team captains. Smith and Harvey both served as captains last season and were both selected to the 2010 All-Conference USA Preseason First-Team by the league's head coaches.

Academic Success: The Marshall football team posted a combined 2.63 grade point average this spring, up from a combined 2.1 GPA from the fall semester of 2009. The combined 2.63 GPA is the highest football team GPA in any single semester at Marshall in the 20 years that the Buck Harless Student Athlete Program has tracked team GPAs. In addition to this Marshall will have seven football players suiting up this year that have already earned their undergraduate degrees. They are - Brandon Campbell (working on second undergraduate degree in economics), Pete Culicerto (working on an MBA), Courtney Edmonson (working on second undergraduate degree in management), Mario Harvey (working on a second undergraduate degree), Kevin Perry (working on graduate degree), Erik Vint (working on masters in chemistry - holds two undergraduate degrees in biology and chemistry), and D.J. Wingate (working on second degree in management).

AFCA Honorable Mention Academic Award: Marshall was one of 41 schools recognized by the American Football Coaches Association in 2009 for graduating 75% or more of its football student-athletes. THE LAST MEETING... Marshall Downs Tulane, 31-10

(Oct. 10, 2009)

NEW ORLEANS - Brian Anderson completed 18-of-22 passes for 207 yards as the Marshall University football team downed Tulane, 31-10, at the Louisiana Superdome.

Anderson completed his first seven pass attempts of the game for the Thundering Herd (4-2, 2-1 C-USA), who improved to 3-0 all-time against Tulane (2-3, 0-2 C-USA). Junior running back Darius Marshall, held to a season-low 98 yards, made his presence known, scoring two touchdowns for the Herd.

Despite Tulane holding onto the ball for over 20 minutes in the first half, Marshall held a decided advantage on the scoreboard, taking a 21-7 lead into the locker room at the half.

Each team scored on its opening possession of the game. The Green Wave took the opening kickoff eight plays and 67 yards into the endzone as Jordan Sullen scored on a 32-yard run. Less than three minutes later, the Herd knotted the score at 7-7 as Darius Marshall rushed for his conference-leading eighth touchdown of the season. That play capped off a 44-yard drive, which was set up by a failed onside kick attempt by Tulane.

Following a three-and-out by each team, the Herd punted the ball to the Green Wave with 5:17 left in the first quarter. Little did it know that it would be another 15:35 of playing time before its offense would step foot back on the field. Tulane received the punt at its own 7-yard line.

After moving the ball 44 yards to the Marshall 49, the Herd defense made its first big statement. John Youboty sacked Tulane QB Joe Kemp for a loss of six and on the next play, Albert McClellan forced Jeremy Williams to fumble. The ball was picked up by Ashton Hall, who ran in for the score to give MU its first lead of the game.

On the ensuing drive, the Green Wave offense once again moved the ball, going 81 yards over 19 plays to the one yard line, but the Herd defense stood tall once again, stuffing Tulane on third and fourth down at the one to turn the ball back over to the Herd. That marked the first time in over a quarter that the MU offense touched the ball.

The offense took full advantage of the rest, marching the ball 99 yards over the next four minutes to go up 21-7. Anderson completed 5 out of 6 passes for 93 yards on the drive. That capped off a strong first half for the junior, who completed his first seven passes of the game before finishing the half 10-of-11 for 126 yards and a touchdown.

Marshall added to its lead in the second half. Craig Ratanamorn connected on a 32-yard field goal in the third quarter, the only score of that period, to remain perfect on the season. He has made his first seven attempts of 2009 and has made all 16 extra point attempts.

Early in the fourth quarter, Marshall found the endzone for the second time in the game. Following a Brandon Burns interception, which gave the Herd the ball at the Tulane 5-yard line, the junior scored on the first play of the drive to put MU up 31-7. Tulane added a field goal in the fourth to cut the deficit to 31-10.

Anderson had his top effort of the year, finishing the game with 207 yards through the air. Tulane starting quarterback Joe Kemp completed 14-of-23 passes for 116 yards. He was replaced in the second half by Ryan Griffin, who was 7-12 with 73 yards.

Darius Marshall was the leading rusher in the contest, gaining 98 yards on 20 carries. Andrew Anderson led Tulane with 92 yards on the ground.

Antavious Wilson led all receivers with 65 receiving yards. He caught six Anderson passes. Jeremy Williams of Tulane led all players with eight receptions. He finished the day with 53 yards.

Tulane finished with an advantage in total offense, gaining 404 yards while holding Marshall to 323, but turnovers played a big role. The Herd forced four Green Wave turnovers while Tulane intercepted one Anderson pass, which slipped through the hands of Cody Slate.



Doc Holliday Head Coach - First Season

Marshall University Director of Athletics Mike Hamrick introduced Doc Holliday as the Thundering Herd's 29th head football coach on December 17, 2009.

Holliday, a Hurricane W.Va. native, is widely regarded as one of the top recruiters in the nation and he brings with him 31 years of collegiate coaching experience to Marshall that includes stops at Florida, N.C. State and West Virginia.

"This was an extensive search. I looked at a lot of head coaches, coordinators and others and I could not convince myself of anyone that was better for this job than Doc Holliday," Hamrick said. "He is a state native that understands and has a passion for this state and I am excited to have him as our head football coach."

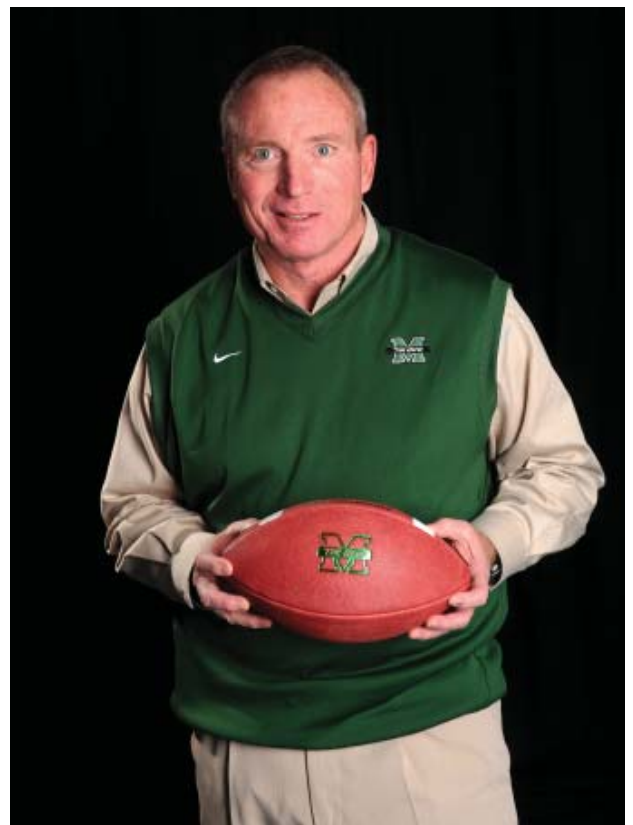
During his coaching career, Holliday has coached in 20 bowl games, three national championship games and coached 11 players that have gone on to the National Football League. He has also coached four All-Americans and 16 student-athletes that have earned all-conference or All-East honors.

"My ultimate goal has always been to be a Division I head football coach at a major university and to have this opportunity at Marshall, a school rich in tradition and full of potential, is a dream come true," Holliday said.

Holliday comes to Marshall after serving as associate head coach at West Virginia for the past two seasons where he also served as the director of recruiting while coaching tight ends and fullbacks for the Mountaineers. Rivals.com has named him one of the Top 25 recruiters in the nation and he helped WVU amass a 2009 recruiting class that was nationally ranked No. 22 by Scout.com and No. 27 by Rivals.com.

Prior to that, he worked as the associate head coach and safeties coach at the University of Florida from 2005 to 2007 and as the associate head coach and wide receivers coach at North Carolina State University from 2000-04. During his tenure at Florida, the Gators won the 2006 National Championship and the UF secondary led the SEC in interceptions in both 2005 and 2006. He also coached two All-SEC standouts Reggie Nelson and Major Wright. At N.C. State, he coached three of the top eight receivers in Wolfpack history (Koren Robinson, Bryan Peterson and Jerricho Cotchery) and the 2003 N.C. State team set six different school-records for passing including yards, yards per game, passing touchdowns and completion percentage.

He started his coaching career as a graduate assistant in 1979 and went on to serve in a variety of coaching positions at his alma mater that included serving as the wide receivers coach from 1983-1989 and again from 1993-1999, the inside linebackers coach from 1990-92 and as the assistant head coach from 1995-99. Holliday was a three-year letter-winner at linebacker at West Virginia (1976-78) and has earned both a bachelor's degree (1979) and a master's degree (1981) from WVU. He and his wife Diana have four children - Meghan, Cade, Chase and Cody.
