Head Coach **BOB GRAY** has over 30 years of experience as a collegiate head coach, including 17 seasons at the helm of the **Thundering Herd**. Gray sports an impressive 411-223-47 all-time record and stands fifth in wins (411) and 20th in winning percentage (.642) among current coaches. All-time, he is in the top-50 for most wins and highest winning percentage. In addition, Gray serves as the West Virginia State Director of Coaching and is the chairman of the player selection committee for the MLS Player Combine.
