## NORTHEAST-10 MEN'S TRACK ATHLETE OF THE WEEK



**Donte Brown, UMass Lowell** (Jr., Raynham, Mass.) - Provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championship in both the 400 meter dash and the 4X400 meter relay at the Boston University Terrier Invitational. Placed fourth overall (first among Division II-III sprinters) in the 400 in 47.94 seconds. Also ran a 49.03-second leg on the 4X400 meter relay team, which placed second overall and tops among collegiate teams in 3:15.64, currently No. 2 on the Division II list.

## NORTHEAST-10 WOMEN'S TRACK ATHLETE OF THE WEEK



**Haley Catarius, UMass Lowell** (Sr., Marshfield, Mass.) - Provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championship in both the 800 meters and the 4X400 meter relay at the Boston University Terrier Invitational. Placed fifth overall and second among collegiate runners in the 800 meters with a time of 2:13.35, currently the second-fastest time in the country. Also ran a 57.2-second split on the 4X400 relay team which placed fourth (first among Division II-III foursomes) in 3:54.75, currently eighth on the Division II list.

## NORTHEAST-10 MEN'S TRACK FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Evan White, UMass Lowell** (Fr., Tewksbury, Mass.) - Defeated all collegiate runners, eclipsed the school record and placed third overall in the 200 meter dash at the Boston University Terrier Invitational with a time of 21.63 seconds. Virtually solidified his place at the NCAA Championship with the third-fastest time in the country.

## NORTHEAST-10 WOMEN'S TRACK FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Erin Carmone, Stonehill** (Fr., Riverside, R.I.) - Led Stonehill at Friday's Reebok Boston Collegiate Indoor Games with a fifth-place finish out of 50 competitors in the 3000-meter run with a time of 10:12.95.

## NORTHEAST-10 MEN'S FIELD ATHLETE AND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Corey Thomas, Stonehill** (Fr., Brookline, Mass.) - Highlighted Stonehill's sixth-place finish (out of 18 teams) at Friday's Reebok Boston Indoor Collegiate Games by winning the high jump with a program-record and NCAA Division II Championship automatic qualifying jump of 7'1" (2.16m) - the highest leap in all of Division II so far this season. The jump bettered his previous school record (6'9") set the previous weekend at the Wheaton Invitational. Thomas also bettered his school-record and NCAA Championship provisional qualifying time in the 55-meter high hurdles with a run of 7.66-seconds in the preliminaries. He would later finish third in the final with a time of 7.74. Thomas was also a part of Stonehill's 4x400-meter relay team that finished ninth with a time of 3:33.34

**Jacqui Barrett, UMass Lowell** (Sr., Woburn, Mass.) - Placed second in the shot put and eclipsed her personal-best throw for the fourth time this season with a distance of 47 feet, 5.75 inches. The effort currently ranks fourth on the NCAA Division II list this season.

## 2009-2010 NORTHEAST-10 INDOOR TRACK & FIELD WEEKLY INFORMATION



**ADELPHI:** The Adelphi University track and field team had the weekend off, but will return to competition at the New Balance Collegiate Invitational on Friday and Saturday, February 5 and 6 at the Armory Track and Field Center.



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: MEN:** Junior Emile Barnett provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships and set school records in the 800-meter run and as a member of the distance medley relay team at Boston University's Terrier Invitational Saturday. Barnett placed 11th in the 800 with a school record time of 1:53.47 and placed third as a member of the distance medley relay team, along with junior Maurice Calenda, sophomore Victor Kemboi and freshman Julien Devanne, with school record time of 10:04.21. Freshman Emmanuel Jean placed ninth in the 400-meter dash with a school-record and NCAA provisional qualifying time of 48.63 seconds and finished 16th in the 200-meter dash with a time of 22.40 seconds, while classmate Noel James won the high jump with an NCAA provisional qualifying mark of 2.07 meters. Calenda was the runner-up in the long jump with a leap of 6.86 meters and placed fourth in the triple jump with a mark of 13.71 meters. Freshman Terrance Worlds finished 14th in the 200-meter dash with a time of 22.21 seconds and junior Jared Torres finished 13th in the 500-meter dash with a time of 1:07.13. Junior Justin Roberts (Sutton, Mass.) placed 14th at Harvard University's Multi Meet, which also featured two-time Olympic medalist Brian Clay, scoring 4,014 points in the heptathlon. Freshman Anthony Hatwood also competed at Harvard. Roberts' height of 3.65 meters in the pole vault tied his own school record. Hatwood was the runner-up in the high jump after clearing 1.97 meters, with Clay's mark of 2.00 meters being the enough for first and finished sixth in the long jump at 6.56 meters. **WOMEN:** Sophomore Bidemi Balogun placed fourth in the weight throw with a provisional qualifying mark of 16.77 meters as the American International College women's track & field team competed at Boston University's Terrier Invitational Saturday. Freshman Starr Nathan topped her own school records in the 200- and 400-meter dash. She placed 13th in the 200 with a time of 25.82 seconds and was 16th in the 400 after clocking in at 59.01 seconds. Freshman Ashley Aupont finished 17th in the 55-meter hurdles with a time of 8.96 seconds and was 12th in the high jump at 1.57 meters. Sophomore Julie Collignon finished 55th in the mile run with a time of 5:26.21, while junior Sarah Beaudoin finished 61st with a time of 5:30.95. Senior Olivia Thibou finished sixth in the triple jump with a leap of 11.29 meters, while freshman Darsel Springer finished 20th with a mark of 9.58 meters. Freshman Sanya Foster finished 20th in the shot put with a throw of 11.12 meters.



**ASSUMPTION:** Freshman Molly Kessler (Hopkinton, MA/Hopkinton), set the team indoor mark in the 800-meter event (2:22.69). Senior sprinter Bernard Scott (St. Petersburg, FL/Farragut) was the men's individual standout for the Hounds at the Terrier Classic Saturday. The premier sprinter in Hounds history, was third in the event with 6.49 time just 0.2 seconds off his team-record time set two years ago at the Smith Invitational (2/9/08). The Greyhounds are next in action at the Smith Invitational Saturday



**BENTLEY:** Sophomore Mike Vatti (Easton, Pa.) accounted for 13 of Bentley's 16 points during the Reebok Boston Indoor Games (collegiate division) with a victory in the 400 meters and a sixth-place finish in the 200. During the weekend, Bentley's best performances of the season were recorded in the 800 (Dan Fava, 1:59.17), the 5000 (Rob Dextradeur, 15:13.35), the 55 meter hurdles (Tim Walant, 8.36) and the shot put (Steven Long, 45'10.75") on the men's side, and the 500 (Amy Varsell, 1:18.98), the 1000 (Caitlin Fahey, 3:02.34), the 3000 (Evelyn Marrero, 10:57.22) and the triple jump (Keisha Johnson, 34'10.5") on the women's. Of those eight, all but Walant are either freshmen or sophomores. During the Boston Indoor Games, Varsell moved to number three on Bentley's all-time list in the 500, Fahey went to number six in school history in the 1000, and Long bettered his PR in the shot by over two feet. Dextradeur improved on his PR in the 5000 by 19 seconds while competing in the BU Terrier Invitational Saturday.



**UMASS LOWELL:** Six UMass Lowell athletes and two relay teams provisionally qualified or bettered their standing for the NCAA Championship Saturday at the Boston University Terrier Invitational. Five athletes and the men's 4X400 meter relay team currently rank among the top four results in the country thus far: Haley Catarius (800 meters, 2nd/2:13.35), Angus MacDonald (mile, 2nd/4:07.92), Evan White (200 meters, 2nd/21.63), Jacqui Barrett (shot put, 4th/47' 5.75"), Donte Brown (400 meters, 3rd/47.94) and the men's 4X400 (2nd/3:15.64), made up of Brown, Jeff Wundt, Craig Bennett and Robert Liekweg. UMass Lowell's women's 4X400 team currently ranks eighth in the country (3:54.75) while shotputter Cory Murray ranks 15th (53' 9.0").



**SAINT ROSE:** The Saint Rose men's track and field team finished tied for second among 17 competing schools and women's squad wound up 12th in a field of 16 teams at the Class of '32 Invitational that was hosted by Colgate University Saturday. Saint Rose bettered four school standards throughout the day. Seniors Kevin Jackson (Schenectady, NY/Schenectady), Tyler Gantz (Rosendale, NY/Rondout Valley), and Jeremy Chapline (Queensbury, NY/Queensbury) all had record setting performances as did sophomore Ryan Saunders (Cambridge, NY/Cambridge). Jackson broke the tape in a school record 22.64 in the 200 meter dash. Saunders was second in the 60m dash with a school record time of 7.15. Gantz snapped a 16-year-old standard with a third place clocking of 2:31.91 in the 1,000m run, while Chapline took seventh in both the shot put and the 35 pound weight throw. He heaved the latter a school record 13.78m to snap a 14-year-old mark.

**STONEHILL: MEN:** Stonehill placed 6th out of 18 teams at Friday's Reebok Boston Indoor Collegiate Games. Freshman Corey Thomas (Brookline, Mass.) highlighted the event once again for Stonehill as he won the high jump with a program-record and NCAA Division II Championship automatic qualifying jump of 7'1" (2.16m) - the highest leap in all of Division II so far this season. The jump bettered his previous school record set of 6'9.48". Senior Joseph D'Agostino (Canton, Mass.) placed second right behind Thomas at 6'8" (2.03m) - just .01 shy of provisionally qualifying for the NCAA Championships - as the Skyhawk duo were the only two high jumpers at the event to clear 2.0-meters. Thomas bettered his school-record and NCAA Championship provisional qualifying time in the 55-meter high hurdles with his time of 7.66-seconds in the preliminaries. Junior Daniel Pilz (Newington, Conn.) placed second out of 31 runners in the 1000-meter run with a time of 2:29.49. He was also part of Stonehill's Distance Medley relay team that finished fourth in 10:27.46. Freshman Sean Hanlon (Georgetown, Mass.) also finished fourth in the 1000-meters with a time of 2:31.54. Sophomore Stephen Polito (Worcester, Mass.) placed ninth out of 52 runners in the 5000-meter run in 15:15.94. **WOMEN:** The Stonehill women placed 14th at Friday's Reebok Boston Indoor Collegiate Games. Freshman Erin Carmone (Riverside, R.I.), an All-American in cross country in her first collegiate season, placed fifth out of 50 competitors in the 3000-meter run with a time of 10:12.95. Junior Lindsey Pinkham (Skowhegan, Maine) took tenth out of 45 runners in the 800-meters with a time of 2:20.88. The Stonehill men and women are back in action on Saturday at the Tufts Stampede.
