CLINIC STAFF

Sean Cotter—Head Coach, UMass Lowell

Cotter begins his third year at UMass Lowell after spending the last 10 years at Plattsburgh State. Cotter is a program builder who has helped set the school record for wins in a season within the first two years of every program he has coached. He took over for the UMass Lowell squad with a prior record of 10-31-1 in 2009 and helped them more than doubled the win total in 2010. At Plattsburgh State, he started the softball program and in his teams 7th year of existence, was a win away from playing for a National Championship..

Emily Friedman—Assistant Coach, Fordham University

Friedman is the owner of Gloveworks. She was an coach at Fordham University for 3 seasons

where she helped the Rams break every offensive and defensive record possible and reach many unprecedented milestones including the program's first ever Atlantic 10 Championship and two Mid-Atlantic Regional Coaching Staff of the Year selections in 2010 and 2011. Friedman competed for the University of California-Berkeley, and also played professionally for the Philadelphia Force and the Chicago Bandits. During her time with the Force she was selected as the only professional player to date to the NPF All-Star team as both an infielder (2008) and outfielder (2010).

Danielle Mason—Pitching Coach, UMass Lowell, Head Coach, Pentucket High School

Mason begins her third year as the Pitching Coach at UMass Lowell after spending one season at Wellesley College and a stellar career at Stonehill College. During her time at Lowell, she has helped mentor Elyssa Boris, who was named the Player of the Year in the Northeast-10 Conference in 2011. At Stonehill, Mason remains among the school's all-time leaders in wins (25) and ranks among NE-10 leaders in wins (11th) and maintained a 3.71 ERA with 54 strikeouts over 102 innings.

Casey Price—Head Coach, Oswego State

Price begins her second year at Oswego State. Before coaching at Oswego, Price was a volunteer assistant pitching coach at Plattsburgh from 1999-2010. While at Plattsburgh, she also served as the Varsity softball coach at Baldwinsville Central, where she earned a Coach of the Year Award in 2000. She competed collegiately at the University of Oklahoma from 1987-89. She was named to the Freshmen Fall Softball Athlete of the Year at Oklahoma.

Cheryl Mulligan—Head Coach Tufts University

Mulligan begins her ninth season at Tufts University. Mulligan enjoyed one of the most successful seasons in NCAA division III history in 2009 with a 44-3 record. During that season, they won their third straight NESCAC title and captured the program's second NCAA New England Region crown. They finished fourth in the nation at the NCAA Championship that year. In 2009, Mulligan was voted as the conference's Coach of the Year for the third straight year and for the fourth time in five years. She was a four-year starter and assistant coach for six years at
