Maryland Coaching Staff

Terry Rupp, Head Coach



Terry Rupp is in his eighth season as the head coach of the Terrapin baseball team. Since taking over as skipper seven years ago, Rupp has overseen dramatic improvements in many aspects of the baseball program. His philosophy of discipline and hard work has helped steer Terp baseball in the right direction as the program works to establish a new winning tradition. During his tenure in College Park, Rupp has shown the ability to teach and develop his players, readying them for the next level. His squads have beaten several top-five teams over the years and, in 2002, the Terps set a school-record with 34 wins.

Jim Farr, Assistant Coach



Jim Farr is in his third season with the Terps, and 23rd in coaching. A former major league pitcher, Farr came to the Terrapins from the College of William & Mary, where he left as the school's all-time winningest coach after transforming the Tribe into a perennial Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) contender. Farr is known as an outstanding recruiter and developer of talent. He has developed four first-round draft picks in his career. Seven of Farr's former players have reached the big leagues, including recent additions Chris Ray/Baltimore Orioles, Brendan Harris/Minnesota Twins and Bill Bray/Cincinnati Reds. A graduate of Penn State University, Farr directs the pitching staff and coordinates the Terps' recruiting efforts.

Blaine Brown, Assistant Coach



Blaine Brown enters his third season as an assistant coach for Terry Rupp and the Terps. Brown's responsibilities at Maryland include working with catchers, hitters, scouting assignments and assists with recruiting. Before coming to Maryland, Brown spent two seasons as Jeff Messer's top assistant coach at Slippery Rock University, where he helped produce two All-Region players and 10 all-conference honorees. Brown guided Slippery Rock to a top-five national ranking his last year, as well as a berth in the NCAA Division II Regionals.

This is an advanced camp for the young player who aspires to be successful at the higher levels. **The camp will run from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm Wednesday and Thursday.** Campers will be provided lunch daily, along with a camp T-shirt at check-in. The Terrapin camp staff will offer two sessions of the prospect showcase camp this summer. This is a fast-paced, showcase instructional camp, which will provide the high school camper with the opportunity to be evaluated by the University of Maryland baseball coaches, as well as the many college coaches that will be on staff throughout the camp. Campers will receive instruction in all phases of the game, as well as participate in daily competitive games. Each camper will receive a detailed evaluation of his skills at the end of the camp. These are great camps for the player who wishes to gain exposure for future college recruiting possibilities, as well as improving his skills. This is an overnight boarding camp. Resident campers will be provided housing, as well as meals and a camp T-shirt at check-in. Non-resident campers will be provided housing, as well as all meals (excluding breakfast) and a camp T-shirt. Late resident registrants will be taken as dorm space permits. **Full payment is required with registration.**
